# CLOSING IN ON 10,000

• Mike Evans needs just 122 receiving yards to become the first player to 10,000 career receiving yards with Tampa Bay, and the 48th player in NFL history to reach the 10,000 receiving yards milestone.

• If Evans can reach the 10,000-yard mark this season, he will become just the sixth player in NFL history with 10,000+ receiving yards and 75+ receiving touchdowns through nine career seasons.

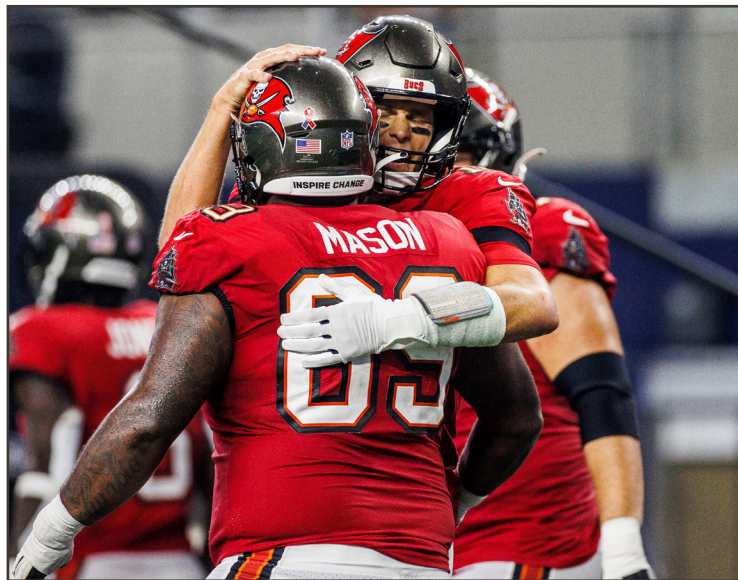

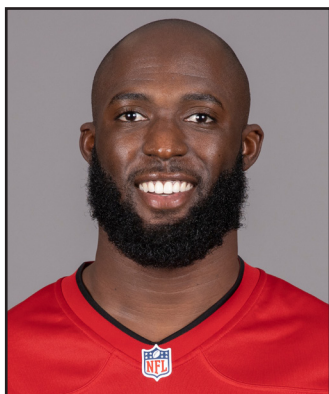

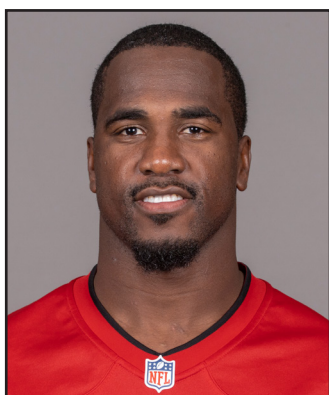

## FORMER RAMS

- Assistant Wide Receivers Coach **Thaddeus Lewis** played for the Rams in 2010.

## FORMER BUCCANEERS

- K **Matt Gay** was drafted by the Buccaneers in the fifth round of the 2019 Draft and played his rookie season in Tampa Bay.
- Head Coach **Sean McVay** began his NFL coaching career as an offensive assistant for the Buccaneers in 2008.
- Defensive Coordinator **Raheem Morris** has had two coaching stints with the Buccaneers. He entered the NFL coaching ranks with Tampa Bay in 2002 as a defensive quality control coach prior to being promoted to defensive assistant (2003) and later defensive backs coach (2004-05). He returned as the defensive backs coach from 2007-08 before spending three seasons as the team's head coach from 2009-11.
- Senior Offensive Assistant **Greg Olson** (2008-11) spent four seasons with the Buccaneers, serving as the quarterbacks coach in 2008 and offensive coordinator from 2009-11.
- Wide Receivers Coach **Eric Yarber** spent the 2010-11 seasons with the Buccaneers in the same role.

## SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA TIES

- Quarterbacks Coach **Clyde Christensen** is a Covina native.
- Running Backs Coach **Todd McNair** served as the running backs coach at USC from 2004-2010.

# SEAN MCVAY



On January 12, 2017, Sean McVay was named the 23rd full-time head coach in franchise history. McVay became the youngest coach in modern NFL history at 30 years old.

During the 2021 season, McVay produced his fifth-straight winning season with the Rams, the longest consecutive winning season streak since the Rams posted four-consecutive winning seasons from 1983-1986. The 12-5 record earned L.A. its fourth postseason appearance and second Super Bowl appearance in McVay's first five seasons leading the

franchise which was capped off by a Super Bowl LVI victory in the Rams' home stadium. McVay also became the youngest head coach in NFL history to win a Super Bowl at the age of 36.

## SEAN MCVAY AT A GLANCE

- In 2020, the Rams defensive unit finished the season as the No. 1 ranked unit across the league, with Aaron Donald being named NFL Defensive Player of the Year. The Rams defense held opposing offenses to only 16.8 points per game. The Rams held opposing offenses to 281.9 yards per game, 190.7 passing yards per game and held each opposing quarterback to under 300 net yards passing. As a team, L.A. held opponents to only 18.5 points per game.
- In McVay's second season guiding the Rams in 2018, the Rams posted a 13-3 record, which tied for the second-best record in franchise history, won a pair of playoff games and advanced to the Rams fourth Super Bowl appearance days after his 33rd birthday, becoming the youngest NFL head coach to ever help his team to a Super Bowl.
- In 2017, the Rams' passing attack finished among the top-10 in passing yards per attempt (8.33, 4th), passing yards per game (295.6, 5th) and touchdowns (32, tied for 8th). The defense was led by DT Aaron Donald, who posted a franchise-best 20.5 sacks, the most ever by a defensive tackle. Donald recorded 183.5 sack yards, the most ever by a defender in a single season. As a unit, the Rams ranked sixth with 1.6 takeaways per game.
- In his first season guiding the Rams, McVay completed one of the greatest offensive turnarounds in NFL history. He helped the Rams move from the 32nd-ranked scoring offense in 2016 to the league's top-scoring team in 2017, marking the first time in league history a team has gone from last to first in scoring. The first-year head coach led the Rams to an 11-5 record and their first NFC West title since the 2003 season, earning the team's first playoff berth since 2004.
- Before joining the Rams, McVay completed his third season as the Redskins' offensive coordinator in 2016 after initially being promoted to the position on January 15, 2014. Prior to his promotion during the 2014 offseason, McVay spent three seasons as the team's tight ends coach (2011-13) and one as an offensive assistant (2010).
- McVay joined the Redskins prior to the 2010 season after an undefeated regular season with the Florida Tuskers of the United Football League (UFL). McVay originally entered the National Football League as an offensive assistant with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 2008.
- McVay graduated from Miami University (Ohio) where he played wide receiver from 2004-07, earning Miami's Scholar-Athlete Award in 2007.
