· A season ago, OLB **Shaquil Barrett** led the league with a franchise-best 19.5 sacks, breaking Pro Football Hall of Famer **Warren Sapp's** previous franchise record of 16.5 set in 2000.

· In 2020, Barrett has 25 quarterback pressures,

which are tied for the second-most in the NFL this season. His 75 pressures since the start of the 2019 season rank third in the NFL.

### **BUCCANEERS TEAM**

 Quarterback Tom Brady and tight end Rob Gronkowski have connected for 81 touchdowns in the regular season and need four more to tie Steve Young and Jerry Rice (85) for the third-most touchdown connections in NFL history.

### **SHAQUIL BARRETT**

- Barrett recorded a franchise-record 19.5 sacks in 2019. With 11.0 more in 2020, he would be just the 11th player in NFL history to post consecutive seasons with at least 15.0 sacks.
- Barrett has 23.5 sacks as a Buccaneer. He needs 2.5 more to tie Greg Spires (26.0 from 2002-07) for the 10th-most sacks in franchise history.

#### **TOM BRADY**

- Brady has 20 passing touchdowns this season. He needs one more to pass Doug Williams (20 in 1980), Vinny Testaverde (20 in 1989) and Brian Griese (20 in 2004) and tie Trent Dilfer (21 in 2998 & 1998) for eighth-most, two more to tie Brad Johnson (22 in 2002) and Jameis Winston (22 in 2015) for sixth-most and five more to tie Josh Freeman (25 in 2010) for the fifth-most passing touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Brady has two career regular season games with at least six passing touchdowns and needs one more such game to tie Peyton Manning (three) for the most such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has seven such games, tied with Ben Roethlisberger for the third-most in NFL history.

#### **CAMERON BRATE**

- Brate has 28 career touchdown catches. He needs one more to pass Joey Galloway (28 from 2004-08) for the fourth-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Brate has three career games with multiple touchdown receptions. He needs one more to tie Jimmie Giles for the most ever such games by a Buccaneers tight end and tie for the third-most such games in franchise history.

### **LAVONTE DAVID**

- David has 24.0 career sacks. He needs 2.5 more to tie Jason Pierre-Paul (26.5 from 2018-Present)
   Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history.
- David has three career defensive touchdowns and needs one more to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979-96; Mike Washington, 1976-84).
- David has started 130 games in his NFL career.
   With a start against Carolina, David will surpass
   Pro Football Hall of Famer Warren Sapp (130) for the seventh-most starts by a Buccaneers player in franchise history.



### **MIKE EVANS**

Evans has seven receiving touchdowns this season. He needs one more to tie Cameron Brate (eight in 2016), Evans' own mark (eight in 2018 & 2019), Jimmie Giles (eight in 1985), Vincent Jackson (eight in 2012), Keyshawn Johnson (eight in 2000) and Keenan McCardell (eight in 2003) for the 10th-most receiving touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.

### **CHRIS GODWIN**

- Godwin has 3,020 career receiving yards. He needs 424 more to pass Gerald Carter (3,443 from 1981-87) for the ninth-most receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has 19 career touchdown receptions.
   He needs one more to tie Vincent Jackson (20 from 2012-16) for 10th-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.

#### **ROB GRONKOWSKI**

• Gronkowski has 82 regular season receiving touchdowns. He needs one more to pass Anquan Boldin and Reggie Wayne (82) for the 23rd-most touchdown receptions in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has 94 receiving touchdowns and needs one more to tie Issac Bruce (95) and Hines Ward (91) for the 13th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

### **LESEAN MCCOY**

McCoy has 73 career rushing touchdowns. He needs one more to tie Earl Campbell and Leroy Kelly (74) for 26th-most, two more to tie Clinton Portis (75) for 25th-most and three more to tie Pete Johnson (76) for the 24th-most regular season rushing touchdowns in NFL history.

### **JASON PIERRE-PAUL**

 Pierre-Paul has 27.5 sacks as a Buccaneer. He needs 1.0 more to pass Ronde Barber (28.0 from 1997-2012) for eighth-most in franchise history.


### PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- Panthers WR Robby Anderson (2016-18), RB Trenton Cannon (2018-19) and LB Julian Stanford (2016-17) played for the New York Jets when Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles was the head coach in New York. Buccaneers Defensive Line Coach Kacy Rodgers was the defensive coordinator and Buccaneers Defensive Quality Control Coach Tim Atkins served in the same role for the Jets at this time.
- Panthers LB Adarius Taylor played for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers (2015–18) when Buccaneers Defensive/ Special Teams Assistant Keith Tandy was a safety for the organization (2012–17).

