• The team has found success through the air in the red zone, recording 15 red zone passing touchdowns, tied for the most in the NFL this season.

WASTING NO TIME

• Outside linebacker **Jason Pierre-Paul** has recorded sacks in five of the first seven weeks of the 2020 season, taking his career total to 85.0. His 85.0 sacks since entering the league in 2010 are tied for the eighth-most in the NFL.

• Pierre-Paul has earned 26.5 sacks since joining the Buccaneers in 2018, which rank ninth in the NFL during that span.

ROUGHING UP THE RUN GAME



• In 2018, the Buccaneers ranked 20th in defensive rush average and 24th in rush yards allowed per game. Last season, Tampa Bay ranked first in the NFL in run defense, and it continues to lead the NFL in that category dating back to the start of 2019, holding

13-straight opponents under 100 yards rushing, tying the third-longest streak in the NFL since the merger (most recently, 2006 Minnesota Vikings).

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- Quarterback **Tom Brady** and tight end **Rob Gronkowski** have connected for **80 touchdowns** in the regular season and need **five more** to tie Steve Young and Jerry Rice (85) for the third-most touchdown connections in NFL history.
- Dating back to the 2019 season, the Buccaneers have held 13 consecutive opponents under 100 rushing yards, a franchise record and tied for the third-longest streak in the NFL since the 1970 merger. If Tampa Bay holds the Giants **under 100 rushing yards**, it will tie for the second-longest streak in the NFL since the merger (Baltimore Ravens, 14 games, 11/5/00-10/28/01).
- The Buccaneers scored 45 points at Las Vegas. With at least **45 points** at New York, it would mark the first time in franchise history the team has posted consecutive games with at least 45 points. Tampa Bay would be the first team in the NFL to do so since 2018 (New Orleans Saints, three games, 11/4/18-11/18/18).
- Tampa Bay has scored at least 35 points in each of the past two games, matching a franchise record. With at least **35 points** against the Giants, Tampa Bay would establish a new team record.
- The Buccaneers have scored 222 **points** this season and need **five more** to pass 2012 (226), **eight more** to pass 2018 (229) and **nine more** to pass 2019 (230) for the most points scored through eight games in franchise history.
- The Buccaneers have recorded an interception in six straight games, the team's longest such streak since 2013. With **an interception** at New York, it will mark the team's longest streak since 2007-08 (12/16/07-9/28/08).
- The Buccaneers have held each of the past three opponents to 20-or-fewer points. If Tampa Bay **holds the Giants to 20-or-fewer points**, it will mark the longest such streak for the franchise since 2009-10 (five games, 12/20/09-9/19/10).
- With **a win** at New York, Tampa Bay would match the best record through eight games in franchise history (6-2), accomplished twice before (1979, 2002).
- Tampa Bay has not allowed a sack in either of the past two games, the first time since 2008 the team has posted consecutive games without allowing a sack (9/21/08-9/28/08). If the Buccaneers **do not allow a sack** against the Giants, it will mark the longest streak of games without allowing a sack in franchise history, accomplished three other times, most recently in 1994.



TOM BRADY

- Brady has 18 **passing touchdowns** this season. He needs **two more** to tie Doug Williams (20 in 1980), Vinny Testaverde (20 in 1989) and Brian Griese (20 in 2004) for 10th-most, **three more** to tie Trent Dilfer (21 in 1998 & 1998) for eighth-most and four more to tie **Brad Johnson** (22 in 2002) and **Jameis Winston** (22 in 2015) for the sixth-most passing touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Brady has 559 regular season **passing touchdowns**, one more than Drew Brees (558 - active) for the most regular season passing touchdowns in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has thrown for 632 touchdowns, the most in NFL history.
- Brady has two career regular season games with at least **six passing touchdowns** and needs **one more** such game to tie Peyton Manning (three) for the most such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has seven such games, tied with Ben Roethlisberger for the third-most in NFL history.
- Brady threw for four touchdowns at Las Vegas. With at least **four touchdown passes** at New York, he will join Ryan Fitzpatrick (9/9/18-9/16/18) and Jameis Winston (12/8/19-12/15/19) as the only players in franchise history to post consecutive games with at least four passing touchdowns.
- Brady accounted for five touchdowns against the Raiders (four passing, one rushing). If he accounts for **five or more touchdowns** against the Giants, it will mark only the sixth time in league history a player has had consecutive games accounting for at least five touchdowns (two such games in a row: Russell Wilson, 2020; Deshaun Watson, 2017; Ben Roethlisberger, 2014; Daunte Culpepper, 2004). Brady owns the NFL league record with three consecutive games in 2007.





