

• Since the start of the 2020 season, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.1%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (16). Led by Pro Bowl right tackle Tristan Wirfs, the Buccaneers finished first in the NFL in 2022 in both fewest sacks allowed (22) and fewest sacks per pass attempt (2.8%).
