WHAT TO WATCH FOR

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- Quarterback **Tom Brady** and tight end **Rob Gronkowski** have connected for **82 touchdowns** in the regular season and need **three more** to tie Steve Young and Jerry Rice (85) for the third-most touchdown connections in NFL history.

SHAQUIL BARRETT

- Barrett has **24.5 sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **1.5 more** to tie Greg Spires (26.0 from 2002-07) for the 10th-most sacks in franchise history.

TOM BRADY

- Brady has **25 passing touchdowns** this season. He needs **one more** to pass Josh Freeman (25 in 2010) and tie Brad Johnson (26 in 2003) for fourth-most, **two more** to tie Freeman (27 in 2012) for third-most and **three more** to tie Jameis Winston (28 in 2016) for the second-most passing touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Brady has two career regular season games with at least six passing touchdowns and needs **one more** such game to tie Peyton Manning (three) for the most such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has seven such games, tied with Ben Roethlisberger for the third-most in NFL history.

CAMERON BRATE

- Brate has **29 career touchdown catches**. He needs **two more** to tie Kevin House (31 from 1980-86) for the third-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Brate has **three career games with multiple touchdown receptions**. He needs **one more** to tie Jimmie Giles for the most ever such games by a Buccaneers tight end and tie for the third-most such games in franchise history.

ANTONIO BROWN

- Brown has **859 career receptions**, the 26th-most in NFL history. He needs **two more** to pass Muhsin Muhammad (860 from 1996-2009) for 25th-most and **four more** to pass Jimmy Smith (862 from 1992-2005) for the 24th-most receptions in NFL history.
- Brown has **11,420 career receiving yards**, the 33rd-most in NFL history. He needs **19 more** to pass Muhsin Muhammad (11,438 from 1996-2009) for the 32nd-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Brown has **75 career touchdown receptions**, tied for the 35th-most in NFL history. He needs **one more** to pass James Lofton (75 from 1978-1993) and tie Fred Biletnikoff (76 from 1965-1978) and Harold Jackson (76 from 1968-1983) for the 33rd-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.

MIKE EVANS

- Evans has **nine receiving touchdowns** this season. He needs **one more** to tie Joey Galloway (10 in 2005) for fourth-most, **two more** to tie Mike Williams (11 in 2010) and **three more** to tie his own mark (12 in 2014 & 2016) for the most receiving touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.



LAVONTE DAVID

- David has **24.0 career sacks**. He needs **2.5 more** to tie Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history.
- David has **three career defensive touchdowns** and needs **one more** to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979-96; Mike Washington, 1976-84).
- David has **started 132 games** in his NFL career. With **a start** against the Kansas City Chiefs, David will pass Buccaneers Ring of Honor member John Lynch (132) for the sixth-most starts by a Buccaneers player in franchise history.

CHRIS GODWIN

- Godwin has **3,165 career receiving yards**, the ninth-most in franchise history. He needs **279 more** to pass Gerald Carter (3,443 from 1981-87) for the eighth-most receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has **20 career touchdown receptions**. He needs one more to pass Vincent Jackson (20 from 2012-16) for the 10th-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.

ROB GRONKOWSKI

- Gronkowski has **83 regular season receiving touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to pass Calvin Johnson and Brandon Marshall (83) and tie Mark Clayton, Irving Fryar, Tommy McDonald and Andre Rison (84) for the 18th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has 95 receiving touchdowns and needs **one more** to pass Isaac Bruce (95) and Hines Ward (95) and tie Andre Reed (96) for the 12th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

JASON PIERRE-PAUL

- Pierre-Paul has 27.5 **sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **1.0 more** to pass Ronde Barber (28.0 from 1997-2012) for eighth-most in franchise history.

RYAN SUCCOP

- Succop contributed **96 points** this season. He needs **four more** to tie Rian Lindell (100 in 2013) for 10th-most, **five more** to tie Connor Barth (101 in 2011) for ninth-most, **nine more** to tie Barth (105 in 2010) for eighth-most and **10 more** to tie Martin Gramatica (106 in 1999) for seventh-most points in a single season in franchise history.

