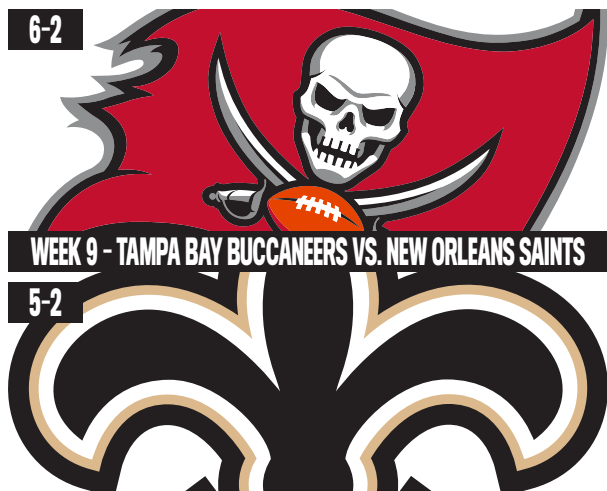

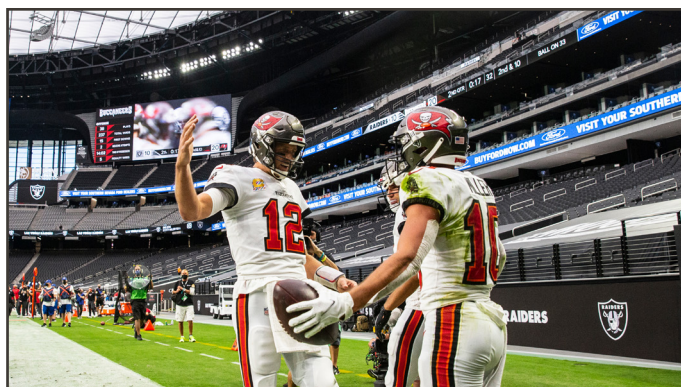

• Outside linebacker **Jason Pierre-Paul** has recorded sacks in six of the first eight weeks of the 2020 season, taking his career total to 86.0. His 86.0 sacks since entering the league in 2010 rank eighth in the NFL.

• Pierre-Paul has earned 27.5 sacks since joining the Buccaneers in 2018, which rank tied for ninth in the NFL during that span.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- Quarterback **Tom Brady** and tight end **Rob Gronkowski** have connected for **81 touchdowns** in the regular season and need four more to tie Steve Young and Jerry Rice (85) for the third-most touchdown connections in NFL history.
- The Buccaneers have scored 247 **points** this season and need **14 more** to pass 2012 & 2019 (260) for the most points scored through eight games in franchise history.
- Tampa Bay has posted at least 3.0 sacks in each of the past four games and with **3.0 or more sacks** against New Orleans, the team will have its longest streak of consecutive games with at least 3.0 sacks since 2002 (five games, 10/27/02-12/1/02). It would tie for the third-longest streak of such games in franchise history.
- The Buccaneers have recorded an interception in seven straight games, the team's longest such streak since 2007-08. With **an interception** against New Orleans, it will mark the team's longest streak since 2004 (nine games, 10/10/04-12/12/04).
- With **a win** against New Orleans, Tampa Bay would match the best record through nine games in franchise history (7-2), accomplished twice before (1979, 2002).



SHAQUIL BARRETT

- Barrett recorded a **franchise-record 19.5 sacks** in 2019. **With 12.0 more** in 2020, he would be just the 11th player in NFL history to post consecutive seasons with at least 15.0 sacks.
- Barrett has **22.5 sacks as a Buccaneer**. He needs **3.5 more** to tie Greg Spies (26.0 from 2002-07) for the 10th-most sacks in franchise history.

CAMERON BRATE

- Brate has **28 career touchdown catches**. He needs **one more** to pass Joey Galloway (28 from 2004-08) for the fourth-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Brate has **three career games with multiple touchdown receptions**. He needs **one more** to tie Jimmie Giles for the most ever such games by a Buccaneers tight end and tie for the third-most such games in franchise history.



