OFFENSIVE NOTES

A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

· In Week 13, Mike Evans reached the 1,000-yard mark for the 10th consecutive season - the longest-such streak to begin a career and the second-longest streak overall in league history.

· He is also the first player ever with 60+ receptions in each of his first 10 career seasons.



· Evans now has five career seasons with 1,000+ receiving yards and 10-or-more receiving touchdowns, which tie him for the fifth-most in NFL history. Every other player with at least as many seasons as Evans is a member of the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

· Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.

· Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

NO SIGNS OF AGING HERE: LAVONTE DAVID IS PLAYING AT AN ALL-PRO LEVEL IN YEAR 12



· In Week 11, Lavonte David surpassed Rondé Barber (1,428) for the second-most tackles in franchise history.

· From Week 6 through Week 11, Lavonte David had four more tackles for loss (11) than any other player. He also ranked third in the NFL during that span in tackles (62) before injuring his groin.

· Antoine Winfield Jr. is tied for first in the league with three fumble recoveries this season, matching his single-season career high.

· He is 1-of-2 players in the league with three-or-more forced fumbles and three-or-more fumble recoveries this season, alongside Steelers edge rusher T.J. Watt.

· Winfield Jr. is the first defensive back since Hall of Famer Brian Dawkins and Roy Williams in 2002 with three-or more forced fumbles, three-or-more fumble recoveries, two-plus interceptions and 2.0-plus sacks in a single season.

· Buccaneers rookies Yaya Diaby and Calijah Kancey have combined for 15 tackles for loss, 15 quarterback hits, 8.0 sacks and 45 total pressures this season.

· Kancey, the reigning NFL Defensive Rookie of the Month, is the only rookie with 25-or-more pressures on fewer than

350 defensive snaps, per TruMedia data. Meanwhile, Diaby is 1-of-3 rookies with 5.0+ sacks, five-plus tackles for loss and five-or-more quarterback hits this season (Will Anderson Jr. and Kobie Turner).

IN THE COMMUNITY

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

· On Tuesday afternoon, the Tampa Bay Buccaneers and Habitat for Humanity of Hillsborough will continue their community partnership to address affordable housing in Hillsborough County. Ahead of the holiday season, over 90% of the Buccaneers roster has donated funds towards the construction of a home for a family in need, with the Buccaneers organization matching their contributions to fund the construction of two Habitat homes in the Temple Terrace community.

· Tuesday served as the second of two volunteer sessions, as the parties are set to revisit the homes they first worked on last month as part of the player-led Buccaneers Youth Leadership Program. This session featured 25 students from Webb Middle School set to join Buccaneers players, staff and "Bigs in Badges" from the Tampa Police Department in beautification projects, such as painting and landscaping.

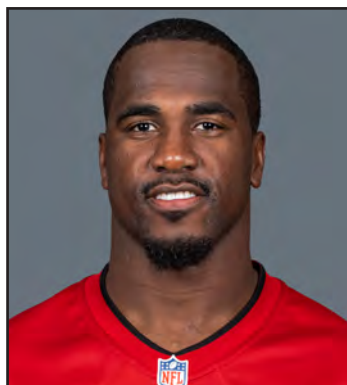

WHAT TO WATCH FOR



LAVONTE DAVID

- Needs **10 tackles** to mark his 10th career season with 100-or-more tackles, joining London Fletcher (14) and Bobby Wagner (11) as the only players to accomplish that feat since 2000.
- Needs **1 tackle for loss** to tie himself (2014), Gerald McCoy (2014) and Jason Pierre-Paul (2018) for the longest streak of games with at least one tackle for loss within a season by a Buccaneers player since tackles for loss became an official statistic in 2006.



MIKE EVANS

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie and **2 receiving touchdowns** to surpass Rob Gronkowski (92) for the 12th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie Mike Williams (11 in 2010) for the fifth-most receiving touchdowns in a single season in franchise history.
- Needs **2 receiving touchdowns** to tie himself (12 in 2014 and 2016) for the third-most receiving touchdowns in a single season in franchise history.
- Needs **3 receiving touchdowns** to tie himself (13 in 2020) for the second-most receiving touchdowns in a single season in franchise history.
- Needs **4 receiving touchdowns** to tie himself (14 in 2021) for the franchise record for single-season touchdown receptions.
- Needs **1 total touchdown** to tie Rob Gronkowski and Jim Taylor (93) for the 30th-most overall touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **2 total touchdowns** to tie Jerome Bettis, Priest Holmes and Marshawn Lynch (94) for the 27th-most overall touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **2 receiving yards** to surpass Muhsin Muhammad (11,438) for the 34th-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Needs **183 receiving yards** to surpass Calvin Johnson (11,438) for the 33rd-most receiving yards in NFL history. He will also pass Johnson for the sixth-most receiving yards by a player through his first 10 seasons in league history.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR

CHRIS GODWIN

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie Jimmie Giles (34) and surpass Cameron Brate (33) for the second-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs **1 reception** to join Mike Evans as the only players in team history with 500+ receptions for Tampa Bay. He will become just the 28th player in league history with 500-or-more receptions in his first 100 career games.
- Needs **1 game played** to hit the 100 career games milestone.



