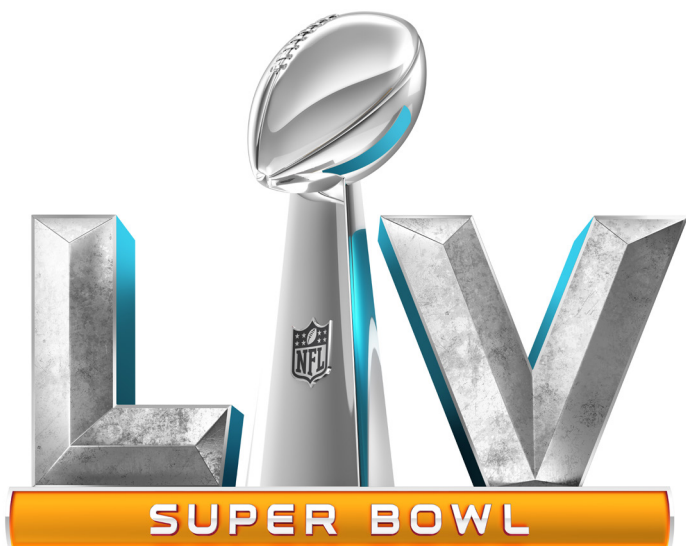

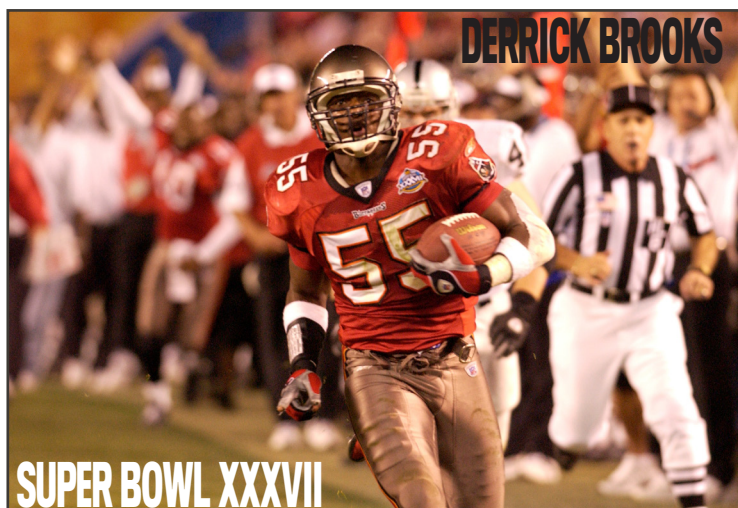

OFFENSIVE NOTES

THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

• Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). Over his last eight quarters of regular season football, Brady threw for 1,067 yards and 10 touchdowns with just one interception.

GETTING RED ZONE RESULTS



• The Buccaneers offense scored a touchdown on 42-of-61 trips inside the red zone this season, while leading the NFL with a 95.1 scoring percentage (58-of-61) on red zone drives.

• The team found success through the air in the red zone, recording 27 red zone passing touchdowns, tied for the second-most in the NFL this season.

A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN

• With 1,006 yards in 2020, Mike Evans became the first player in NFL history with 1,000-or-more receiving yards in each of his first seven NFL seasons, surpassing Randy Moss (first six seasons).

• Evans set a new franchise record with 13 receiving touchdowns (fourth in the NFL) and is Tampa Bay's all-time leader in receptions, receiving yards and receiving touchdowns.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- Dating back to the regular season, the Buccaneers have scored **at least 30 points in six consecutive contests**, the longest streak in team history. With **at least 30 points in Super Bowl LV**, the Buccaneers would be the first NFL team to post at least seven consecutive games with at least 30 points since the Denver Broncos set an NFL record with 12 consecutive games (2012-13). The last team to score at least 30 points in seven consecutive games in the same season were the 2010 New England Patriots (eight consecutive games, Weeks 10-17).

