THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

• Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). Over his last eight quarters of football, Brady has thrown for 1,067 yards and 10 touchdowns with just one interception.

GETTING RED ZONE RESULTS



• The Buccaneers offense scored a touchdown on 42-of-61 trips inside the red zone this season, while leading the NFL with a 95.1 scoring percentage (58-of-61) on red zone drives.

• The team has found success through the air in the red zone, recording 27 red zone passing touchdowns, tied for the second-most in the NFL this season.

A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN

• With 1,006 yards in 2020, Mike Evans became the first player in NFL history with 1,000-or-more receiving yards in each of his first seven NFL seasons, surpassing Randy Moss (first six seasons).

• Evans set a new franchise record with 13 receiving touchdowns (fourth in the NFL) and is Tampa Bay's all-time leader in receptions, receiving yards and receiving touchdowns.

ROUGHING UP THE RUN GAME



In 2018, the Buccaneers ranked 20th in defensive rush average and 24th in rush yards allowed per game. Tampa Bay has now led the NFL in run defense in each of the past two seasons under Todd Bowles, becoming the first team to accomplish that feat since the Minnesota Vikings (2006-08).

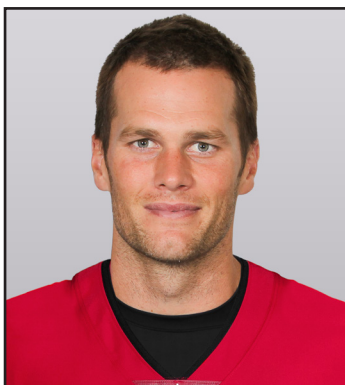

FIRST THINGS FIRST

Rob Gronkowski needs... **1 REC. TOUCHDOWN**

to surpass John Stallworth (12 from 1985-2000) for the second-most postseason touchdown receptions in NFL history, trailing only Jerry Rice (22).

Rob Gronkowski needs... **A 100-YARD GAME**

to surpass Vernon Davis (four) and set an NFL postseason record for the most 100-yard receiving performances by a tight end.

ANTONIO BROWN

- Brown has **five career 100-yard games** in the **postseason**. He needs **one more** to tie Julian Edelman and Michael Irvin (six each) for the second-most 100-yard receiving games in NFL postseason history.
- Brown has **two career games with multiple touchdown receptions** in the **postseason**, tied for the ninth-most such games in NFL history. He needs **one more** to tie for the second-most such games in NFL postseason history.
- Brown has **837 career postseason receiving yards**, the third-most among active players. He needs **106 more** to pass Larry Fitzgerald (942) for the second-most postseason receiving yards among active players.
- Including **regular season and postseason**, Brown has **937 career receptions**, the 24th-most in NFL history. He needs **two more** more to pass Keenan McCardell (938 from 1992-2007) for the 23rd-most receptions in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).
- Including **regular season and postseason**, Brown has **12,583 career receiving yards**, the 28th-most in NFL history. He needs **80 more** to pass Derrick Mason (12,662 from 2007-2015) for the 27th-most receiving yards in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).
- Including **regular season and postseason**, Brown has **83 career touchdown receptions**, tied for the 30th-most in NFL history. He needs **one more** to pass James Lofton (83 from 1978-93) and Brandon Marshall (83 from 2006-2018) for the 30th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

NDAMUKONG SUH

- Suh has **5.0 career postseason sacks**. He needs **1.0 more** to tie Brooks Reed and J.J. Watt (6.0 each) for the second-most postseason sacks by an active player.



ROB GRONKOWSKI

- Gronkowski has **1,163 postseason receiving yards**, ninth-most in NFL history. He needs **five more** to pass Fred Biletnikoff (1,167) for eighth-most, **19 more** to pass Hines Ward (1,181) for seventh-most, **67 more** to pass Andre Reed (1,229) for sixth-most and **92 more** to pass Reggie Wayne (1,254) for the fifth-most postseason receiving yards in NFL history.
- Gronkowski has **four career 100-yard games** in the **postseason**. He needs **one more** to surpass Vernon Davis (four) for the most such games by a tight end in NFL postseason history. With **one more** 100-yard receiving game, Gronkowski would tie Antonio Brown (active or current), Larry Fitzgerald, Andre Reed, John Stallworth and Hines Ward for the fourth-most 100-yard receiving games in NFL postseason history.
- Gronkowski has **three career games with multiple touchdown receptions** in the **postseason**, tied for the second-most such games in NFL history. He needs **one more** to have the second-most such games in NFL postseason history.
- Gronkowski has **98 receiving touchdowns** (regular & postseason combined) and needs **two more** to tie Don Hutson (100) for the 11th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

