

STEERING THE SHIP

RIVALRY RENEWED - A BATTLE TO REMAIN ATOP THE NFC SOUTH



Dating back to Week 4 of the 2021 season, Tampa Bay has held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 35 of the last 36 weeks, winning back-to-back NFC South division titles.

The Buccaneers and Saints have combined to win each of the last six NFC South Division titles. In 2022, Tampa Bay earned a series sweep over the Saints to help claim the division.

The NFC South is the only division in which all four teams have reached the Super Bowl in the last 15 years (2009-23). The Buccaneers last reached, and won, the Super Bowl following the 2020 season, while the Saints last won following the 2009 NFL season.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

• Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.



• Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

THRIVING ON THIRD DOWNS

• Baker Mayfield is leading the league through Week 3 in completion percentage on third-down attempts (78.1%). He also ranks second in passer rating on third down plays (129.4).



• Mayfield also has a 107.2 passer rating when pressured, which ranks as the third-highest mark in the NFL through Week 3.

SOLID UP FRONT

• Since the arrival of All-Pro tackle Tristan Wirfs in 2020, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.1%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (17). So far in 2023, the Buccaneers have allowed just three sacks through Week 3 (t-3rd in the NFL).

GETTING PRODUCTION RIGHT OUT OF THE GATES

· Through Week 3, Evans has racked up 17 receptions for 297 yards (17.5 avg.) and three touchdowns.

· In Week 2 alone, Mike Evans hauled in six receptions for 171 yards and one touchdown. His 28.5 yards per reception were his most in a game (minimum three receptions) since 12/16/18 at Baltimore (30.3).

• The Buccaneers defense has seven takeaways through Week 3 and has been one of the league's best at creating turnovers since **Todd Bowles** took over the defense in 2019. From the start of the 2019 season, Tampa Bay ranks fifth in takeaways (109) and first in points off turnovers (400).

• In 2023, Tampa Bay ranks tied for third in takeaways (seven) and tied for second in interceptions (five).





- X Named 2014 Assistant Coach of the Year by the Pro Football Writers Association and the Associated Press.
- X The architect of Tampa Bay's Super Bowl LV-winning defense during the 2020 NFL season.
- X Bowles' defenses have finished inside the top five in fewest yards per play five times (2013, 2015, 2019, 2020, 2021).
- X Placing a heavy emphasis on stopping the run, Bowles' defenses have led the NFL in fewest rushing yards allowed per game three times (2014, 2019, 2020).
- X 24 different players have earned Pro Bowl selections with Bowles as their position coach, defensive coordinator or head coach.
- X Enjoyed an eight-year career as an NFL defensive back, playing for Washington (1986-1990, 1992-93) and the San Francisco 49ers.

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019-21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Joined Jon Gruden as the only coaches in franchise history to win a division title in their first year as head coach.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached six different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021), Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021) and Tristan Wirfs (2022).
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-to-back seasons from 2019-20.
- X In his three seasons as defensive coordinator, Tampa Bay ranked first in fewest rushing yards allowed per game (82.5), first in fewest rushing yards per attempt (3.72), first in quarterback hits (352), first in fumble recoveries (37), first in passes defended (241), second in strip sacks (26), third in tackles for loss (262), third in takeaways (82), third in sacks (142), fourth in forced fumbles (52), tied for fourth in defensive touchdowns (nine), fifth in fewest yards per play allowed (5.13) and fifth in passing yards per attempt allowed (6.78).

DENNIS ALLEN



Dennis Allen enters his second season as head coach of the New Orleans Saints in 2023 after being named the 17th head coach in franchise history on Feb. 8, 2022. New Orleans went 7-10 in Allen's first season at the helm.

Allen was promoted to head coach after spending the past six-and-a-half seasons as the defensive coordinator of the Saints, during which the team enjoyed five consecutive winning seasons and also captured four-straight NFC South division titles from 2017-20. During his tenure as an assistant under Payton in New Orleans,

Allen has been part of staffs that have qualified for the playoffs seven times, captured the NFC South six times, reached the NFC Championship game three times and won the Super Bowl XLIV championship.

DENNIS ALLEN AT A GLANCE

- During his 22 years of coaching in the NFL, Allen has worked with 10 players who have combined for 23 Pro Bowl selections. He has also coached two AP Defensive Rookie of the Year winners and three members of the Pro Football Hall of Fame.
- In 2022, New Orleans ranked second in the NFL in pass defense (184.4 yards per game), fifth in total defense (314.8 net yards per game), tied for fifth in sacks (48) and ninth in scoring defense (20.3 points per game), coaching both LB Demario Davis and DE Cameron Jordan to the Pro Bowl.
- Offensively in 2022, WR Chris Olave earned a selection to the PFWA All-Rookie Team, leading the team with 72 receptions for 1,042 yards. In addition, RB Alvin Kamara became the only active player with six consecutive seasons of 1,300+ yards from scrimmage.
- Allen previously served as the head coach of the Oakland Raiders from 2012-14, with an 8-28 (.222) record.
- Prior to Oakland, Allen served as defensive coordinator of the Denver Broncos in 2011. He led a defense that helped the Broncos win the AFC West division crown and advance to the AFC Divisional round with an AFC Wild Card game victory.
- During Allen's previous five-year tenure in New Orleans, he first served as assistant defensive line coach (2006-07) before being promoted to secondary coach (2008-10).
- He was a part of a defensive coaching staff that engineered significant improvement from 2009-10, when the club went 24-8 in the regular season, qualified for the playoffs both times and captured Super Bowl XLIV.
- Allen joined the Saints after a four-year stint with the Atlanta Falcons, where he spent his final two years as defensive assistant/quality control with an emphasis on working with the defensive line. Over the previous two seasons, he was in charge of defensive quality control while helping tutor the secondary.
- A native of Hurst, Texas, Allen earned four letters for Texas A&M as a safety from 1992-95. A highlight was his fourth-quarter interception that clinched an 18-9 victory over Texas in 1993, sending the Aggies to their third-straight Cotton Bowl.
