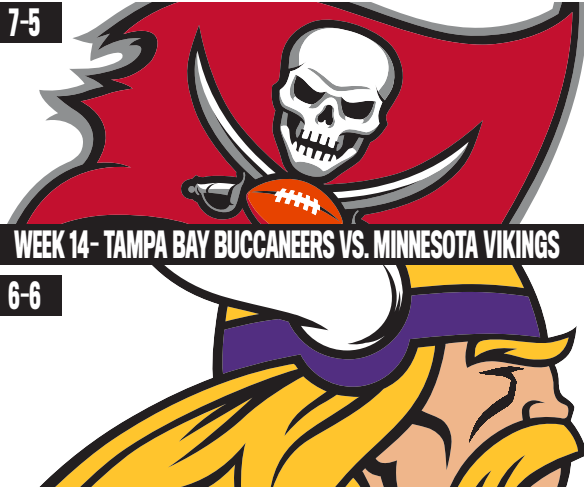

• The Buccaneers offense has scored a touchdown on 32-of-45 trips inside the red zone this season, while leading the NFL with a 97.8 scoring percentage (44-of-45) on red zone drives.

• The team has found success through the air in the red zone, recording 23 red zone passing touchdowns, the second-most in the NFL this season.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

SHAQUIL BARRETT

- Barrett has **25.5 sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **1.0 more** to tie Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for the 10th-most sacks in franchise history.

TOM BRADY

- Brady has **28 passing touchdowns** this season. He needs **one more** to pass Jameis Winston (28 in 2016) for second-most and **five more** to tie Winston (33 in 2019) for the most passing touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Brady has **3,300 passing yards** this season. He needs **152 more** to pass Josh Freeman (3,451 in 2010) for 10th-most, **205 more** to pass Jameis Winston (3,504 in 2017) for ninth-most, **255 more** to pass Steve DeBerg (3,554 in 1984) for eighth-most, **264 more** to pass Doug Williams (3,563 in 1981) for seventh-most and **293 more** to pass Josh Freeman (3,592 in 2011) for the sixth-most passing yards in a single season in Buccaneers history.

CAMERON BRATE

- Brate has **29 career touchdown catches**. He needs **two more** to tie Kevin House (31 from 1980-86) for the third-most touchdown receptions in team history.

ANTONIO BROWN

- Brown has **861 career receptions**, the 25th-most in NFL history. He needs **two more** to pass Jimmy Smith (862 from 1992-2005) for the 24th-most receptions in NFL history.
- Brown has **11,431 career receiving yards**, the 33rd-most in NFL history. He needs **eight more** to pass Muhsin Muhammad (11,438 from 1996-2009) for the 32nd-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Brown has **75 career touchdown receptions**, tied for the 35th-most in NFL history. He needs **one more** to pass James Lofton (75 from 1978-1993) and tie Fred Biletnikoff (76 from 1965-1978) and Harold Jackson (76 from 1968-1983) for the 33rd-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.

MIKE EVANS

- Evans has **11 receiving touchdowns** this season. He needs **one more** to tie his own mark (12 in 2014 & 2016) for the most receiving touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Evans caught **two touchdowns** against Kansas City. With **at least two touchdown receptions** against Minnesota, Evans will mark only the fourth time in team history that a player has posted multiple touchdown receptions in consecutive games. Previously: Chris Godwin (9/29/19 at L.A. Rams-10/6/19 vs. New Orleans), Vincent Jackson (10/13/13 vs. Philadelphia-10/20/13 at Atlanta) and Horace Copeland (10/24/93 vs. Green Bay-10/31/93 at Atlanta).



LAVONTE DAVID

- David has **24.0 career sacks**. He needs **2.5 more** to tie Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history.
- David has **three career defensive touchdowns** and needs **one more** to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979-96; Mike Washington, 1976-84).

CHRIS GODWIN

- Godwin has **3,262 career receiving yards**, the 10th-most in franchise history. He needs **182 more** to pass Gerald Carter (3,443 from 1981-87) for the ninth-most receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has **20 career touchdown receptions**. He needs one more to pass Vincent Jackson (20 from 2012-16) for the 10th-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.