### **COACHING CONNECTIONS**



- Buccaneers Outside Linebackers Coach Larry Foote (2015-18) held the same role for the Arizona Cardinals while Buccaneers Wide Receivers Coach Kevin Garver (2017-18) was the assistant wide receivers coach, Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator Byron Leftwich (2017-18) served in multiple roles, Buccaneers Safeties Coach Nick Rapone (2013-17) was the defensive backs coach, Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach Kevin Ross (2013-17) held the same position and Buccaneers Head Strength & Conditioning Coach Anthony Piroli (2015-17) was an assistant when Panthers Defensive Run Game Coordinator Al Holcomb was the defensive coordinator in Arizona in 2018.
- Buccaneers Safeties Coach Nick Rapone (1999-05) was the secondary coach at Temple University when Panthers Cornerbacks Coach Evan Cooper was a defensive back for the Owls.
- Buccaneers Offensive Quality Control Coach John Van Dam was on the Alabama staff as a graduate assistant in 2013, when Panthers Quarterbacks Coach Jake Peetz was an offensive analyst/assistant quarterbacks coach.
- Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach Kevin Ross (1996) played for the San Diego Chargers when Panthers General Manager Marty Hurney (1990-97) was the Assistant General Manager for the Chargers.
- Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians** (2001-03) was the offensive coordinator in Cleveland and Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2001-04) was the Defensive Nickel Package Coach when Panthers Assistant Strength and Conditioning Coach **Gus Felder** was an offensive lineman for the Browns. Panthers Wide Receivers Coach **Frisman Jackson** also played in Cleveland from 2002-06.



## HC BRUCE ARIANS

### **CAREER HIGHLIGHTS**

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

### **ARIZONA CARDINALS**

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

### TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

### **INDIANAPOLIS COLTS**

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. ## MATT RHULE



The Carolina Panthers announced Matt Rhule as the franchise's fifth head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2020.

Rhule, 44, joins Carolina after three seasons (2017-19) as the head coach at Baylor University. Rhule helped rebuild the Baylor program, guiding the team from a 1-11 finish in his first season to a 7-6 record and a bowl berth in 2018 to an 11-3 record and appearance in the Big 12 Championship and the Sugar Bowl in 2019. This fall, he was voted the Chuck Neinas Coach of the Year by his peers.

### **MATT RHULE AT A GLANCE**

- His performance at Baylor continued a head coaching career that saw him turn around college programs' fortunes and guide teams to success. In his head coaching debut at Temple, (2013-16), Rhule took the Owls from a 2-10 mark in his first season to a 6-6 record in 2014 and two consecutive 10-win seasons in 2015 and 2016. Rhule has spent 22 years as a coach in the college and NFL ranks.
- Baylor's appearance in the Sugar Bowl this season was just the second-ever in school history, and under Rhule's leadership the Bears became the first Power 5 program to go from 11 losses (2017) to 11 wins (2019) within two seasons.
- Since 2016, Rhule has had 11 players selected in the NFL Draft, including the 2017 first round pick of the Arizona Cardinals Haason Reddick and Hurd, a 2019 third round selection by San Francisco. A total of 33 players have earned NFL opportunities in Rhule's first six seasons as a head coach.
- In his time as a coach and player, Rhule's teams have played in 10 bowl games, including four times as a head coach. In his first season at Baylor, quarterback Charlie Brewer was named the 2017 Big 12 Co-Offensive Freshman of the Year.
- Rhule came to Baylor after four seasons as head coach at Temple University. He guided the Owls to the school's first back-to-back 10-win seasons, a pair of bowl berths (2015-16), and the 2016 American Athletic Conference championship. He helped the Owls improve from a two-win season in his first year at the school in 2013.
- Rhule returned to Temple after coaching with the New York Giants under head coach Tom Coughlin in 2012. He worked closely with Pat Flaherty in coaching the offensive line. The Giants finished 9-7 and averaged 335 yards on offense, with offensive guard Chris Snee earning 2012 Pro Bowl honors.
- Prior to his stint in the NFL, Rhule spent six seasons as an assistant at Temple under head coaches Al Golden and Steve Addazio. He spent four seasons as offensive coordinator from 2008-11, coached quarterbacks and served as recruiting coordinator in 2007, and mentored the defensive line in 2006.
- From 2002-05, Rhule was an assistant at Western Carolina, serving as assistant head coach during his last three seasons. He also was part of the staffs at UCLA (2001), Buffalo (1999-2000) and Albright College (1998).
- A native of New York City, Rhule played linebacker at Penn State from 1994-97. He holds a master's degree from Buffalo. Rhule and his wife Julie have three children, Bryant, Vivienne and Leona.
