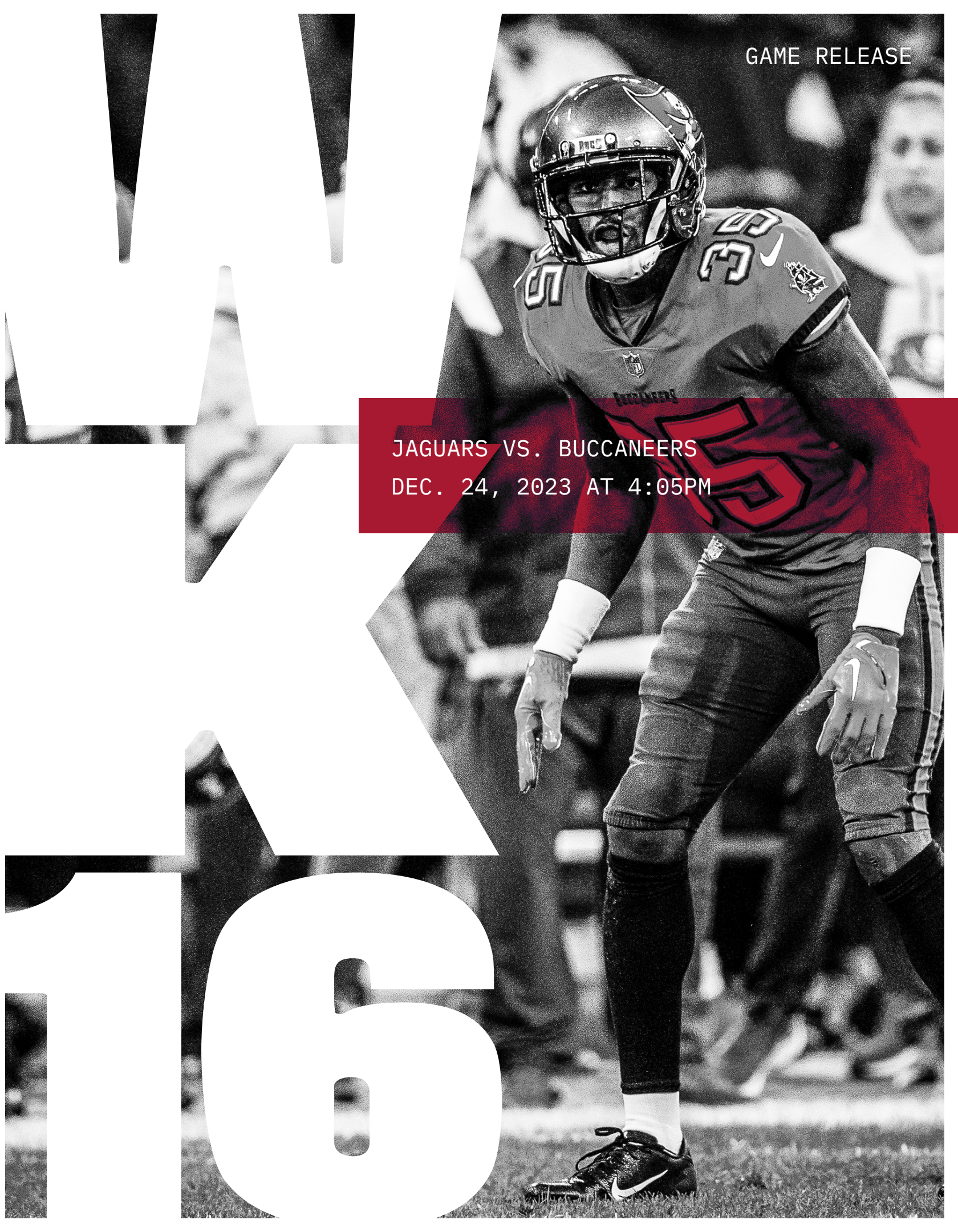

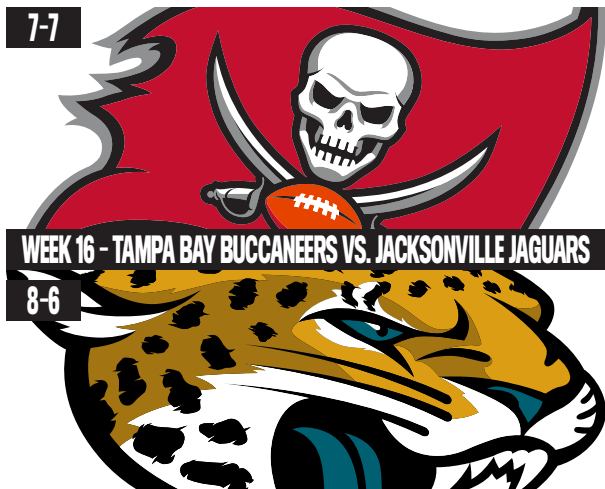

# OFFENSIVE NOTES

## A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

· In Week 13, Mike Evans reached the 1,000-yard mark for the 10th consecutive season - the longest-such streak to begin a career and the second-longest streak overall in league history.