WHAT TO WATCH FOR

SHAQUIL BARRETT

- Barrett recorded a **franchise-record 19.5 sacks** in 2019. **With 12.0 more** in 2020, he would be just the 11th player in NFL history to post consecutive seasons with at least 15.0 sacks.
- Barrett has **22.5 sacks as a Buccaneer**. He needs **3.5 more** to tie Greg Spires (26.0 from 2002-07) for the 10th-most sacks in franchise history.

CAMERON BRATE

- Brate has **28 career touchdown catches**. He needs **one more** to pass Joey Galloway (28 from 2004-08) for the fourth-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Brate has **three career games with multiple touchdown receptions**. He needs **one more** to tie Jimmie Giles for the most ever such games by a Buccaneers tight end and tie for the third-most such games in franchise history.



ROB GRONKOWSKI

- Gronkowski has **81 regular season receiving touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to pass Art Powell and Steve Smith (81) for 25th-most and tie Anquan Boldin and Reggie Wayne (82) for the 23rd-most touchdown receptions in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has **93 receiving touchdowns** and needs **two more** to tie Issac Bruce (95) and Hines Ward (91) for the 13th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

RONALD JONES II

- Jones has rushed for at least one touchdown in each of the past two games. With **a rushing touchdown** at New York, he would be the first Buccaneers player to post a rushing score in three consecutive games since 2018 (Peyton Barber, three games, 11/18/18-12/2/18).



LAVONTE DAVID

- David has **24.0 career sacks**. He needs **2.5 more** to tie Jason Pierre-Paul (26.5 from 2018-Present) Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history.
- David has **three career defensive touchdowns** and needs **one more** to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979-96; Mike Washington, 1976-84).

CHRIS GODWIN

- Godwin has **2,979 career receiving yards**. He needs **465 more** to pass Gerald Carter (3,443 from 1981-87) for the ninth-most receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has **19 career touchdown receptions**. He needs **one more** to tie Vincent Jackson (20 from 2012-16) for 10th-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.
- Godwin had **1,333 receiving yards in 2019**. If he **surpasses 1,300 yards receiving in 2020**, he would be the first player in team history to record 1,300-or-more yards in consecutive seasons.

LESEAN MCCOY

- McCoy has **73 career rushing touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to tie Earl Campbell and Leroy Kelly (74) for 26th-most, **two more** to tie Clinton Portis (75) for 25th-most and **three more** to tie Pete Johnson (76) for the 24th-most regular season rushing touchdowns in NFL history.

JASON PIERRE-PAUL

- Pierre-Paul has **26.5 sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **0.5 more** to pass Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for ninth-most and **1.5 more** to tie Ronde Barber (28.0 from 1997-2012) for eighth-most in franchise history.

DEVIN WHITE

- White registered 3.0 sacks at Las Vegas. With **at least 3.0 sacks** at New York, he would join teammate Shaquil Barrett as the only players in franchise history to post consecutive games of at least 3.0 sacks. Barrett, who accomplished the feat in 2019, is the last NFL player to do so.

- Monday's spotlight will feature a pair of Tampa Bay corners against Giants leading WR **Darius Slayton** (2015-18), who played at Auburn with Buccaneers CB **Carlton Davis III** (2015-17) and Buccaneers CB **Jamel Dean** (2015-18). The trio all played key roles in a 2017 Auburn squad that went 10-4 and finished the season 10th in the AP Poll following an appearance in the Peach Bowl. Slayton caught five touchdowns on the season while Davis III snared an interception to go along with 10 passes defended. Dean finished the year second to Davis III in passes defended, tallying eight.

FORMER BUCCANEERS

- Giants Offensive Coordinator Jason Garrett spent part of the 2004 season as a quarterback for the Buccaneers.
- Giants Assistant Coach - Special Projects & Situations Amos Jones was the assistant special teams coordinator for the Buccaneers in 2019.

FORMER GIANTS

- Buccaneers OLB Jason Pierre-Paul was drafted the 15th-overall selection by the Giants in the 2010 NFL Draft, spending eight seasons in the Big Apple and playing a major role in New York's Super Bowl XLVI victory over the New England Patriots following the 2011 season. Pierre-Paul was a Pro Bowl and First-Team All-Pro honoree that season.

- Buccaneers Defensive/Special Teams Assistant **Keith Tandy** played safety for the Atlanta Falcons in 2018 when Giants RB **Devonta Freeman** (2014-19) was also on the team.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2015-18) was the head coach for the New York Jets when the organization drafted Giants DL **Leonard Williams** (2015-19) with the sixth-overall pick in 2015. Williams played for multiple coaches on the Buccaneers staff, including defensive line coach **Kacy Rodgers**.



