OFFENSIVE NOTES

A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

· Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.



· Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

PROFICIENCY IN PASS PROTECTION

• Since the arrival of All-Pro tackle Tristan Wirfs in 2020, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.4%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (17). So far in 2023, the Buccaneers have allowed 20 sacks through Week 11.

· In Week 11, Lavonte David surpassed Rondé Barber (1,428) for the second-most tackles in franchise history.

· Since Week 6 when Tampa Bay returned from its Bye Week, Lavonte David has four more tackles for loss (11) than any other player. He also ranks third in the NFL during that span in tackles (62).

TURKEY TIME WITH O-LINE

· On Tuesday, November 21 at 4:00 p.m., the Tampa Bay Buccaneers offensive line and Publix Super Markets will team up once again for the 17th Annual Turkey Time with the O-Line, supported by Publix. Buccaneers offensive linemen will distribute over 1,000 full Thanksgiving meals funded by the offensive linemen and Assistant Head Coach/Run Game Coordinator Harold Goodwin and Offensive Line Coach Joe Gilbert.

· At the start of Tuesday's event, the Tampa Bay Buccaneers Foundation Social Justice Fund will present a check, matching the players and coaches' contribution of \$43,500 to the nonprofit organization Feeding Tampa Bay, serving as the sixth-consecutive year the two parties will collaborate for this event. The matching donation will be utilized through school pantries, mobile pantries and with Feeding Tampa Bay's more than 550 agency pantries to help provide meals to community members in need this holiday season.

· Families who have been pre-selected by United Way Suncoast, Hillsborough County Public Schools and local nonprofit organizations will receive a full meal purchased by the Buccaneers' offensive line, with contributions from Publix and TECO Peoples Gas.

· Tuesday's event is carrying on the tradition launched in 2007 as a way to make a major impact in the Tampa Bay community during the holidays. Following this year's distribution, the annual effort will have provided more than 13,500 underserved families with Thanksgiving meals.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

LAVONTE DAVID



- Needs **10 tackles** to mark his 10th career season with 100-or-more tackles, joining London Fletcher (14) and Bobby Wagner (11) as the only players to accomplish that feat since 2000.
- Needs **1 tackle for loss** to tie himself (2014), Gerald McCoy (2014) and Jason Pierre-Paul (2018) for the longest streak of games with at least one tackle for loss within a season by a Buccaneers player since tackles for loss became an official statistic in 2006.

MIKE EVANS



- Needs **1 total touchdown** to tie Leroy Kelly and Charley Taylor (90) for the 38th-most total touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **2 total touchdowns** to tie Davante Adams (active), Isaac Bruce, Tony Dorsett, Edgerrin James, Bobby Mitchell and Ricky Watters (91) for the 32nd-most total touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **3 receiving touchdowns** to tie Davante Adams (active) and Isaac Bruce (91) for the 13th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs **59 receiving yards** to surpass DeSean Jackson (11,263) for the 37th-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Needs **169 receiving yards** to surpass Keenan McCardell (11,373) for the 36th-most receiving yards in NFL history.

SHANE STEICHEN



Shane Steichen was hired as head coach of the Indianapolis Colts on February 14, 2023. He has 13 years of coaching experience, including the last 12 seasons in the NFL.

Steichen served as the offensive coordinator of the Philadelphia Eagles the last two seasons and helped the team reach Super Bowl LVII in 2022.

During his two seasons as offensive coordinator, Steichen coordinated an offense that ranked first in the NFL in rushing yards per game (153.6), rushing yards (5,224) and rushing touchdowns (57) over that time frame. Philadelphia also ranked tied for first in fewest interceptions (19) and third in fourth down conversion percentage (58.92 percent).

SHANE STEICHEN AT A GLANCE

- In 2022, he guided a Philadelphia offense that finished in the top 10 in numerous categories, including yards per game (389.1 - third), points per game (28.1 - third), rushing yards per game (147.6 - fifth), passing yards per game (241.5 - ninth), fewest turnovers (19 - tied-fifth), first downs per game (22.6 - third), third down percentage (franchise-record 45.95 percent - fourth), fourth down percentage (68.75 percent - fourth), red zone percentage (67.80 percent - third), goal to go percentage (82.35 percent - fifth), points scored on their first offensive possession (62 - first) and plays of 10+ yards (253 - second). The Eagles were one of just two teams to finish in the top 10 in rushing yards per game and passing yards per game.
- Steichen worked with quarterback Jalen Hurts, who set single-season career highs in every passing category, including completions (306), passing yards (3,701), passing touchdowns (22), completion percentage (66.5) and passer rating (101.5). Hurts also had a team high and single-season career-high 13 rushing touchdowns. He finished fourth in the NFL in passer rating and 10th in passing yards.
- Prior to Philadelphia, Steichen spent seven seasons (2014-20) with the Los Angeles/San Diego Chargers where he served as offensive coordinator (2020), interim offensive coordinator (2019), quarterbacks coach (2016-19) and offensive quality control/wide receivers (2014-15). The Chargers offense finished in the top 10 in passing yards per game in each of his seven years on the offensive staff, including the league's best in 2017.
- Steichen began his NFL career as a defensive assistant with the Chargers (2011-12) after spending one season as a full-time offensive assistant at Louisville (2010). He also served as an offensive graduate assistant (2008-09) and student graduate assistant (2007) at his alma mater, UNLV.
- As a four-year letterman (2003-06) at quarterback for the Rebels, Steichen left as the school's 12th all-time leading passer with 2,755 yards and 22 touchdowns.
- A native of Sacramento, Calif., Steichen earned his degree in journalism and media studies from UNLV. He attended Oak Ridge High School in El Dorado Hills, Calif., and earned area MVP honors from the Sacramento Bee after leading his squad to a conference sectional title in 2002.
- Steichen and his wife, Nina, have a son, Hudson, and a daughter, Stella. Steichen's older brother, Sean, was a punter at Boise State.