· He is also the first player ever with 60+ receptions in each of his first 10 career seasons.



· Evans now has five career seasons with 1,000+ receiving yards and 10-or-more receiving touchdowns, which tie him for the fifth-most in NFL history. Every other player with at least as many seasons as Evans is a member of the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

· Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.

· Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

## RELYING ON RACHAAD

· Through Week 15, Rachaad White is one of four players with 1,300+ scrimmage yards and 8+ touchdowns (also, Christian McCaffrey, Tyreek Hill and CeeDee Lamb).

Rachaad White ranks third among running backs, and fifth among all players, in yards from scrimmage (1,303). He also stands second among running backs in receiving yards (469) and ranks fifth among running backs in receptions, with 50.

## A DO-IT-ALL SAFETY



• Antoine Winfield Jr. is tied for first in the league with three fumble recoveries this season, matching his single-season career high. He also ranks second in the NFL with a career-best five forced fumbles this season.

• He is 1-of-2 players in the league with three-or-more forced fumbles and three-

or-more fumble recoveries this season, alongside Steelers edge rusher T.J. Watt.

• Winfield Jr. is the first defensive back since Hall of Famer Brian Dawkins and Roy Williams in 2002 with three-or more forced fumbles, three-or-more fumble recoveries, two-plus interceptions and 2.0-plus sacks in a single season.

## THE VET HAS STILL GOT IT



• Through Week 15, 12-year veteran Lavonte David is the only player in the NFL with 100+ tackles and 15+ tackles for loss.

• Since 2000, David's 10 seasons with 100+ tackles are the third-most, trailing only London Fletcher (14) and Bobby Wagner (11). David has four seasons

with 100+ tackles and 15+ tackles for loss, while no other player has more than two-such seasons since tackles for loss became regularly tracked in 2008.

• In Week 11, Lavonte David surpassed Rondé Barber (1,428) for the second-most tackles in franchise history.

# IN THE COMMUNITY

## HABITAT HILLSBOROUGH HOME DEDICATION DAY

On Tuesday morning, the Tampa Bay Buccaneers and Habitat for Humanity of Hillsborough saw the work of their community partnership, "Holiday Home Build with the Bucs", come to fruition as they handed over the keys to the four families that will inhabit the homes that they have worked on over the course of the last month. In the last month, Buccaneers players and staff have put in volunteer hours at the homes, installing windows and doors and priming the houses.

Prior to the project's start, over 90% of the Buccaneers roster donated funds towards the construction of a home for a family in need, with the Buccaneers organization matching their contributions to fund the construction of two Habitat homes in the Temple Terrace community. Since then, thanks to donations from the Buccaneers fanbase, coined "The Krewe", as well as comedians Bert Kreischer and Tom Segura, the impact has doubled and now the build of four homes along Overlook Drive has been funded.

The project was part of the player-led Buccaneers Youth Leadership Program, with 25 students apiece from Young Middle Magnet School and Webb Middle School volunteering at the homes as well. The Buccaneers Youth Leadership Program is part of the team's Social Justice Initiative, a player-led program created in 2018 with a \$1,000,000 commitment by the Glazer family to break down barriers to racial and social equality.

# WHAT TO WATCH FOR



## LAVONTE DAVID

- Needs **1.5 sacks** to become just the second player since tackles for loss became regularly tracked in 2008 to record multiple seasons with 100+ tackles, 15+ tackles for loss and 5.0+ sacks, joining Daryl Washington (2011, 2012).
- Needs **4 tackles for loss** to hit 20 tackles for loss on the season and tie Aaron Donald and DeMarcus Ware (3) for the second-most such-seasons since the statistic became regularly tracked in 2008. Only J.J. Watt (4) has more.



## MIKE EVANS

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to break a tie with Davante Adams (active) and Rob Gronkowski (92) for the 12th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs **1 receiving touchdowns** to tie himself (12 in 2014 and 2016) for the third-most receiving touchdowns in a single season in franchise history.
- Needs **2 receiving touchdowns** to tie himself (13 in 2020) for the second-most receiving touchdowns in a single season in franchise history.
- Needs **3 receiving touchdowns** to tie himself (14 in 2021) for the franchise record for single-season touchdown receptions.
- Needs **1 total touchdown** to tie Jerome Bettis, Priest Holmes and Marshawn Lynch (94) for the 27th-most overall touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **3 total touchdowns** to tie Eric Dickerson (96) for the 26th-most overall touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **117 receiving yards** to surpass Calvin Johnson (11,438) for the 33rd-most receiving yards in NFL history. He will also pass Johnson for the sixth-most receiving yards by a player through his first 10 seasons in league history.



# WHAT TO WATCH FOR

## CHRIS GODWIN

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie Jimmie Giles (34) and surpass Cameron Brate (33) for the second-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs **186 receiving yards** to reach the 1,000-yard milestone for the fourth time in his career, breaking a tie with Joey Galloway and Vincent Jackson for the second-most 1,000-yard receiving seasons in team history.
- Needs **12 receptions** to hit the 80-catch mark for the fourth time in his career, extending his current franchise record for such-seasons to four.