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Buccaneers Inside Linebackers Coach **Mike Caldwell** spent the 2002 season as a linebacker with the Philadelphia Eagles, playing with Giants Offensive Line Coach **Marc Colombo** (2002-05). The two were a part of an Eagles squad that advanced to the NFC Championship game before falling to the Buccaneers, 27-10.
- Three offensive coaches from the 2012 National Champion Alabama Crimson Tide squad will coach in Monday's contest. Buccaneers Wide Receivers Coach **Kevin Garver** was an offensive analyst alongside Giants Defensive Assistant **Jody Wright**, and Buccaneers Quality Control Coach **John Van Dam** was an offensive graduate assistant. The Crimson Tide posted a 13-1 record that season, knocking off Notre Dame, 42-14, in the BCS Championship Game. Alabama boasted one of the nation's top offenses that year, averaging 38.7 points-per-game and 227.5 rushing yards per game. The Crimson Tide offense scored 40-plus points in eight contests that season as well.
- Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians** (2013-17) was the head coach of the Arizona Cardinals when Giants Assistant Defensive Backs Coach **Anthony Blevins** (2013-17) was an assistant special teams coach, Giants Assistant Coach **Amos Jones** (2013-17) was the special teams coordinator and Giants Tight Ends Coach **Freddie Kitchens** (2007-16) held multiple roles for the Cardinals. Multiple coaches on the Tampa Bay coaching staff worked in Arizona during this time as well.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2005-07) was the defensive backs coach for the Dallas Cowboys when Giants Offensive Coordinator **Jason Garrett** was the offensive coordinator in Dallas in 2007.
- Buccaneers Assistant Strength & Conditioning Coach **Cory Bickey** (2013-17) held the same position at Arkansas when Giants Outside Linebackers/Senior Assistant **Bret Bielema** was the head coach of the program from 2013-17.

HC BRUCE ARIANS



CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

Joe Judge was named the 19th head coach in Giants history on Jan. 8, 2020.

In his 15 seasons as an NFL and collegiate coach, Judge has been a part of five championship teams. He was on the Patriots' staff when they won Super Bowls XLIX, LI and LIII. New England reached the playoffs in every one of Judge's eight seasons and played in the AFC Championship Game in each his first seven seasons with the team. In addition, he coached at the University of Alabama when the Crimson Tide won BCS titles in 2009 and 2011.

JOE JUDGE AT A GLANCE

- He joined the Patriots in 2012 as the team's assistant special teams coach, a position he held for three years. Judge was elevated to special teams coordinator in 2015 and was given the additional responsibility of coaching the wide receivers in 2019 after Chad O'Shea left the Patriots to become the Miami Dolphins' offensive coordinator.
- In his 15 seasons as an NFL and collegiate coach, Judge has been a part of five championship teams. He was on the Patriots' staff when they won Super Bowls XLIX, LI and LIII. New England reached the playoffs in every one of Judge's eight seasons and played in the AFC Championship Game in each his first seven seasons with the team. In addition, he coached at the University of Alabama when the Crimson Tide won BCS titles in 2009 and 2011.
- Judge spent the previous 11 seasons working under two of the most successful coaches in football history in Nick Saban and Bill Belichick.
- Under Judge's leadership in 2019, the Patriots finished ninth in the NFL in three significant special teams categories - punt return (8.0-yard average) and punt (6.3) and kickoff coverage (20.9). They were 17th in kickoff returns with an average of 22.1 yards on 26 runbacks.
- Under Judge's tutelage, kicker Stephen Gostkowski led the NFL in scoring four times and was elected to the Pro Bowl in 2013, 2014 and 2015. With 156 points in 2017, Gostkowski became the first player in NFL history with five 150-point seasons. He is one of three players to lead the league in scoring in at least five seasons. While playing under Judge, Gostkowski was named AFC Special Teams Player of the Week five times and AFC Special Teams Player of the Month three times.
- Judge began his coaching career at his alma mater, Mississippi State, where he was a graduate assistant from 2005-07. He served as the special teams/linebackers coach at Birmingham-Southern in 2008. The following year, he began a three-year stint as a football analyst/special teams assistant under Saban at Alabama.
- The Crimson Tide special teams were consistently outstanding during Judge's tenure. They boasted a first-team All-America kicker and Groza Award finalist (Leigh Tiffin, 2009), a first-team All-America return specialist (Javier Arenas, 2009), an SEC all-freshman punter (Cody Mandell, 2010) and a returner who finished his career ranked second all-time in NCAA return yards (Arenas).
- Judge was born in Philadelphia, where his father, Joseph, played football at Temple and later with the Hamilton Tiger-cats of the CFL.
- Judge played at Mississippi State from 2000-04, earning three letters. He and his wife, Amber, a former Mississippi State soccer player, have four children - Sean, Michael, Emma Riley and Ella Grace.

Families should not have to worry about the safety of their children because of the color of their skin. Change for the black community must happen now and we must lead by our collective actions.

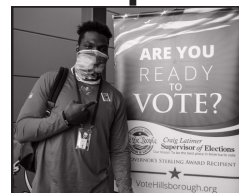