TOM BRADY

- Brady's **860 passing yards** are the second-most in Buccaneers postseason history. He needs **13 more** to pass Brad Johnson (872) for the most postseason passing yards in team history.
- Brady has thrown for **860 passing yards** this postseason. He needs **145 more** to pass Aaron Rodgers (1,004 in 2016) for 10th-most, **155 more** to pass Matt Ryan (1,014 in 2016) for ninth-most, **175 more** to pass Peyton Manning (1,034 in 2006) for eighth-most, **204 more** to pass Kurt Warner (1,063 in 1999) for seventh-most, **235 more** to pass Rodgers (1,094 in 2010) for sixth-most, **273 more** to pass his own mark (1,132 in 2017) for fifth-most, **278 more** to pass his own mark (1,137 in 2016) for fourth-most, **281 more** to pass Joe Flacco (1,140 in 2012) for third-most, **288 more** to pass Warner (1,147 in 2008) for the second-most and **360 passing yards** to surpass Eli Manning (1,219 in 2011) for the most passing yards in a single postseason in NFL history.
- Brady has **860 passing yards this postseason** and **if he reaches 1,000**, he will be the first player in NFL history to throw for 1,000 yards in three separate postseasons (currently tied at two with Aaron Rodgers and Kurt Warner).
- Brady has thrown **seven touchdowns this postseason**. He needs **two more** to tie Eli Manning (nine in 2011), Peyton Manning (nine in 2003), Aaron Rodgers (nine in both 2010 & 2016), Matt Ryan (nine in 2016) and Steve Young (nine in 1994) for sixth-most, **three more** to tie his own mark (10 in 2014) and Patrick Mahomes (10 in 2019) for fourth-most and **four more** to tie Joe Flacco (11 in 2012), Joe Montana (11 in 1989) and Kurt Warner (11 in 2008) for the most passing touchdowns in a single postseason in NFL history.

SHAQUIL BARRETT

- Barrett has **3.0 sacks this postseason**. He needs **one more** to tie Smieon Rice (4.0 in 2002) for the most sacks in a single postseason in team history.



ANTONIO BROWN

- Brown has **five career 100-yard games in the postseason**. He needs **one more** to tie Julian Edelman and Michael Irvin (six each) for the second-most 100-yard receiving games in NFL postseason history.
- Brown has **two career games with multiple touchdown receptions in the postseason**, tied for the ninth-most such games in NFL history. He needs **one more** to tie for the second-most such games in NFL postseason history.
- Brown has **896 career postseason receiving yards**, the fourth-most among active players. He needs **47 more** to pass Larry Fitzgerald (942) for the third-most postseason receiving yards among active players.
- Including regular season and postseason, Brown has **12,642 career receiving yards**, the 28th-most in NFL history. He needs **21 more** to pass Derrick Mason (12,662 from 2007-2015) for the 27th-most receiving yards in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).
- Including regular season and postseason, Brown has **84 career touchdown receptions**, the 30th-most in NFL history. He needs **one more** to tie Harold Carmichael, Calvin Johnson and Tommy McDonald (85) for 27th-most and **two more** to tie Fred Biletnikoff and Irving Fryar (86) for 25th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

MIKE EVANS

- Evans has **two touchdown receptions** this postseason, tied with Keenan McCardell for the most in Buccaneers postseason history and the most in a single Buccaneers postseason. With **one touchdown reception** in Super Bowl LV, he would set a new franchise record in each.
- Evans has **173 postseason receiving yards**. He needs **25 more** receiving yards to surpass Joe Jurevicius (197) for third-most, **51 more** to surpass Chris Godwin (223-active) for second-most and **202 more** to surpass Keyshawn Johnson (375) for the most postseason receiving yards in franchise history.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR

LEONARD FOURNETTE

- Fournette has **three touchdowns this postseason**. He needs **one more** to tie Mike Alstott (four in 2002) for the most touchdowns in a single postseason in team history.
- Fournette has **313 yards from scrimmage** in the postseason with Tampa Bay. He needs **30 more** to surpass Michael Pittman (342) for fourth-most, **63 more** to surpass Keyshawn Johnson (375) for third-most, **75 more** to surpass Warrick Dunn for second-most and **190 more** to surpass Mike Alstott (502) for the most scrimmage yards in Buccaneers postseason history.
- Fournette has **211 rushing yards** in the postseason with Tampa Bay. He needs **nine more** to surpass Warrick Dunn (219) for second-most and **131 more** to surpass Mike Alstott (341) for the most rushing yards in Buccaneers postseason history.



CHRIS GODWIN

- Godwin's has **223 postseason receiving yards** – the most in single Buccaneers postseason. He needs **153 more** receiving yards to surpass Keyshawn Johnson for the most receiving yards in Buccaneers postseason history (career).