ROB GRONKOWSKI

- Gronkowski has **83 regular season receiving touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to pass Calvin Johnson and Brandon Marshall (83) and tie Mark Clayton, Irving Fryar, Tommy McDonald and Andre Rison (84) for the 18th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has 95 receiving touchdowns and needs **one more** to pass Isaac Bruce (95) and Hines Ward (95) and tie Andre Reed (96) for the 12th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

JASON PIERRE-PAUL

- Pierre-Paul has **29.5 sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **3.5 more** to tie Brad Culpepper (33.0 from 1994-99) for seventh-most in franchise history.

RYAN SUCCOP

- Succop contributed **102 points** this season. He needs **four more** to pass Connor Barth (105 in 2010) for eighth-most and **five more** to pass Martin Gramatica (106 in 1999) for the seventh-most points in a single season in franchise history.

CLASH OF THE SPARTANS

Buccaneers DL William Gholston will be looking to reunite in the backfield with former Michigan State teammate Kirk Cousins when the Buccaneers and Vikings square off on Sunday. The two anchored their respective sides of the ball when they were teammates from 2010-11, a period where the Spartans posted an overall record of 22-5 and peaked in the top 10 of the AP Poll each season. Cousins was a second-team All-Big Ten selection in 2011 after earning honorable mention honors to the all-conference team the year prior. Gholston burst onto the scene in 2011, also earning second-team All-Big Ten recognition after leading the Spartan defensive front with 70 tackles and 16.0 tackles for loss.

- Buccaneers Assistant Coach Tom Moore is a Rochester native and spent time as a coach at the University of Minnesota, serving as its running backs coach from 1972-73 before returning as the offensive coordinator from 1975-76.

- Vikings Wide Receivers Coach Andrew Janocko was an offensive assistant in Tampa from 2012-13.
- Vikings Kicking Consultant Nate Kaeding was a kicker for the Buccaneers in 2013.

- Buccaneers Assistant Coach Tom Moore was an assistant head coach in Minnesota from 1990-93.
- Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach Kevin Ross was the Vikings secondary coach from 2003-05.

CONNECTIONS

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- During the 2017 season with the Buffalo Bills, RB **LeSean McCoy** completed his second of back-to-back Pro Bowl seasons as a Bill. During that year, McCoy worked with Vikings Offensive Line/Run Game Coordinator **Rick Dennison**, who was the offensive coordinator for the Bills. In Dennison's offense, McCoy rushed for 1,138 yards (fourth in the NFL) and scored six touchdowns to go along with 448 receiving yards and a pair of receiving touchdowns.
- Buccaneers C **Ryan Jensen** (2014-17) played for the Baltimore Ravens when Vikings Offensive Coordinator/Assistant Head Coach **Gary Kubiak** (2014) was the offensive coordinator and Vikings Offensive Line/Run Game Coordinator **Rick Dennison** (2014) was the quarterbacks coach.
- Buccaneers Specialists Coach **Chris Boniol** (2010-13) was an assistant special teams coach with the Dallas Cowboys when Vikings K **Dan Bailey** (2011-17) played for Dallas.
- Buccaneers WR **Mike Evans** (2011-13) played at Texas A&M when Vikings Quarterbacks Coach **Klint Kubiak** held multiple offensive coaching positions for the Aggies from 2011-12.



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Buccaneers Defensive Line Coach **Kacy Rodgers** (2003-07) held the same position with the Dallas Cowboys when Vikings Head Coach **Mike Zimmer** (2000-06) was the defensive coordinator in Dallas. During the time both were in Dallas, the Cowboys made a pair of postseason appearances in 2003 and 2006. In 2003, Dallas boasted the league's best passing defense and the third-best run defense in the NFL. The unit also allowed just 260 points in regular season action, the second-best output in the league.
- Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians** was the offensive coordinator and interim head coach of the Indianapolis Colts in 2012 when Vikings Special Teams Coordinator **Marwan Maalouf** (2012) held the same position and Assistant Defensive Backs Coach **Roy Anderson** (2012-15) was the safeties coach in Indianapolis.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2015-18) was the head coach of the New York Jets when Vikings Offensive Line/Run Game Coordinator **Rick Dennison** was held the same position in New York for the 2018 season. Multiple coaches on the Tampa Bay staff also worked in New York during this time.
- Buccaneers Defensive Line Coach **Kacy Rodgers** played for the Pittsburgh Steelers in 1992 when Vikings Senior Defensive Assistant **Dom Capers** was the defensive coordinator in Pittsburgh from 1992-94.
- Buccaneers Assistant Coach **Tom Moore** (1994-96) was the offensive coordinator for the Detroit Lions when Vikings General Manager **Rick Spielman** (1990-96) worked in scouting for the organization.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

