WHAT TO WATCH FOR

SHAQUIL BARRETT

- Barrett has **27.5 sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **1.0 more** to pass Rondé Barber (28.0 from 1997-2012) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history.

TOM BRADY

- Brady has **32 passing touchdowns** this season. He needs **one more** to tie Winston (33 in 2019) for the most passing touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Brady has 3,886 passing yards this season. He needs **157 more** to pass Jameis Winston (4,042 in 2015) for fourth-most, **180 more** to pass Josh Freeman (4,065 in 2012) for third-most and **205 more** to pass Winston (4,090 in 2016) for second-most passing yards in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Brady threw for 390 yards, two touchdowns and no interceptions at Atlanta. With **at least 375 passing yards, two touchdowns and no interceptions** at Detroit, it will mark only the seventh time in NFL history that a player has posted consecutive such games (Brady, twice; Kirk Cousins; Patrick Mahomes; Dak Prescott; Aaron Rodgers).
- At Detroit, Brady will appear in his **300th career NFL game**, tying John Kasay for the 10th-most games player in NFL history. Brady ranks third among non-specialists, trailing only Jerry Rice (303) and Brett Favre (302).



ANTONIO BROWN

- Brown has **11,431 career receiving yards**, the 32nd-most in NFL history. He needs **47 more** to pass Calvin Johnson (11,619 from 2007-2015) for the 31st-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Brown has **76 career touchdown receptions**, tied for the 33rd-most in NFL history. He needs **one more** to pass Fred Biletnikoff (76 from 1965-1978) and Harold Jackson (76 from 1968-1983) and tie Joey Galloway (77 from 1995-2010) for the 32nd-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.



CAMERON BRATE

- Brate has **29 career touchdown catches**. He needs **two more** to tie Kevin House (31 from 1980-86) for the third-most touchdown receptions in team history.

LAVONTE DAVID

- David has **three career defensive touchdowns** and needs **one more** to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979-96; Mike Washington, 1976-84).



CHRIS GODWIN

- Godwin has **3,323 career receiving yards**, the 10th-most in franchise history. He needs **121 more** to pass Gerald Carter (3,443 from 1981-87) for the ninth-most receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has **21 career touchdown receptions**. He needs **two more** to pass Bruce Hill (23 from 1987-91) for the ninth-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR

MIKE EVANS

- Evans has **11 receiving touchdowns** this season. He needs **one more** to tie his own mark (12 in 2014 & 2016) for the most receiving touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Evans has **8,039 career receiving yards** and **59 career receiving touchdowns**. He needs **one touchdown** to join Larry Fitzgerald, Marvin Harrison, Calvin Johnson, Randy Moss, Jerry Rice and Sterling Sharpe as the only players in NFL history with at least 8,000 receiving yards and 60 receiving touchdowns in their first seven seasons.

ROB GRONKOWSKI

- Gronkowski has **84 regular season receiving touchdowns**, tied for the 18th-most in NFL history. He needs **one more** to pass Mark Clayton, Irving Fryar, Tommy McDonald and Andre Rison (84) and tie Lance Alworth, Paul Warfield and Hines Ward (85) for the 15th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has **96 receiving touchdowns** and needs **one more** to pass Andre Reed (96) for the 12th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).
- Gronkowski has **536 receiving yards** this season and needs **44 more** to pass Jimmie Giles for 10th-most (579 in 1979), **56 more** to pass Cameron Brate (591 in 2017) for ninth-most and **67 more** to pass Giles (602 in 1980) for the eighth-most receiving yards in a season by a Buccaneers tight end.



JASON PIERRE-PAUL

- Pierre-Paul has **30.5 sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **2.5 more** to tie Brad Culpepper (33.0 from 1994-99) for seventh-most in franchise history.
- Pierre-Paul has **9.5 sacks** this season. He needs **2.5 more** to tie Simeon Rice (12.0 in 2004) for the 10th-most in a single season in franchise history.

DEVIN WHITE

- White recorded 3.0 sacks at Atlanta. With 3.0 or more sacks at Detroit, he can join Shaquil Barrett (9/12/19 at Carolina-9/22/19 vs. N.Y. Giants) as the only players in team history to post consecutive games with 3.0 sacks. Barrett is the last NFL player to record 3.0 or more sacks in consecutive games.



RYAN SUCCOP

- Succop has contributed **117 points** this season. He needs **one more** to tie Matt Bryant (118 in 2007) for sixth-most, **six more** to tie Connor Barth (123 in 2012) for fifth-most, **seven more** to tie Matt Gay (124 in 2019) for fourth-most, **nine more** to tie Martin Gramatica (126 in 2000) for third-most, **11 more** to tie Gramatica (128 in 2002) for second-most and **14 more** to tie Bryant (131 in 2008) for the most points in a single season in franchise history.

LESEAN MCCOY

- McCoy has **73 career rushing touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to tie Earl Campbell and Leroy Kelly (74) for 26th-most regular season rushing touchdowns in NFL history.
- McCoy has 90 career scrimmage touchdowns. He needs one more to tie Issac Bruce, Edgerrin James and Ricky Watters (91) for the 31st-most touchdowns in NFL history.

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- The Buccaneers have totaled **5,072 net yards** this season. They need **250 more** to pass 1984 (5,321) for 10th-most, **291 more** to pass 2010 (5,362) for ninth-most, **382 more** to pass 2003 (5,453) for eighth-most and **385 more** to pass 2008 (5,456) for the seventh-most yards in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have scored **401 points** this season, the second-most in a single season in team history. They need **58 more** to pass 2019 (458) the most points in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have **306 first downs** this season, the eighth-most in a single season in team history. They need **two more** to pass 2003 (307) for seventh-most and **31 more** to pass 2015 (336) for the sixth-most first downs in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have **43.0 sacks** this season, tied for the fifth-most in a single season in team history. They need **one more** to pass 1999 and 2002 (43.0) and tie more to tie 1997 (44.0) for fourth-most, **two more** to tie 2004 (45.0) for third-most and **four more** to tie 2019 (47.0) for the second-most sacks in a single season in team history.

