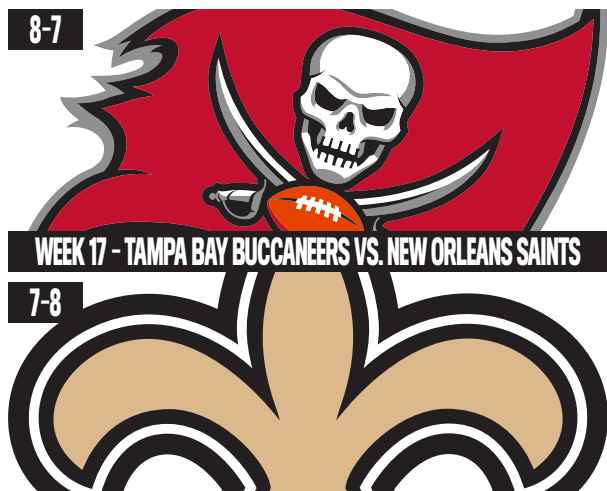

OFFENSIVE NOTES

A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

· In Week 13, Mike Evans reached the 1,000-yard mark for the 10th consecutive season - the longest-such streak to begin a career and the second-longest streak overall in league history. Evans is also the first player ever with 60+ receptions in each of his first 10 career seasons.



· Evans now has five career seasons with 1,000+ receiving yards and 10-or-more receiving touchdowns, which tie him for the fifth-most in NFL history.

· Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark in 2022, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions. Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

A DO-IT-ALL SAFETY



· Antoine Winfield Jr. recorded each a sack, an interception and a fumble recovery in Week 16, joining Buffalo's Terrel Bernard as the only players to do in a single game this season.

· Winfield Jr. leads the league with four fumble recoveries this season, setting a new single-season career high. He also ranks tied for second in the NFL with a career-best five forced fumbles this season.

· He is 1-of-4 players since 2000 with 5.0+ sacks, 5+ takeaways (interceptions + fumble recoveries) and 5+ forced fumbles in a single season, joining T.J. Watt (2019), Justin Tuck (2010) and Terrell Suggs (2003).

· Winfield Jr. is the first defensive back since data became available in 1999 with 5.0+ sacks and 5+ forced fumbles in a single season.

THE VET HAS STILL GOT IT



· Through Week 16, 12-year veteran Lavonte David is the only player in the NFL with 100+ tackles, 15+ tackles for loss and 3.0+ sacks.

· Since 2000, David's 10 seasons with 100+ tackles are the third-most, trailing only London Fletcher (14) and Bobby Wagner

(11). David has four seasons with 100+ tackles and 15+ tackles for loss, while no other player has more than two-such seasons since tackles for loss became regularly tracked in 2008.

· In Week 11, Lavonte David surpassed Rondé Barber (1,428) for the second-most tackles in franchise history.

IN THE COMMUNITY

HABITAT HILLSBOROUGH HOME DEDICATION DAY

Last week, the Tampa Bay Buccaneers and Habitat for Humanity of Hillsborough saw the work of their community partnership, "Holiday Home Build with the Bucs", come to fruition as they handed over the keys to the four families that will inhabit the homes that they have worked on over the course of the last month. In the last month, Buccaneers players and staff have put in volunteer hours at the homes, installing windows and doors and priming the houses.

Prior to the project's start, over 90% of the Buccaneers roster donated funds towards the construction of a home for a family in need, with the Buccaneers organization matching their contributions to fund the construction of two Habitat homes in the Temple Terrace community. Since then, thanks to donations from the Buccaneers fanbase, coined "The Krewe", as well as comedians Bert Kreischer and Tom Segura, the impact has doubled and now the build of four homes along Overlook Drive has been funded.

The project was part of the player-led Buccaneers Youth Leadership Program, with 25 students apiece from Young Middle Magnet School and Webb Middle School volunteering at the homes as well. The Buccaneers Youth Leadership Program is part of the team's Social Justice Initiative, a player-led program created in 2018 with a \$1,000,000 commitment by the Glazer family to break down barriers to racial and social equality.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR



MIKE EVANS

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie himself (14 in 2021) for the franchise record for single-season touchdown receptions.
- Needs **1 total touchdown** to tie Eric Dickerson (96) for the 26th-most overall touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **2 receiving touchdowns** to establish a new franchise record for single-season touchdown receptions.
- Needs 14 points scored to tie **Martín Gramática** (592) for the most points scored in franchise history.
- Needs **4 receiving touchdowns** to tie Cris Carter (1995), Rob Gronkowski (2011), Randy Moss (1998, 2003), Carl Pickens (1995) and Jerry Rice (1989) for the sixth-most single-season receiving touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **5 receiving touchdowns** to tie with Don Hutson (99) for the 11th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs **5 total touchdowns** to tie Frank Gore, Franco Harris and Curtis Martin (100) for the 23rd-most overall touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **6 receiving touchdowns** to become the 11th player in NFL history with 100+ career receiving touchdowns.
- Needs **32 receiving yards** to surpass Calvin Johnson (11,438) for the 33rd-most receiving yards in NFL history. He will also pass Johnson for the sixth-most receiving yards by a player through his first 10 seasons in league history.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR

CHRIS GODWIN

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie Jimmie Giles (34) and surpass Cameron Brate (33) for the second-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs **108 receiving yards** to reach the 1,000-yard milestone for the fourth time in his career, breaking a tie with Joey Galloway and Vincent Jackson for the second-most 1,000-yard receiving seasons in team history.
- Needs **6 receptions** to hit the 80-catch mark for the fourth time in his career, extending his current franchise record for such seasons to four.



