## THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

• Tom Brady joined Drew Brees as the only players in NFL history with 40-or-more touchdown passes in back-to-back seasons and threw for the third-most passing yards in a single season in NFL history (5,316).

**Brady also became just the third player in NFL history to lead the league in yards, touchdowns, completions and attempts in a season.**

## THE GIFT OF 'GRONK'

• Since returning from injury in Week 11, Gronkowski ranks second among all NFL tight ends with 618 receiving yards. He also ranks third among all tight ends in receiving yards/game this season (66.8).



• In Week 18 vs. Carolina, Gronkowski hauled in seven receptions for 137 yards, the second-most receiving yards by a tight end in a single game in franchise history.

• It was the 32nd 100-yard receiving performance for Gronkowski, surpassing Tony Gonzalez (31) for the most-such games by a tight end in NFL history.

## A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN

• With 1,035 yards in 2021, Mike Evans became the first player in NFL history with 1,000-or-more receiving yards in each of his first eight NFL seasons, surpassing Randy Moss (first six seasons). His 8 consecutive 1,000-yard seasons are tied for the third-longest streak in NFL history at any point in a player's career. Evans also finished second in the NFL in receiving touchdowns (14).

## THE BUZZ AROUND BOWLES' DEFENSE



Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020 and ranking ninth overall since 2019.

# HC BRUCE ARIANS

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

## ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

## TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X The Buccaneers set a franchise record with 13 wins in 2021, while clinching the organization's first NFC South Divisional title since 2007. Tampa Bay finished with the league's second-best yardage differential and fourth-best point differential for the 2021 regular season. The Buccaneers led the NFL in passing yards per game and ranked second in the league in both total yards per game and points scored per game.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its third-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.

## INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

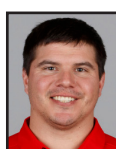

# NICK SIRIANNI



Nick Sirianni was named head coach of the Philadelphia Eagles on January 24, 2021, following a productive three-year stint as the Indianapolis Colts' offensive coordinator. With Sirianni directing the Colts' offense, Indianapolis ranked sixth in third-down conversions (43.4 pct.), seventh in red zone touchdown efficiency (63.9 pct.) and eighth in offensive points per game (24.4), while surrendering the second-fewest sacks (71) in the league, during the 2018-20 seasons. In that span, the Colts combined for a 28-20 record (.583 winning percentage), including a pair of 10-plus-win campaigns, and made two playoff appearances.

## NICK SIRIANNI AT A GLANCE

- During an 11-5 season in 2020, Sirianni oversaw a Colts offense that posted the 10th-most total yards per game (378.1) in the NFL and allowed the second-fewest sacks (21, tied) as well as the third-fewest giveaways (15). Additionally, rookie running back Jonathan Taylor (1,169 yards) ranked third among the league's rushing leaders and tied for the most rushing scores (11) by a rookie since Ezekiel Elliott in 2016 (15).
- Under Sirianni, guard Quenton Nelson achieved first-team All-Pro and Pro Bowl honors after each of his first three NFL seasons (2018-20) while center Ryan Kelly secured back-to-back trips to the Pro Bowl (2019-20) along with second-team All-Pro recognition (2020). In 2018, Sirianni's first season leading Indianapolis' offense, quarterback Andrew Luck was named Associated Press NFL Comeback Player of the Year and earned his fourth career Pro Bowl nod after ranking second overall with 39 passing touchdowns, behind Patrick Mahomes (50), and producing the league's fifth-most passing yards (4,593).
- Prior to joining the Colts, Sirianni spent five years (2013-17) as a member of the Los Angeles/San Diego Chargers' coaching staff, including two seasons as wide receivers coach (2016-17). In 2017, Sirianni assisted with the top-ranked passing offense (276.9 ypg), which featured a career year from wide receiver Keenan Allen, who was selected as the AP NFL Comeback Player of the Year.
- From 2014-15, Sirianni coached the Chargers' quarterbacks and helped Philip Rivers earn consecutive Pro Bowls while averaging 30 passing touchdowns per season.
- Sirianni began his NFL coaching career with the Kansas City Chiefs (2009-12), serving as wide receivers coach (2012) and offensive quality control coach (2009-11).
- Before entering the NFL coaching ranks, Sirianni spent five years at the collegiate level as wide receivers coach at Indiana University of Pennsylvania (2006-08) and as defensive backs coach at Mount Union (2004-05), his alma mater, where he helped the Purple Raiders capture a national title during the 2005 season.
- A native of Jamestown, NY, Sirianni was a three-year starter at wide receiver at Mount Union (Alliance, OH), winning three NCAA Division III National Championships (2000-02) and earning All-Ohio Athletic Conference honors as a senior after catching a career-high 13 touchdowns. He also played one year in the Atlantic Indoor Football League with the Canton Legends while coaching in 2005.