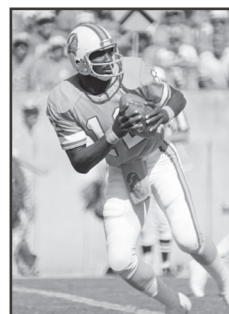

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians** (2013-17) held the same position with the Arizona Cardinals when Washington TE **Logan Thomas** was drafted in the fourth round of the 2014 NFL Draft by Arizona to play quarterback. Multiple coaches on the Tampa Bay staff also worked in Arizona during this time.
- Buccaneers OLB **Jason Pierre-Paul** (2010-17) played for the New York Giants when Washington Assistant Defensive Line Coach **Jeff Zagonia** held the same position in New York for the 2016 season.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** was the head coach of the New York Jets (2015-18) when Washington OLB **Kevin Pierre-Louis** (2018) played nine games for New York. Multiple defensive coaches on the Tampa Bay staff also worked in New York during this time, including Inside Linebackers Coach **Mike Caldwell**, who was an assistant head coach/inside linebackers coach for the Jets.
- Buccaneers QB **Blaine Gabbert** (2011-13) played for the Jacksonville Jaguars when Washington Defensive Coordinator **Jack Del Rio** was the head coach in Jacksonville from 2003-11.



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Two former coaches at Grambling State University will square off on Saturday when Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** meets Washington Senior Vice President of Player Development **Doug Williams**. Williams was the head coach at Grambling State from 1998-2003, hiring Bowles as his defensive coordinator from 1998-99. In their two seasons together, Grambling State went 12-10, including a seven-win season in 1999 that was good for the most wins in five seasons. Williams and Bowles arrived at Grambling State together after spending one season in their same roles at Morehouse College in 1997.
- Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** was selected 7th overall in the 2003 NFL Draft by the Jacksonville Jaguars. Leftwich played four seasons under Washington Defensive Coordinator **Jack Del Rio**, who was the head coach in Jacksonville from 2003-11.
- Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach **Kevin Ross** (2007-08) was the assistant secondary/quality control coach with the San Diego Chargers when Washington Head Coach **Ron Rivera** (2008-10) was the defensive coordinator for the Chargers.
- Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** (2009) played quarterback for the Buccaneers when Washington Senior Vice President of Player Development **Doug Williams** was the director of pro personnel in Tampa during the 2009 season.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

Ron Rivera is in his 24th season coaching in the NFL and his first as Washington's head coach in 2020. He was named the 30th head coach in franchise history on Jan. 1, 2020.

His first regular season in Washington concluded with an NFC East division title after his team won five of its last seven games to win the division and clinch a playoff berth.

Rivera has now been to the playoffs five times during his head coaching career.

RON RIVERA AT A GLANCE

- Rivera most recently served as the head coach of the Carolina Panthers for nine seasons, where he led the team to three-straight divisional titles and an appearance in Super Bowl 50.
- Rivera was twice recognized as the NFL Coach of the Year by the Associated Press in 2013 and in 2015.
- He inherited a 2-14 Carolina Panthers team as a rookie head coach in 2011 and guided it back to an NFC force with four playoff appearances since 2013, tied for the second-most playoff berths in the NFC over that six-year period. In that span, the Panthers recorded 58 wins, tied for the most in any six-year period of their franchise history and fifth-most in the NFL.
- In 2015, Carolina won its second NFC Championship in franchise history, third-consecutive NFC South division title and appeared in Super Bowl 50. Carolina finished the season with a franchise-best 17-2 record.
- Hired by the Panthers for his defensive expertise, Rivera did not disappoint as the Panthers put together five top-10 finishes in total defense in seven seasons from 2012-18.
- Rivera coached back-to-back Rookie of the Year award winners in Carolina with quarterback Cam Newton and linebacker Luke Kuechly.
- Rivera served as the defensive coordinator for the Chicago Bears (2004-06) and the San Diego Chargers (2008-2010) before arriving in Charlotte. The 2008 Chargers defense - led by Rivera - finished as the league's top-ranked defense.
- In 23 seasons as a coach and nine as a player, he has been with teams that have reached the playoffs 20 times, including nine conference championships and three Super Bowls.
- Prior to becoming a coordinator, Rivera spent five seasons as the linebackers coach for the Philadelphia Eagles (1999-2003) and two seasons as the defensive quality control coach for the Chicago Bears.
- He played all nine of his NFL seasons at outside linebacker for the Chicago Bears - the team that selected him in the second round of the 1984 draft out of the University of California.
- Rivera and his wife, Stephanie, have two children, Christopher and Courtney. Stephanie is a former assistant coach for the WNBA's Washington Mystics.