TOM BRADY

- Brady has 20 **passing touchdowns** this season. He needs **one more** to pass Doug Williams (20 in 1980), Vinny Testaverde (20 in 1989) and Brian Griese (20 in 2004) and tie Trent Dilfer (21 in 1998 & 1998) for eighth-most, two more to tie Brad Johnson (22 in 2002) and Jameis Winston (22 in 2015) for sixth-most and five more to tie Josh Freeman (25 in 2010) for the fifth-most passing touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Brady has 561 regular season **passing touchdowns**, one more than Drew Brees (560 - active) for the most regular season passing touchdowns in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has thrown for 634 touchdowns, the most in NFL history.
- Brady has thrown 189 **consecutive passes without an interception**. He needs **nine more** to pass attempts without an interception to surpass Jeff Garcia (197 consecutive passes without an interception in 2007) for the longest such streak in franchise history.
- Brady has two career regular season games with at least six passing touchdowns and needs **one more** such game to tie Peyton Manning (three) for the most such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has seven such games, tied with Ben Roethlisberger for the third-most in NFL history.





WHAT TO WATCH FOR

LAVONTE DAVID

- David has **24.0 career sacks**. He needs **2.5 more** to tie Jason Pierre-Paul (26.5 from 2018-Present) Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history.
- David has **three career defensive touchdowns** and needs **one more** to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979-96; Mike Washington, 1976-84).

MIKE EVANS

- Evans has seven **receiving touchdowns** this season. He needs **one more** to tie Cameron Brate (eight in 2016), Evans' own mark (eight in 2018 & 2019), Jimmie Giles (eight in 1985), Vincent Jackson (eight in 2012), Keyshawn Johnson (eight in 2000) and Keenan McCardell (eight in 2003) for the 10th-most receiving touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.



CHRIS GODWIN

- Godwin has **2,979 career receiving yards**. He needs **465 more** to pass Gerald Carter (3,443 from 1981-87) for the ninth-most receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has **19 career touchdown receptions**. He needs **one more** to tie Vincent Jackson (20 from 2012-16) for 10th-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.
- Godwin had **1,333 receiving yards in 2019**. If he **surpasses 1,300 yards receiving in 2020**, he would be the first player in team history to record 1,300-or-more yards in consecutive seasons.

RYAN SUCCOP

- Succop made four field goals at New York Giants. With **four or more made field goals** against New Orleans, would be the first player in franchise history to post consecutive games with at least four field goals made.



ROB GRONKOWSKI

- Gronkowski has caught a touchdown pass in each of the past three games. With **a touchdown reception** against New Orleans, he will tie Cameron Brate (four consecutive games, 9/24/17-10/15/17) for the longest streak of games with a touchdown reception by a tight end in franchise history.
- Gronkowski has **82 regular season receiving touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to pass Anquan Boldin and Reggie Wayne (82) for the 23rd-most touchdown receptions in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has **94 receiving touchdowns** and needs **one more** to tie Issac Bruce (95) and Hines Ward (91) for the 13th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

LESEAN MCCOY

- McCoy has **73 career rushing touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to tie Earl Campbell and Leroy Kelly (74) for 26th-most, **two more** to tie Clinton Portis (75) for 25th-most and **three more** to tie Pete Johnson (76) for the 24th-most regular season rushing touchdowns in NFL history.

JASON PIERRE-PAUL

- Pierre-Paul has 27.5 **sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **1.0 more** to pass Ronde Barber (28.0 from 1997-2012) for eighth-most in franchise history.

- Three members of the Super Bowl winning 2015 Denver Broncos will reunite on Sunday, as Buccaneers OLB **Shaquil Barrett** (2015-18) squares off against Saints WRs **Bennie Fowler** (2015-17) and **Emmanuel Sanders** (2014-18). Barrett appeared in all 16 games and made six starts in his rookie campaign, making 50 tackles, while forcing four fumbles to go along with a pair of fumble recoveries. Sanders recorded 1,135 receiving yards and six receiving touchdowns. Fowler appeared in all 16 games, finishing the season with 203 receiving yards.





CONNECTIONS

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- When Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2015–18) was the head coach of the New York Jets, he helped Saints LB **Demario Davis** record the best season of his career during the 2017 campaign. Davis, who finished the season with career-best outputs in sacks (5.0), tackles (135), tackles for loss (13) and quarterback hits (15), also worked with a pair of current Buccaneer coaches who were on the defensive side of the ball in New York – **Mike Caldwell** and **Kacy Rodgers**. Davis led the New York defense in sacks, tackles and tackles for loss, while finishing with the second-most quarterback hits.
- Buccaneers T **Tristan Wirfs** played at Iowa from 2016–18 when Saints Offensive Assistant **Declan Doyle** served in a similar role for the Hawkeyes.
- Buccaneers DT **Ndamukong Suh** played in Miami in 2015, when Saints Assistant Head Coach/Tight Ends Coach **Dan Campbell** was the tight ends coach and interim head coach.
- Saints WR **Michael Thomas** was on the Ohio State roster in 2013 when Buccaneers Head Strength & Conditioning Coach **Anthony Piroli** was a volunteer strength coach for the Buckeyes.