RYAN SUCCOP

- Succop has made **eight field goals this postseason**. He needs **one more** to tie David Akers (nine in 2008), Steve Christie (nine in 1992), John Kasay (nine in 2003) and Chuck Nelson (nine in 1987) for third-most, **two more** to tie Brandon McManus (10 in 2015) for second-most and **six more** to tie Adam Vinatieri (14 in 2006) for the most field goals made in a single postseason.
- Succop has **32 points this postseason**. He needs **four more** to tie many players for fifth-most (36 points), **seven more** to tie Steve Christie (39 in 1992) for fourth-most, **10 more** to tie Larry Fitzgerald (42 in 2008) for third-most, **16 more** to tie Terrell Davis (48 in 1997) for second-most and **17 more** to tie Adam Vinatieri for the most points in a single postseason.



ROB GRONKOWSKI

- Gronkowski has **1,206 postseason receiving yards**, seventh-most in NFL history. He needs **24 more** to pass Andre Reed (1,229) for sixth-most, **49 more** to pass Reggie Wayne (1,254) for fifth-most, **84 more** to pass Cliff Branch for fourth-most and **110 more** to pass Michael Irvin for the third-most postseason receiving yards in NFL history.
- Gronkowski has **four career 100-yard games** in the postseason. He needs **one more** to surpass Vernon Davis and tie Travis Kelce for the most such games by a tight end in NFL postseason history. With one more 100-yard receiving game, Gronkowski would tie Antonio Brown, Larry Fitzgerald, Travis Kelce, Andre Reed, John Stallworth and Hines Ward for the fourth-most 100-yard receiving games in NFL postseason history.
- Gronkowski has **three career games with multiple touchdown receptions** in the postseason, tied for the second-most such games in NFL history. He needs **one more** to have the second-most such games in NFL postseason history.
- Gronkowski has **98 receiving touchdowns** (regular & postseason combined) and needs **two more** to tie Don Hutson (100) for the 11th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

SEAN MURPHY-BUNTING

- Murphy-Bunting's **three interceptions** are tied for the most in Buccaneers postseason history. He needs **one more** to set the record for the most interceptions in Buccaneers postseason history.
- Murphy-Bunting has **three interceptions this postseason**. He needs **one more** to tie Eric Davis (four in 1994), A.J. Duhe (four in 1982), Darrien Gordon (four in 1998), Rodney Harrison (four in 2004), Rick Manning (four in 2003), Emmitt Thomas (four in 1969) and Dennis Thurman (four in 1982) for third-most and **two more** to tie Lester Hayes (five in 1980) and Vernon Perry (five in 1979) for the most interceptions in a postseason in NFL history. With **one more**, Murphy-Bunting will join Rodney Harrison (4) and Aeneas Williams (4) for the most-consecutive postseason games with an interception. He would become the only player in league history to do so in a single postseason.

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- When Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians** and multiple members of his current Tampa Bay staff were in Arizona, the organization selected Chiefs S **Tyrann Mathieu** with the 69th overall pick in the 2013 NFL Draft. Mathieu became one of the league's best safeties while working under Arians and his staff, becoming a Pro Bowler and First-Team All-Pro in the 2015 season after recording single-season career-high five interceptions to go along with 17 passes defended and 11 tackles for loss.
- Buccaneers OLB **Jason Pierre-Paul** (2010-17), CB **Ross Cockrell** (2017) and S **Andrew Adams** (2016-17) all played for the New York Giants when Chiefs Defensive Coordinator **Steve Spagnuolo** (2007-08, 2015-17) was the defensive coordinator and interim head coach for the organization.
- Buccaneers RB **Ronald Jones II** (2015-17) played at USC when Chiefs Running Backs Coach **Deland McCullough** held the same position for the Trojans that year.
- Buccaneers QB **Tom Brady** (2000-19) played for the New England Patriots when Chiefs Quarterbacks Coach/Pass Game Coordinator **Mike Kafka** (2013) also played quarterback in New England. Brady also played with Chiefs Wide Receivers Coach **Greg Lewis**, who was a receiver in New England in 2009.