MIKE ZIMMER



Mike Zimmer enters his 7th season as Vikings Head Coach in 2020. Zimmer has notched 59 wins including playoffs in his 6 seasons leading the team with a pair of NFC North titles and three playoff appearances.

Zimmer was hired as the 9th head coach in Vikings history on Jan. 15, 2014. A veteran defensive coordinator, Zimmer is in his 26th season on an NFL sideline in 2019. In his NFL tenure, Zimmer has been a part of 13 playoff teams and teams that have won 9 Division titles. He coached the Cowboys DBs when Dallas won Super Bowl XXX over Pittsburgh after the 1995 season.

MIKE ZIMMER AT A GLANCE

- In 2019, the Vikings used a new offensive scheme with a renewed emphasis on balance and a strong ground game to return to the playoffs with a 10-6 mark, earning a Wild Card win at New Orleans and advancing to face #1 seed San Francisco in the Divisional Round. The Vikings offense featured a 1,000-yard rusher (Dalvin Cook- 1,135) a 1,000-yard receiver (Stefon Diggs- 1,130) and 3,000-yard passer (Kirk Cousins- 3,603) for the 1st time since 2009 and the team climbed from #30 in NFL rushing in 2018 to #6 in 2019.
- Zimmer's arrival in Cincinnati for the 2008 season signaled a franchise turnaround on the defensive side of the ball. The Bengals notched top-10 defensive rankings in 2009, '11, '12 and '13 after only cracking the NFL's top 10 once in 18 seasons prior to Zimmer joining the team. During his tenure, Zimmer coached Geno Atkins as he became one of the top DTs in the NFL, earning consensus All-Pro honors in 2012 and Pro Bowl berths in 2011 and 2012. In 2013, LB Vontaze Burfict continued his rise from an undrafted rookie free agent in 2012 to a Pro Bowler in 2013. Atkins became the 1st Bengals defensive lineman since Tim Krumrie in 1988 to earn a Pro Bowl trip, and Burfict was the 1st Bengals LB to be honored since Jim LeClair in 1976.
- Zimmer led top-10 defenses for Dallas in both a 4-3 and 3-4 scheme. The 2003 Cowboys defense ranked #1 in the NFL with only 253.3 yards per game allowed. During Zimmer's tenure in Dallas as DBs coach (1994-99) and defensive coordinator (2000-06) the team ranked in the top 5 of NFL scoring defense a total of 6 times. The 1995 Cowboys hoisted the Lombardi Trophy in Super Bowl XXX with a win over Pittsburgh, and one of Zimmer's pupils, CB Larry Brown, won the Super Bowl MVP award with a pair of INTs in the game. Brown is 1 of only 3 DBs to earn Super Bowl MVP honors in the history of the game.
- Before moving to the NFL ranks, Zimmer spent 15 seasons coaching at the collegiate level. He spent his final 5 seasons in the college ranks as defensive coordinator at Washington State from 1989-93. Zimmer was at Weber State from 1981-88, serving as defensive coordinator from '83-88. He entered the profession at Missouri as an assistant from 1979-80.
- Zimmer played QB and later LB at Illinois State, earning a degree in physical education. He has 3 children - son, Adam, and daughters, Corri and Marki. Adam is coaching the Vikings LBs after having spent time with Kansas City, New Orleans and Cincinnati as an assistant LBs and DBs coach. The father and son have each both earned Super Bowl titles with Adam's coming after the 2009 season when the Saints won Super Bowl XLIV over Indianapolis.