RACHAAD WHITE

- Needs **127 rushing yards** to become the first Buccaneers running back since Doug Martin in 2015 with 1,000+ rushing yards in a single season. It would mark the 13th-such occurrence by a Tampa Bay player in team history.
- Needs **127 rushing yards** to join James Wilder (1984) as the only players in franchise history with 1,000+ rushing yards and 500+ receiving yards in a single season. He would also become the first player to accomplish this within his first two seasons since Saquon Barkley and Christian McCaffrey in 2018.
- Needs **120 scrimmage yards** to become the first Buccaneers running back since Doug Martin in 2015, and the first Buccaneers player since Mike Evans in 2018, with 1,500+ scrimmage yards in a single season. It would mark the 8th-such occurrence by a Tampa Bay player in team history.
- Needs **1 total touchdown** to tie five players (10) for the fifth-most single-season touchdowns from scrimmage by a running back in team history.
- Needs **2 total touchdowns** to tie Mike Alstott (11 in 2001) and Errict Rhett (11 in 1995) for the third-most single-season touchdowns from scrimmage by a running back in team history.
- Needs **3 total touchdowns** to tie Doug Martin (12 in 2012) for the second-most single-season touchdowns from scrimmage by a running back in team history.





WHAT TO WATCH FOR



BAKER MAYFIELD

- Needs **1 passing touchdown** to tie Josh Freeman (27 in 2012) for the fifth-most single-season passing touchdowns in team history.
- Needs **2 passing touchdowns** to tie Jameis Winston (28 in 2016) for the fourth-most single-season passing touchdowns in team history.
- Needs **4 passing touchdowns** to join Tom Brady as the only players with 30+ passing touchdowns in their first season with Tampa Bay.
- Needs **1 game with a 90+ passer rating** to join Tom Brady (2020, 2021) as the only quarterbacks with 10-or-more such games in a single single in franchise history.



LAVONTE DAVID

- Needs **0.5 sacks** to become just the second player since tackles for loss became regularly tracked in 2008 to record multiple seasons with 100+ tackles, 15+ tackles for loss and 5.0+ sacks, joining Daryl Washington (2011, 2012).
- Needs **3 tackles for loss** to reach 20 tackles for loss on the season and tie Aaron Donald and DeMarcus Ware (3) for the second-most such-seasons since the statistic became regularly tracked in 2008. Only J.J. Watt (4) has more.

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019-21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Joined Jon Gruden as the only coaches in franchise history to win a division title in their first year as head coach.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.

- X In his three seasons as defensive coordinator, Tampa Bay ranked first in fewest rushing yards allowed per game (82.5), first in fewest rushing yards per attempt (3.72), first in quarterback hits (352), first in fumble recoveries (37), first in passes defended (241), second in strip sacks (26), third in tackles for loss (262), third in takeaways (82), third in sacks (142), fourth in forced fumbles (52), tied for fourth in defensive touchdowns (nine), fifth in fewest yards per play allowed (5.13) and fifth in passing yards per attempt allowed (6.78).

DENNIS ALLEN



Dennis Allen is in his second season as head coach of the New Orleans Saints in 2023 after being named the 17th head coach in franchise history on Feb. 8, 2022. New Orleans went 7-10 in Allen's first season at the helm.

Allen was promoted to head coach after spending the past six-and-a-half seasons as the defensive coordinator of the Saints, during which the team enjoyed five consecutive winning seasons and also captured four-straight NFC South division titles from 2017-20. During his tenure as an assistant under Payton in New Orleans,

Allen has been part of staffs that have qualified for the playoffs seven times, captured the NFC South six times, reached the NFC Championship game three times and won the Super Bowl XLIV championship.

DENNIS ALLEN AT A GLANCE

- During his 22 years of coaching in the NFL, Allen has worked with 10 players who have combined for 23 Pro Bowl selections. He has also coached two AP Defensive Rookie of the Year winners and three members of the Pro Football Hall of Fame.
- In 2022, New Orleans ranked second in the NFL in pass defense (184.4 yards per game), fifth in total defense (314.8 net yards per game), tied for fifth in sacks (48) and ninth in scoring defense (20.3 points per game), coaching both LB Demario Davis and DE Cameron Jordan to the Pro Bowl.
- Offensively in 2022, WR Chris Olave earned a selection to the PFWA All-Rookie Team, leading the team with 72 receptions for 1,042 yards. In addition, RB Alvin Kamara became the only active player with six consecutive seasons of 1,300+ yards from scrimmage.
- Allen previously served as the head coach of the Oakland Raiders from 2012-14, with an 8-28 (.222) record.
- Prior to Oakland, Allen served as defensive coordinator of the Denver Broncos in 2011. He led a defense that helped the Broncos win the AFC West division crown and advance to the AFC Divisional round with an AFC Wild Card game victory.
- During Allen's previous five-year tenure in New Orleans, he first served as assistant defensive line coach (2006-07) before being promoted to secondary coach (2008-10).
- He was a part of a defensive coaching staff that engineered significant improvement from 2009-10, when the club went 24-8 in the regular season, qualified for the playoffs both times and captured Super Bowl XLIV.
- Allen joined the Saints after a four-year stint with the Atlanta Falcons, where he spent his final two years as defensive assistant/quality control with an emphasis on working with the defensive line. Over the previous two seasons, he was in charge of defensive quality control while helping tutor the secondary.
- A native of Hurst, Texas, Allen earned four letters for Texas A&M as a safety from 1992-95. A highlight was his fourth-quarter interception that clinched an 18-9 victory over Texas in 1993, sending the Aggies to their third-straight Cotton Bowl.