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Buccaneers General Manager **Jason Licht** worked in the personnel department for the Philadelphia Eagles from 2003-07 while Chiefs Head Coach **Andy Reid** (1999-2012) and various members of the Kansas City staff coached the Eagles. The Eagles finished first in the NFC East in three of the five years Licht and Reid worked together, including a 2004 season that saw the franchise post a 13-3 regular season record and advance to Super Bowl XXXIX where it narrowly lost to Buccaneers QB Tom Brady and the New England Patriots.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** spent the 2012 season in Philadelphia as the secondary coach/interim defensive coordinator, working under Chiefs Head Coach **Andy Reid** (1999-2012). Buccaneers Inside Linebackers Coach **Mike Caldwell** spent multiple seasons with Reid in Philadelphia, holding multiple positions on the defensive coaching staff from 2007-12 after playing linebacker for Reid from 1998-2001.
- Buccaneers Offensive Line Coach **Joe Gilbert** (1994-99) was the offensive line coach and offensive coordinator at Maine when Chiefs Defensive Coordinator **Steve Spagnuolo** (1993-94) was the defensive coordinator for the program in the 1994 season.
- Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** played quarterback for the Jacksonville Jaguars from 2003-06, working with Chiefs Offensive Line Coach **Andy Heck**, who held the same position and was an assistant at the position for the Jaguars from 2004-12.
- Buccaneers Defensive/Special Teams Assistant **Keith Tandy** played safety for the Buccaneers from 2012-17 and was teammates with Chiefs Quarterbacks Coach/Pass Game Coordinator **Mike Kafka**, who played quarterback for the organization in 2014.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and earned a spot in the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

ANDY REID



Andy Reid is finishing out his eighth season at the helm of the Chiefs in 2020. He was hired as the club's 13th head coach in franchise history on January 7, 2013.

Completing his 22nd season as an NFL head coach, Reid added Super Bowl champion to his resume after he led his squad to a 31-20 come-from-behind win in Super Bowl LIV. He owns a 221-130-1 regular season record and adds a 17-14 postseason record, giving him 238 total wins, which rank third in NFL history and second among active head coaches, trailing only New England Head Coach

Bill Belichick. Reid joined the Chiefs after 14 seasons as Head Coach/Executive Vice President of Football Operations of the Philadelphia Eagles where he compiled a 130-93-1 (.583) regular season record. Including his years as an assistant coach, Reid's teams have made the playoffs 21 times (24-18 record), and he has coached in four Super Bowls and 10 Championship Games (8 NFC, 2 AFC). He owns three NFL Coach of the Year titles.

ANDY REID AT A GLANCE

- Since his arrival in Kansas City, Reid's teams have made it to the playoffs seven out of eight seasons, including back-to-back-to-back AFC Championship Game appearances (2018-20). In eight seasons under Reid, the Chiefs have recorded seven 10-plus win seasons and a .711 (91-37) winning percentage, which is the top mark in franchise history for any coach in his first eight seasons leading the club.
- In 2019, Reid's 12-4 Chiefs finished the regular season as AFC West Champs for a franchise-record fourth-straight season and secured the No. 2 seed in the AFC. The club defeated Tennessee 35-24 in the AFC Championship Game on it's way to returning to the Super Bowl for the third time in franchise history and first since the club won Super Bowl IV following the 1969 season. In Super Bowl LIV in Miami, Florida, Reid's Chiefs fell behind 20-10.
- Reid joined Philadelphia as head coach in 1999 and remained in that role through the 2012 season, becoming one of just 11 first-time NFL head coaches to lead 12-or-more seasons with the same club. Reid assumed the additional role of Executive Vice President of Football Operations in 2001.
- While compiling his 10-9 postseason record with Philadelphia, Reid led the Eagles franchise to one Super Bowl appearance, a game that saw Philadelphia fall by a mere field goal to the New England Patriots in Super Bowl XXXIX following the 2004 season. Reid guided Philadelphia to nine playoff appearances (2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010) during his 14-year tenure in the City of Brotherly Love. During that time period, only Indianapolis (12) and New England (10) had more postseason appearances than the Eagles.
- In 2008, Reid became the 37th coach to reach the 100-win plateau and the 22nd to win 100 games with one franchise. He overcame a 5-5-1 start to reach the NFC Championship Game.
- During his seven years with the Packers, Reid served as the tight ends coach and assistant offensive line coach (1992-96) and as quarterbacks coach (1997-98). In his span with the Packers, the team reached the playoffs six times and represented the NFC twice in back-to-back Super Bowls, defeating New England in Super Bowl XXXI and falling to Denver in Super Bowl XXXII.
- Reid coached collegiately at Missouri, UTEP, Northern Arizona and San Francisco State.
- He played collegiately as an offensive tackle and guard at BYU from 1979-81 before entering the coaching ranks as a graduate assistant at BYU under LaVell Edwards in 1982.
- The Los Angeles native and his wife, Tammy, have five children and nine grandchildren.

Families should not have to worry about the safety of their children because of the color of their skin. Change for the black community must happen now and we must lead by our collective actions.

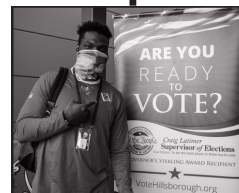