## RACHAAD WHITE

- Needs **31 receiving yards** to record his first season with 500+ receiving yards, marking the ninth-such occurrence by a running back in team history.
- Needs **166 rushing yards** to become the first Buccaneers running back since Doug Martin in 2015 with 1,000+ rushing yards in a single season. It would mark the 13th-such occurrence by a Tampa Bay player in team history.
- Needs **166 rushing yards and 31 receiving yards** to join James Wilder (1984) as the only players in franchise history with 1,000+ rushing yards and 500+ receiving yards in a single season. He would also become the first player to accomplish this within his first two seasons since Saquon Barkley and Christian McCaffrey in 2018.
- Needs **197 scrimmage yards** to become the first Buccaneers running back since Doug Martin in 2015, and the first Buccaneers player since Mike Evans in 2018, with 1,500+ scrimmage yards in a single season. It would mark the 8th-such occurrence by a Tampa Bay player in team history.
- Needs **1 total touchdowns** to tie five players for the 10th-most single-season touchdowns from scrimmage by a running back in team history.







# WHAT TO WATCH FOR



## **BAKER MAYFIELD**

- Needs **1 passing touchdown** to join Tom Brady as the only players with 25+ passing touchdowns in their first season with Tampa Bay.
- Needs **3 passing touchdowns** to tie Josh Freeman (27 in 2012) for the fifth-most single-season passing touchdowns in team history.
- Needs **4 passing touchdowns** to tie Jameis Winston (28 in 2016) for the fourth-most single-season passing touchdowns in team history.
- Needs **2 games with a 90+ passer rating** to join Tom Brady (2020, 2021) as the only quarterbacks with 10-or-more such games in a single single in franchise history.



## **ANTOINE WINFIELD JR.**

- Needs **1.0 sack** to become the first defensive back since 1999 (when forced fumbles started being tracked) with 5.0+ sacks and 5+ forced fumbles in a single season.
- Needs **1.0 sack** to become 1-of-4 players since 2000 with 5.0+ sacks, 5+ takeaways and 5+ forced fumbles in a single season, joining T.J. Watt (2019), Justin Tuck (2010) and Terrell Suggs (2003).
- Needs **3 tackles** to become the first defensive back since Pro Football Hall of Famer John Lynch (117 in 1999) to record 110+ tackles in a season for Tampa Bay.

# DOUG PEDERSON



The Jacksonville Jaguars hired two-time Super Bowl champion and former NFL QB Doug Pederson as head coach on Feb. 3, 2022.

In Pederson's first year as head coach of the Jaguars, he led the team to its first AFC South title and first playoff appearance since 2018. The Jaguars ranked first in the NFL in win differential from 2021 to 2022 and became just the third team since 1970 to draft first overall and win their division the following season.

## DOUG PEDERSON AT A GLANCE

- In 2023, Pederson was 1-of-3 finalists for AP NFL Coach of the Year.
- Pederson joined the Jaguars after most recently spending five seasons (2016-20) as the head coach of the Philadelphia Eagles, compiling a 46-39-1 record during the regular season and postseason.
- During his time in Philadelphia, the Eagles made the postseason in three consecutive seasons (2017-19) and won two NFC East titles (2017 and 2019).
- In 2017, Pederson led the Eagles to their first-ever Super Bowl Championship in Super Bowl LII, with a 41-33 victory over the Patriots.
- 11 different players earned Pro Bowl honors during Pederson's time in Philadelphia.
- Pederson was key in the development of QB Carson Wentz, who threw for 16,811 yards and 113 touchdowns from 2016-20. Wentz established several single-season franchise records during his time in Philadelphia, including completions (388 in 2019), completion percentage (69.6% in 2018), passing yards (4,039 in 2019) and passing touchdowns (33 in 2017) under Pederson's tutelage.
- In 2017, Pederson became the eighth head coach in NFL history to win the Super Bowl within his first two seasons with a team, and the seventh to win the Super Bowl in his first playoff appearance.
- Prior to arriving in Philadelphia, Pederson serves as the offensive coordinator of the Kansas City Chiefs from 2013-15. Before Kansas City, Pederson was the quarterbacks coach in Philadelphia (2011-12), helping Michael Vick become the second quarterback in NFL history with 3,000+ passing yards and 500+ rushing yards in consecutive seasons.
- A 12-year NFL veteran, Pederson played quarterback for the Green Bay Packers, Miami Dolphins, Philadelphia Eagles and Cleveland Browns. He was coached by three of the most successful coaches in NFL history: Don Shula, Mike Holmgren and Andy Reid. Pederson played for Green Bay from 1996-98 and 2001-04, and was part of Packer teams that won Super Bowl XXXI, two NFC Championships and six division titles.
- The Bellingham, Washington, native attended Northeast Louisiana (now Louisiana Monroe), where he was a three-year starter at quarterback.
- He and his wife, Jeannie, have three sons.
