# STEERING THE SHIP

## A BATTLE ATOP THE NFC SOUTH



Dating back to Week 4 of the 2021 season, Tampa Bay has held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 38 of the last 39 weeks, winning back-to-back NFC South division titles.

The NFC South is the only division in which all four teams have reached the Super Bowl in the last 15 years (2009-23). The Buccaneers last reached, and won, the Super Bowl following the 2020 season, while the Falcons last reached following the 2016 season.

Tampa Bay has won 5-of-6 meetings vs. Atlanta dating back to the start of the 2020 season and has outscored the Falcons 191-141 during that span.

# OFFENSIVE NOTES

## A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

· Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.



· Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

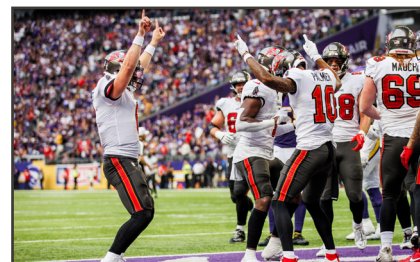

# OFFENSIVE NOTES

## PROFICIENCY IN PASS PROTECTION

• Since the arrival of All-Pro tackle Tristan Wirfs in 2020, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.1%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (17). So far in 2023, the Buccaneers have allowed just five sacks through Week 6 (1st in the NFL).

# DEFENSIVE NOTES

## RAISING THE LEVEL IN THE REDZONE



• Through Week 6, Tampa Bay has allowed its opponents to reach the end zone on just 23.1% of redzone drives, the best defensive mark in the NFL this season. Tampa Bay's three redzone touchdowns are also the fewest allowed in the NFL this season.

• The Buccaneers have allowed just 1.2 yards per play inside the redzone, which ranks second in the NFL.

## STOPPING THE RUN



• The Buccaneers defense has held 4-of-5 opponents this season under 75 yards rushing - the most-such games in the NFL this season.

• In addition, the average distance of first contact with the opponent's rusher has come within a yard of the line of scrimmage - the

second-lowest yards before contact per rush average in the NFL through Week 6.

# ARTHUR SMITH



Arthur Smith was named the 18th head coach in Atlanta Falcons history on January 15, 2021 and took over the club after serving as the Tennessee Titans offensive coordinator for the previous two seasons (2019-2020).

In 2022, Atlanta finished with a 7-10 record, winning six games at Mercedes-Benz Stadium - the most since the stadium opened in 2017. Under Smith's guidance, the Falcons led the NFL in fewest penalties, finished third in the league in rushing yards per game

and 10th in third-down conversion rate.

Atlanta's rushing attack averaged 74.5 more rushing yards per game in 2022 than it did in 2021, resulting in the largest oneseason improvement by any team since at least 2001.

## ARTHUR SMITH AT A GLANCE

- In his first year at the helm, the Falcons posted a 7-10 record. Under Smith's guidance, nine-year veteran running back Cordarrelle Patterson set single-season career highs for rushing yards (618), receiving yards (548), rushing touchdowns (six) and receiving touchdowns (five), and became the first player to record at least five rushing and five receiving touchdowns in a single season in franchise history. Additionally, tight end Kyle Pitts became the second rookie tight end to surpass 1,000 receiving yards in NFL history, joining Pro Football Hall of Famer Mike Ditka (1,076 yards in 1961).
- Prior to his tenure in Atlanta, Smith orchestrated one of the NFL's top offenses with the Titans (2019-20), leading the league in red-zone touchdown percentage (75.2), ranking fifth points per game (27.9) and fifth in total offense (379.6). He oversaw the second-ranked rushing attack in the NFL, averaging 153.5 yards per game on the ground. He oversaw Derrick Henry become just the eighth player in NFL history to rush for more than 2,000 yards in a single season.
- In 2019, Smith helped lead the Titans to the team's first AFC Championship Game appearance in 17 years.
- In Tennessee, Smith worked his way up from his 2011 position of defensive assistant/quality control coach. He also spent time as an offensive assistant/quality control coach (2012), offensive line/tight ends assistant (2013), and assistant tight ends coach (2014-15) before taking over as tight ends coach during the 2015 season and holding the position through 2018.
- Prior to joining the Titans, Smith spent two years as the defensive quality control coach for the Washington Football Team from 2007-08. He also worked as a college scouting assistant in Washington in 2007. In 2010, Smith worked at Ole Miss as an administrative assistant/defensive intern, primarily working with the linebackers.
- Smith graduated from North Carolina where he played offensive line and later joined the Tar Heels coaching staff as a graduate assistant (2006), working with the offensive line. Born and raised in Memphis, Tenn., he went to high school at Georgetown Prep (North Bethesda, Md.). Smith and his wife, Allison, currently live in Nashville with their two sons, Tanner and Liam, and their daughter, Sophie.