YAYA DIABY

- Needs **1.5 sacks** to tie Gaines Adams (6.0 in 2007) for the third-most sacks by a rookie in team history.
- Needs **3.0 sacks** to surpass Adrian Clayborn (7.5 in 2011) for the second-most sacks by a rookie in team history.

RACHAAD WHITE

- Needs **3 total touchdowns** to tie five players for the 10th-most single-season touchdowns from scrimmage by a running back in team history.
- Needs **74 receiving yards** to join Warrick Dunn as the only players in team history with 1,000+ rushing yards and 750+ receiving yards over the player's first two career seasons.
- Needs **200 scrimmage yards** to become the eighth player in Buccaneers team history with 2,000 scrimmage yards over the player's first two career seasons.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Named 2014 Assistant Coach of the Year by the Pro Football Writers Association and the Associated Press.
- X The architect of Tampa Bay's Super Bowl LV-winning defense during the 2020 NFL season.
- X Bowles' defenses have finished inside the top five in fewest yards per play five times (2013, 2015, 2019, 2020, 2021).
- X Placing a heavy emphasis on stopping the run, Bowles' defenses have led the NFL in fewest rushing yards allowed per game three times (2014, 2019, 2020).
- X 24 different players have earned Pro Bowl selections with Bowles as their position coach, defensive coordinator or head coach.
- X Enjoyed an eight-year career as an NFL defensive back, playing for Washington (1986-1990, 1992-93) and the San Francisco 49ers.
- X Started 12 games and contributed four interceptions for a Washington team that won Super Bowl XXII.

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019-21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Joined Jon Gruden as the only coaches in franchise history to win a division title in their first year as head coach.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached six different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021), Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021) and Tristan Wirfs (2022).
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-to-back seasons from 2019-20.
- X In his three seasons as defensive coordinator, Tampa Bay ranked first in fewest rushing yards allowed per game (82.5), first in fewest rushing yards per attempt (3.72), first in quarterback hits (352), first in fumble recoveries (37), first in passes defensed (241), second in strip sacks (26), third in tackles for loss (262), third in takeaways (82), third in sacks (142), fourth in forced fumbles (52), tied for fourth in defensive touchdowns (nine), fifth in fewest yards per play allowed (5.13) and fifth in passing yards per attempt allowed (6.78).

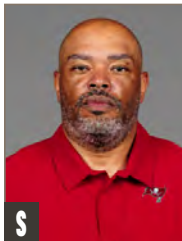

ARTHUR SMITH



Arthur Smith was named the 18th head coach in Atlanta Falcons history on January 15, 2021 and took over the club after serving as the Tennessee Titans offensive coordinator for the previous two seasons (2019-2020).

In 2022, Atlanta finished with a 7-10 record, winning six games at Mercedes-Benz Stadium - the most since the stadium opened in 2017. Under Smith's guidance, the Falcons led the NFL in fewest penalties, finished third in the league in rushing yards per game

and 10th in third-down conversion rate.

Atlanta's rushing attack averaged 74.5 more rushing yards per game in 2022 than it did in 2021, resulting in the largest oneseason improvement by any team since at least 2001.

ARTHUR SMITH AT A GLANCE

- In his first year at the helm, the Falcons posted a 7-10 record. Under Smith's guidance, nine-year veteran running back Cordarrelle Patterson set single-season career highs for rushing yards (618), receiving yards (548), rushing touchdowns (six) and receiving touchdowns (five), and became the first player to record at least five rushing and five receiving touchdowns in a single season in franchise history. Additionally, tight end Kyle Pitts became the second rookie tight end to surpass 1,000 receiving yards in NFL history, joining Pro Football Hall of Famer Mike Ditka (1,076 yards in 1961).
- Prior to his tenure in Atlanta, Smith orchestrated one of the NFL's top offenses with the Titans (2019-20), leading the league in red-zone touchdown percentage (75.2), ranking fifth points per game (27.9) and fifth in total offense (379.6). He oversaw the second-ranked rushing attack in the NFL, averaging 153.5 yards per game on the ground. He oversaw Derrick Henry become just the eighth player in NFL history to rush for more than 2,000 yards in a single season.
- In 2019, Smith helped lead the Titans to the team's first AFC Championship Game appearance in 17 years.
- In Tennessee, Smith worked his way up from his 2011 position of defensive assistant/quality control coach. He also spent time as an offensive assistant/quality control coach (2012), offensive line/tight ends assistant (2013), and assistant tight ends coach (2014-15) before taking over as tight ends coach during the 2015 season and holding the position through 2018.
- Prior to joining the Titans, Smith spent two years as the defensive quality control coach for the Washington Football Team from 2007-08. He also worked as a college scouting assistant in Washington in 2007. In 2010, Smith worked at Ole Miss as an administrative assistant/defensive intern, primarily working with the linebackers.
- Smith graduated from North Carolina where he played offensive line and later joined the Tar Heels coaching staff as a graduate assistant (2006), working with the offensive line. Born and raised in Memphis, Tenn., he went to high school at Georgetown Prep (North Bethesda, Md.). Smith and his wife, Allison, currently live in Nashville with their two sons, Tanner and Liam, and their daughter, Sophie.