- Buccaneers Outside Linebackers Coach Larry Foote played linebacker for the Lions in 2009.
- Buccaneers Assistant Coach Tom Moore was the offensive coordinator in Detroit from 1994-96.

CONNECTIONS

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians**, Assistant Head Coach/Run Game Coordinator **Harold Goodwin** and multiple other members of the Tampa Bay coaching staff worked with Lions RB **Adrian Peterson** when the veteran played in six games for the Arizona Cardinals in 2017.
- Buccaneers Offensive Line Coach **Joe Gilbert** (2004-06) held the same position at the University of Central Florida when Lions K **Matt Prater** (2002-05) kicked for UCF. The Knights posted an 8-5 record in 2005 and made their first Bowl Game appearance in program history, earning a trip to the Hawaii Bowl. The eight wins in 2005 was UCF's second-best season in program history to that point.
- Buccaneers Quarterbacks Coach **Clyde Christensen** (2018) was the director of football and player development for the Miami Dolphins when Lions WR **Danny Amendola** played in Miami.
- Buccaneers WR **Scotty Miller** (2015-18) played collegiately at Bowling Green when Lions Assistant Offensive Line Coach **Billy Yates** (2016-17) was the head strength and conditioning coach at the university.



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Two former University of Connecticut Huskies football coaches will face each other on Saturday. Buccaneers Safeties Coach **Nick Rapone** and Lions Interim Head Coach **Darrell Bevell** were each a part of the 1998 Connecticut coaching staff, Rapone serving as the defensive coordinator while Bevell was the wide receivers coach. The Huskies posted a 10-3 record that season, which remains the only 10-plus win season in Connecticut's 124-year history.

- Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach **Kevin Ross** (2007-08) was an assistant secondary coach for the San Diego Chargers when Lions Defensive Backs Coach **Steve Gregory** played in San Diego's secondary from 2006-11.
- Buccaneers Quarterbacks Coach **Clyde Christensen** held multiple positions, including offensive coordinator, with the Miami Dolphins from 2016-18. During that time, Lions Tight Ends Coach **Ben Johnson** (2013-18) coached multiple offensive positions for Miami.
- Buccaneers Inside Linebackers Coach **Mike Caldwell** (1998-2001) played for the Philadelphia Eagles when Lions offensive line coach **Hank Fraley** also played for Philadelphia from 2000-05.
- Buccaneers Safeties Coach **Nick Rapone** was the defensive coordinator at the University of Delaware from 2006-12. During that time, Lions Defensive Quality Control Coach **Stephen Thomas** was a graduate assistant on the defense from 2009-10.

HC BRUCE ARIANS



CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

DARRELL BEVELL



Darrell Bevell was named the Lions' interim head coach on Nov. 28, 2020. He began his 20th NFL season as Detroit's offensive coordinator, his second year in that role.

In his first season with the team, Bevell helped guide the Lions offensive attack which ranked 10th in passing yards per game (243.8) and offensive touchdowns (28). On the ground, he coached four different running backs who accumulated at least 200 rushing yards a piece, which sat atop the NFL charts.

DARRELL BEVELL AT A GLANCE

- Leading the Seattle Seahawks' offense from 2011-17, Bevell helped guide the team to five playoff appearances, three NFC West championships, two NFC Conference titles and one Super Bowl championship (XLVIII) in that span. Eight different offensive players combined for 17 Pro Bowl selections under Bevell, two players earned First-Team AP All-Pro honors under his guidance and the team ranked second in the NFL with a point differential of +741.
- From 2011-17, the Seahawks totaled 14,773 rushing yards, the second-most in the NFL, and averaged 29.7 rushing attempts per game, the third-most in the League during that span. During that seven-season range, the Seahawks accumulated a combined passer rating of 95.7, the fourth-highest in the NFL. Under Bevell's tutelage, Russell Wilson accounted for the most wins (65), highest passer rating (98.8), third-best interception rate (1.98), fourth-most passing touchdowns (161), fifth-highest completion percentage (64.04) and sixth-most passing yards (22,176) that a quarterback has ever totaled in his first six seasons in NFL history.
- Prior to joining the Seahawks, Bevell served as the Minnesota Vikings' offensive coordinator from 2006-10. He helped lead the club to two playoff appearances, two NFC North titles and one NFC Championship Game appearance. From 2006-10, the Vikings ranked fourth in the NFL with a 4.51 rushing average, fifth with 10,646 rushing yards and 84 rushing touchdowns and seventh with 2,363 rushing attempts.
- Bevell received his NFL start with the Green Bay Packers in 2000 and served in various roles with the team through the 2005 season, serving as the quarterbacks coach in his last three years.
- Bevell entered the coaching ranks at Westmar University in Lemars, Iowa in 1996, where he worked as passing game coordinator and quarterbacks coach. He moved on to Iowa State in 1997 as a graduate assistant and then the University of Connecticut for two seasons in 1998-99 as wide receivers coach. The 1998 UConn Huskies posted a 10-3 record, a school-record 461 points, won the Atlantic-10 Conference North Division title and advanced to the Division I-AA playoff quarterfinals.
- A four-year starting quarterback at the University of Wisconsin from 1992-95, Bevell left Madison as the school's all-time leading passer with 19 team records and a pair of Big Ten marks.
- A native of Yuma, Ariz., Bevell and his wife, Tammy, have three daughters, Kylie, Morgan and Hailey.
