THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

· Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). Over his last eight quarters of regular season football, Brady



threw for 1,067 yards and 10 touchdowns with just one interception.

- The Buccaneers offense scored a touchdown on 42-of-61 trips inside the red zone this season, while leading the NFL with a 95.1 scoring percentage (58-of-61) on red zone drives.
- · The team found success through the air in the red zone, recording 27 red zone passing touchdowns, tied for the second-most in the NFL this season.






CONNECTIONS

COACHING CONNECTIONS

- Head Coach Bruce Arians (1998-2000, 2012) coached Cowboys Quarterbacks Coach Doug Nussmeier (1998) while with the Indianapolis Colts. Nussmeier (2012-13) and Buccaneers Assistant Tight Ends Coach John Van Dam (2012-13) worked together on the same coaching staff for Alabama.
- Offensive Line Coach Joe Gilbert (2012-17) and Cowboys Offensive Line Coach Joe Philbin (2016-2017) coached together for the Indianapolis Colts.
- Defensive Quality Control Coach **Tim Atkins** (2006-08) and Cowboys Defensive Coordinator **Dan Quinn** (2005-06) worked together for the Miami Dolphins.
- Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2008–11) coached Cowboys Defensive Backs Coach **Al Harris** (2010) while with the Miami Dolphins. Bowles (2001–04) and Cowboys Sr. Defensive Assistant **George Edwards** (2004) coached together for the Cleveland Browns. Bowles (2008–11), Defensive Quality Control Coach **Tim Atkins** (2006–08) and George Edwards (2005–09) coached together for the Miami Dolphins.

- Buccaneers DL Ndamukong Suh (2010-2014) and Cowboys Offensive Coordinator Kellen Moore (2012-14) played together for the Detroit Lions.
- Additionally, Suh (2015-17) played under Cowboys Offensive Line Coach Joe Philbin (2012-15) who served as the head coach for the Miami Dolphins.
- Buccaneers LB Kevin Minter (2009-12) played under Cowboys Tight Ends Coach Lunda Wells (2008-09) while at LSU.
- Tampa Bay DL Rakeem Nunez-Roches (2015-17) played under Cowboys Defensive Backs Coach Al Harris (2013-18) while with the Kansas City Chiefs.
- Cowboys DE Tarell Basham (2018-20) and CB Maurice Canady (2019) played under the defensive staff of Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles (2000, 2015-18), Defensive Quality Control Coach Tim Atkins (2016-18) and Defensive Line Coach Kacy Rodgers (2015-18) while with the New York Jets.
- Cowboys CB C.J. Goodwin (2017) played under Bruce Arians (2013-17) and the majority of the Buccaneers coaching staff while with the Arizona Cardinals.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

MIKE MCCARTHY



The Dallas Cowboys named Mike McCarthy the ninth head coach in franchise history on Jan. 8, 2020.

McCarthy came to Dallas with 13 years of head coaching experience and 13 additional years as an assistant coach in the NFL, including six as an offensive coordinator.

As a head coach, McCarthy has racked up a 131-87-2 regular season record - with the Green Bay Packers (2006-18) and Dallas Cowboys (2020) - and he owns the sixthmost wins (27th all-time) among active NFL coaches. His teams have qualified for

the postseason nine times, won six NFC North Division titles, made four NFC Championship Game appearances and took home a Super Bowl XLV championship.

MIKE MCCARTHY AT A GLANCE

- In his first season, McCarthy guided the Cowboys to a 6-10 record, while overcoming four different starting quarterbacks and eight starting offensive line combinations. In total, the club lost 152 games played and 127 starts to injury.
- McCarthy launched his head coaching career with Green Bay on Jan. 12, 2006, and in 12-plus years as their head coach, he guided one of the most successful stretches in franchise history, reaching the postseason in eight consecutive seasons (2009–16). With his Super Bowl XLV victory, McCarthy joined Vince Lombardi and Mike Holmgren as the only coaches to guide the Packers to a Super Bowl win.
- Known as a prolific offensive mind and the primary play-caller McCarthy's Packers offense finished fourth in the NFL in total offense (364.4) and third in points-per-game (26.0) in total through his tenure with the club. Behind the arm of Aaron Rodgers, over that same span, the Packers were third in passing offense. Additionally, over the course of 13 years with the Packers, his offenses regularly ranked in the top10 in passing yards (10 times), total offense (nine) and scoring offense (nine).
- In Week 6 of 2015, McCarthy earned the 100th regular season win of his career in just his 150th game, making him the seventh-fastest coach in NFL history and the then fastest current NFL coach to reach the 100-win plateau. Two years later in Week 6 of 2017, McCarthy coached his 200th career game, including postseason, and having compiled 128 victories, he tied Bud Grant and Chuck Noll for the sixth-most wins by a head coach through 200 games.
- McCarthy is only the fourth head coach in NFL history to lead a single franchise to eight-or-more consecutive playoff appearances, joining Tom Landry, Noll and Bill Belichick. Those eight appearances from 2009-16 were more than the rest of the NFC North Division combined over that span (Minnesota, three; Detroit, three; Chicago, one).