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Saints Head Coach **Sean Payton** spent the 2003–05 seasons as the assistant head coach & quarterbacks coach in Dallas, while Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2005–07) and Defensive Line Coach **Kacy Rodgers** (2003–07) were on the staff. Saints Assistant Head Coach/Tight Ends Coach **Dan Campbell** also played in Dallas from 2003–05.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** and defensive line coach **Kacy Rodgers** coached alongside Saints Assistant Head Coach/Tight Ends Coach **Dan Campbell** and Special Teams Coordinator **Darren Rizzi** with the Miami Dolphins from 2010–11. Rodgers and Rizzi were both on Miami's staff together from 2008–14.
- Buccaneers Quarterbacks Coach **Clyde Christensen** was on the Miami Dolphins staff when Saints Special Teams Coordinator **Darren Rizzi** coached in Miami from 2016–18. Saints Assistant Special Teams Coach **Phil Galiano** was a special teams intern for Miami in 2016.
- Saints Secondary Coach **Aaron Glenn** played for the New York Jets in 2000, when **Todd Bowles** was the defensive backs coach.
- Buccaneers Defensive Quality Control Coach **Tim Atkins** coached alongside Saints Secondary Coach **Aaron Glen** on the Cleveland Browns staff in 2014–15.
- **Chris Boniol** worked as the assistant special teams coach in Oakland in 2014, when Saints Defensive Coordinator **Dennis Allen** was the head coach.
- Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach **Kevin Ross** and Saints Offensive Coordinator **Pete Carmichael** both coached for the San Diego Chargers in 2007–08.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

SEAN PAYTON



Since he was hired as head coach of the New Orleans Saints in 2006, Sean Payton has established himself as one of the most successful coaches in the NFL. Since coming to New Orleans, Payton has led the Saints to eight playoff berths, six NFC South division titles and the franchise's first World Championship with a 31-17 win over the Indianapolis Colts in Super Bowl XLIV.

Entering 2019, Payton's 139 combined regular season and postseason wins in his NFL head coaching career rank 26th-most in NFL history. Payton holds the club's top win total and winning percentage for a head coach.

SEAN PAYTON AT A GLANCE

- Payton has presided over the NFL's most prolific offense since his arrival, leading the league in net yards per game in 2006, 2008, 2009, 2011, 2014 and 2016 and finishing first in scoring in 2008 and 2009.
- Despite missing QB Drew Brees for five contests, the 2019 Saints won 13 games, including seven on the road, both for the second consecutive season and captured the NFC South division title for the third straight time.
- Payton was hired as the 14th head coach in Saints history on Jan. 18, 2006 after serving as a member of the Dallas Cowboys coaching staff from 2003-05 under 2013 Pro Football Hall of Fame inductee Bill Parcells. Prior to his final season with the Cowboys, Payton was promoted to assistant head coach/passing game coordinator and was responsible for the team's play-calling after serving as assistant head coach/quarterbacks from 2003-04.
- Payton went to Dallas following four years with the New York Giants (1999-2002), the last three as offensive coordinator after spending his first season as quarterbacks coach.
- Payton wrapped two coaching stints at San Diego State University (1988-89 and 1992-93) around a stop at Indiana State (1990-91). During his second stretch with the Aztecs, Payton was running backs coach, working with Heisman Trophy runner-up Marshall Faulk before becoming quarterbacks coach.
- Following the 1993 season, Payton moved to Miami (Ohio) (1994-95) where he was quarterbacks coach. He spent 1996 as quarterbacks coach at Illinois before entering the NFL with Philadelphia.
- Payton earned a bachelor's degree in communications at Eastern Illinois, where as a quarterback he had 10,665 passing yards, then the third-highest total in NCAA Division I-AA history. The three-time AP All-American selection had professional stints with Chicago of the Arena Football League, Ottawa of the Canadian Football League and the Chicago Bears in 1987. Payton was inducted into the Eastern Illinois Hall of Fame in September of 2000. He received an honorary doctorate from his alma mater in 2013.
- Payton was born Dec. 29, 1963 in San Mateo, Calif., and raised in Naperville, Ill., Payton has a daughter, Meghan and a son, Connor.
