· Tom Brady has now thrown 40+ touchdown passes in each of his first two seasons with Tampa Bay, joining Drew Brees as the only players in NFL history with 40-or-more touchdown passes in back-to-back seasons. **Brady currently ranks first in the NFL in both passing touchdowns and passing yards.**

THE GIFT OF 'GRONK'

· Since returning from injury in Week 11, Gronkowski ranks third among all NFL tight ends with 481 receiving yards. He also ranks sixth among all tight ends in receiving yards/game this season (60.45).



· In Week 17 at the New York Jets, Gronkowski hauled in seven receptions for 115 yards. It was the 31st 100-yard receiving performance for Gronkowski, tying Tony Gonzalez (31) for the most such games by a tight end in NFL history.

· With 1,006 yards in 2020, Mike Evans became the first player in NFL history with 1,000-or-more receiving yards in each of his first seven NFL seasons, surpassing Randy Moss (first six seasons). He stands just 101 yards shy of extending his streak to 8.



· Evans also ranks tied for third in the NFL in receiving touchdowns (12).

THE BUZZ AROUND BOWLES' DEFENSE



Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020 and ranking 11th in 2021.

ROUGHING UP THE RUN GAME



Tampa Bay led the NFL in run defense in 2019 & 2020, becoming the first team to accomplish that feat since the Minnesota Vikings (2006-08).

Since Bowles took over in 2019, the Buccaneers lead the NFL in rushing yards per attempt allowed and rushing yards per game allowed.

Tom Brady needs...

10 PASSING YARDS

to join Drew Brees as the only players in NFL history with multiple 5,000-yard passing seasons.

Tom Brady needs...

119 PASSING YARDS

to break the single season team record for passing yards (J. Winston, 2019, 5,109).

Tom Brady needs...

1 TD PASS

to break his single season franchise record for passing touchdowns (40 in 2020) and surpass Josh Freeman (80) for the second-most passing touchdowns in team history.

Cameron Brate needs...

1 REC. TOUCHDOWN

to tie Jimmie Giles (34) for the second-most receiving touchdowns in team history.

Mike Evans needs...

54 RECEIVING YARDS

to reach eight consecutive seasons with 1,000+ receiving yards - the most-such seasons to begin a career in NFL history. He would also match the third-longest streak overall of consecutive 1,000-yard seasons at any point in a player's career (8).

to tie Torry Holt, Nat Moore and Jason Witten (74) for the 38th-most in NFL history.

BUCCANEERS OFFENSE

- The Buccaneers have scored **470 points** this season, the second-most in a single season in team history. They need **23 more** to pass 2020 (492) for the most points scored in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have scored **58 touchdowns** this season, the second-most in a single season in team history. They need **two more** to surpass 2020 (59) for the most touchdowns in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have totaled **6,492 net yards** this season, the second-most in a single season in team history. They need **157 more** to pass 2018 (6,648) for the most yards in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have totaled **4,905 net passing yards** this season, the second-most in a single season in team history. They need **221 more** to pass 2018 (5,125) for the most net passing yards in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have **383 first downs** this season, the second-most in a single season in team history. They need **six more** to pass 2018 (388) for the most first downs in a single season in team history.

QB TOM BRADY

- Tom Brady has **4,990 passing yards** this season and needs **95 more** for 10th-most, **108 more** for ninth-most, **120 more** for eighth-most, **140 more** for seventh-most, **173 more** for sixth-most, **188 more** for fifth-most, **219 more** for fourth-most, **246 more** for third-most (Brady's career high), **487 more** for second most and **488 more** to set a new NFL record for the most passing yards in a single season in NFL history.

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- The Buccaneers have **45.0 sacks** this season, tied for the fourth-most in a single season in team history. They need **one more** to pass 2004 (45.0) for fourth-most, **three more** to pass 2019 (47.0) for third-most, **four more** to pass 2020 (48.0) for second-most and **11.0 more** to pass 2000 (55.0) for the most sacks in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have **117 quarterback hits** this season, the most quarterback hits in a single season since at least 2006 when quarterback hits became regularly tracked.

