· In Week 14, Tom Brady threw his 100th touchdown pass with Tampa Bay, making him the fifth quarterback in league history to throw 100-or-more touchdown passes with multiple teams (Peyton Manning, Carson Palmer, Frank Tarkenton, Kurt Warner).



· Brady currently ranks fourth in the NFL in passing yards this season with 3,585. Since arriving in Tampa Bay in 2020, his 13,534 passing yards trail only Patrick Mahomes.





- Bengals Head Coach Zac Taylor signed with the Buccaneers as a college free agent in 2007 and made an appearance at training camp before being waived by the team.
- Bengals G Alex Cappa (2018-21) was a key part of the Buccaneers blocking efforts that allowed a league-low 23 sacks in 2021, after allowing the fourth-fewest sacks (22) in 2020.
- Bengals Senior Defensive Assistant Mark Duffner spent the 2016-18 seasons with the Buccaneers as a linebackers coach and served as interim defensive coordinator for the last 11 games of 2018. During this time, Buccaneers LB Lavonte David had five forced fumbles, which was the second-most in the NFL, and a league-high five fumble recoveries.

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019-21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached five different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021) and Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021).
- X First Buccaneers coach to begin career 2-0 since Sam Wyche in 1992, and the first to do it with a pair of road wins.
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-toback seasons from 2019-20.
- X In his three seasons as defensive coordinator, Tampa Bay ranked first in fewest rushing yards allowed per game (82.5), first in fewest rushing vards per attempt (3.72), first in quarterback hits (352), first in fumble recoveries (37), first in passes defensed (241), second in strip sacks (26), third in tackles for loss (262), third in takeaways (82), third in sacks (142), fourth in forced fumbles (52), tied for fourth in defensive touchdowns (nine), fifth in fewest yards per play allowed (5.13) and fifth in passing yards per attempt allowed (6.78).

ZAC TAYLOR



Player of the Year.

Zac Taylor was named the 10th head coach in Bengals history on Feb. 4, 2019. The 2022 season is his fourth in the position after a '21 campaign in which he led the team to an AFC North Division championship, an AFC championship and a berth in Super Bowl LVI.

Working with one of the NFL's top young offenses in 2021, Taylor helped guide second-year QB Joe Burrow to a breakout year in which he set team records for passing yardage (4611), TD passes (34) and passer rating (108.3), as well as recording a league-high 70.4 completion percentage. Burrow was named the AP NFL Comeback

ZAC TAYLOR AT A GLANCE

- Taylor also oversaw the rapid rise of first-year WR Ja'Marr Chase, who posted the most receiving yards by a rookie in the Super Bowl era (1455) en route to winning AP Offensive Rookie of the Year honors. Chase and fellow WR Tee Higgins (1091 yards) became the first duo in NFL history to record 1000 receiving yards in the same season before the age of 23.
- Overall in 2021, the Cincinnati offense finished the regular season in the top half of the NFL in yards (13th, 361.5 per game), passing yards (seventh, 259.0) and points (eighth, 27.1).
- In 2020, Taylor helped transition Burrow, the No. 1 overall pick in the NFL draft. Burrow produced one of the most productive starts to a career by a QB in NFL history before a knee injury ended the rookie's season after 10 games. Still, Burrow's 264 completions were the most ever by an NFL QB through their first 10 career games, while his 404 pass attempts were second and his 2688 passing yards were fifth.
- Taylor came to Cincinnati after two seasons (2017-18) with the L.A. Rams, where he served as assistant wide receivers coach in '17 and quarterbacks coach in '18. In 2018, he helped guide Rams QB Jared Goff to career highs in every major passing category.
- Prior to his time with the Rams, Taylor had a one-year stint in the college ranks, serving as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at the University of Cincinnati in 2016. Taylor served under head coach Tommy Tuberville at UC.
- Taylor broke into NFL coaching in 2012 with the Miami Dolphins as assistant quarterbacks coach. He was elevated to quarterbacks coach from 2013-15, and spent the final five games of '15 as the Dolphins' interim offensive coordinator and primary play-caller, after the team made coaching staff changes.
- Taylor's coaching career began at Texas A&M University, where he served as offensive graduate assistant and tight ends coach under head coach Mike Sherman from 2008-11.
- As a player, Taylor played his final two seasons ('05-06) at the University of Nebraska. Taylor had a decorated career with the Cornhuskers, setting numerous school records and passing for 5850 yards and 45 touchdowns. In his 2006 senior season, he was named Big 12 Offensive Player of the Year, leading the Cornhuskers to a 9-3 record, an appearance in the Big 12 Championship Game and a berth in the Cotton Bowl. He was inducted into the Nebraska Football Hall of Fame in 2017.
- Taylor joined the Tampa Bay Buccaneers as a college free agent in 2007, but he was waived prior to the start of training camp.