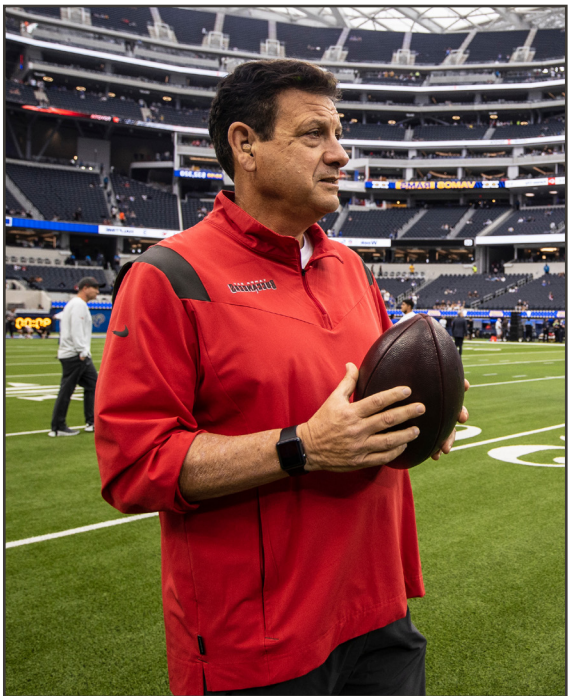
CONNECTIONS

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- Panthers WR **Robby Anderson** (2016-18), LB **Julian Stanford** (2016-17), S **Juston Burris** (2016-18), LB **Frankie Luvu** (2018-20) and LB **Julian Stanford** (2015-17) played for the New York Jets when Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** was the head coach in New York, Buccaneers Defensive Line Coach **Kacy Rodgers** was the defensive coordinator and Buccaneers Defensive Quality Control Coach **Tim Atkins** served in the same role for the Jets at this time.
- Panthers S **Jeremy Chinn** (2016-19) played at Southern Illinois when Buccaneers Assistant Tight Ends Coach **John Van Dam** was the Offensive Coordinator for the Salukis.
- Panthers QB **Matt Barkley** (2015, 2017) played under Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians** and a number of his assistants while with the Arizona Cardinals.
- Panthers OLB **Haason Reddick** (2017-20) also played for **Arians** and Buccaneers Outside Linebackers Coach **Larry Foote** during his time with the Cardinals.



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Buccaneers Outside Linebackers Coach **Larry Foote** (2015-18), Wide Receivers Coach **Kevin Garver** (2017-18) and Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** (2017-18) were all on the coaching staff in Arizona when Panthers Defensive Run Game Coordinator **Al Holcomb** was the defensive coordinator for the Cardinals in 2018.
- Buccaneers Safeties Coach **Nick Rapone** (1999-05) was the secondary coach at Temple University when Panthers Cornerbacks Coach **Evan Cooper** was a defensive back for the Owls.
- Buccaneers Defensive Line Coach **Kacy Rodgers** (2008-14) held the same position with the Miami Dolphins when Panthers Senior Offensive Assistant/Running Backs Coach **Jeff Nixon** (2011-15) was the running backs coach in Miami.
- Panthers Offensive Pass Game Coordinator/Wide Receivers Coach **Frisman Jackson** (2002-06) played under Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians** (2001-03) in Cleveland, while Arians served as offensive coordinator for the Browns. Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2001-04) and Running Backs Coach **Todd McNair** (2001-03) also were a part of the Browns coaching staff during this time.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

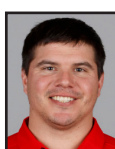

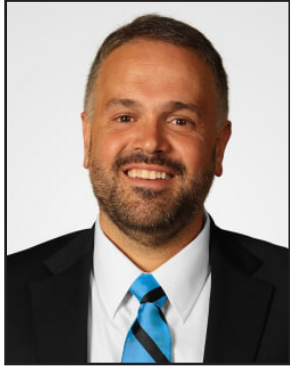

MATT RHULE



The Carolina Panthers announced Matt Rhule as the franchise's fifth head coach on January 8, 2020.

Rhule was hired as Carolina's head coach on January 8, 2020 after three seasons (2017-19) as the head coach at Baylor University. Rhule helped rebuild the Baylor program, guiding the team from a 1-11 finish in his first season to a 7-6 record and a bowl berth in 2018 to an 11-3 record and appearance in the Big 12 Championship and the Sugar Bowl in 2019. In 2019, he was voted the Chuck Neinas Coach of the Year by his peers.

MATT RHULE AT A GLANCE

- In his first season in 2020, the Panthers earned a 5-11 record, with 11 contests decided by eight points or fewer which tied for second-most in the NFL.
- Carolina had 11 rookies record defensive snaps with six starting at least one game. That group accounted for 287 tackles, the most by any first-year group in the NFL and fifth-most by a rookie class since 2000. The Panthers led the NFL with 15 fumble recoveries and tied for the league lead with three fumble recoveries for touchdowns.
- Offensively, Carolina became the fifth team in the Super Bowl era to have four different players (DJ Moore 1,215, Robby Anderson 1,111, Curtis Samuel 1,051 and Mike Davis 1,015) record over 1,000 scrimmage yards. The Panthers also set a franchise record for the fewest punts (45) in a season.
- Rhule went to Baylor after four seasons as head coach at Temple University. He guided the Owls to the school's first back-to-back 10-win seasons, a pair of bowl berths (2015-16), and the 2016 American Athletic Conference championship. He helped the Owls improve from a two-win season in his first year at the school in 2013.
- Rhule's first coaching stint in the NFL came under former New York Giants Head Coach Tom Coughlin, where he coached the offensive line alongside Pat Flaherty.
- Prior to his first stint in the NFL, Rhule spent six seasons as an assistant at Temple from 2006-11. He started as defensive line coach in 2006 before switching to the offensive side of the ball in 2007 as quarterbacks coach and recruiting coordinator. Rhule added offensive coordinator duties to his plate from 2008-10. In 2011, he served as tight ends coach.
- From 2002-05, Rhule was an assistant at Western Carolina, serving as assistant head coach during his last three seasons.
- He also was part of the staffs at UCLA (2001), Buffalo (1999-2000) and Albright College (1998).
- A native of New York City, Rhule played linebacker at Penn State from 1994-97. He holds a master's degree from Buffalo.
- Rhule and his wife Julie have three children, Bryant, Vivienne and Leona.