- Chiefs OL Mike Remmers spent the 2012 season with the Buccaneers.
- Chiefs Quarterbacks/Passing Game Coordinator Mike Kafka played for the Buccaneers in 2014.

FORMER CHIEFS

- Buccaneers DL Rakeem Nunez-Roches spent the 2015-17 seasons with the Chiefs before joining the Buccaneers.
- Buccaneers RB LeSean McCoy spent the 2019 season with Kansas City where he was a member of the Chiefs' Super Bowl LIV winning squad.
- Buccaneers Head Coach Bruce Arians was the running backs coach for the Chiefs from 1989-92.
- Buccaneers Running Backs Coach Todd McNair was drafted by the Chiefs in the 1989 NFL Draft and spent the first five seasons of his professional career with the organization before returning in 1996 for his final season in the NFL.
- Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach Kevin Ross was drafted by Kansas City in 1984 and spent 10 seasons with the organization before returning in 1997 for the final season of his NFL career.

FLORIDA TIES

- Chiefs Defensive Quality Control Coach Terry Bradden is a Riviera Beach native and attended Inlet Grove High School (Fla.). He also spent time coaching at Florida Atlantic in 2011 before returning as head coach of Inlet High School in 2015. Before joining the Chiefs in 2017, he served as a quarterbacks graduate assistant at Bethune-Cookman University.
- Chiefs Offensive Quality Control Coach David Girardi is a St. Petersburg native.

CONNECTIONS

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- When Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians** and multiple members of his current Tampa Bay staff were in Arizona, the organization selected Chiefs S **Tyrann Mathieu** with the 69th overall pick in the 2013 NFL Draft. Mathieu became one of the league's best safeties while working under Arians and his staff, becoming a Pro Bowler and First-Team All-Pro in the 2015 season after recording single-season career-high five interceptions to go along with 17 passes defended and 11 tackles for loss.
- Buccaneers OLB **Jason Pierre-Paul** (2010-17), CB **Ross Cockrell** (2017) and S **Andrew Adams** (2016-17) all played for the New York Giants when Chiefs Defensive Coordinator **Steve Spagnuolo** (2007-08, 2015-17) was the defensive coordinator and interim head coach for the organization.
- Buccaneers RB **Ronald Jones II** (2015-17) played at USC when Chiefs Running Backs Coach **Deland McCullough** held the same position for the Trojans that year.
- Buccaneers QB **Tom Brady** (2000-19) played for the New England Patriots when Chiefs Quarterbacks Coach/Pass Game Coordinator **Mike Kafka** (2013) also played quarterback in New England. Brady also played with Chiefs Wide Receivers Coach **Greg Lewis**, who was a receiver in New England in 2009.



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Buccaneers General Manager **Jason Licht** worked in the personnel department for the Philadelphia Eagles from 2003-07 while Chiefs Head Coach **Andy Reid** (1999-2012) and various members of the Kansas City staff coached the Eagles. The Eagles finished first in the NFC East in three of the five years Licht and Reid worked together, including a 2004 season that saw the franchise post a 13-3 regular season record and advance to Super Bowl XXXIX where it narrowly lost to Buccaneers QB Tom Brady and the New England Patriots.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** spent the 2012 season in Philadelphia as the secondary coach/interim defensive coordinator, working under Chiefs Head Coach **Andy Reid** (1999-2012). Buccaneers Inside Linebackers Coach **Mike Caldwell** spent multiple seasons with Reid in Philadelphia, holding multiple positions on the defensive coaching staff from 2007-12 after playing linebacker for Reid from 1998-2001.
- Buccaneers Offensive Line Coach **Joe Gilbert** (1994-99) was the offensive line coach and offensive coordinator at Maine when Chiefs Defensive Coordinator **Steve Spagnuolo** (1993-94) was the defensive coordinator for the program in the 1994 season.
- Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** played quarterback for the Jacksonville Jaguars from 2003-06, working with Chiefs Offensive Line Coach **Andy Heck**, who held the same position and was an assistant at the position for the Jaguars from 2004-12.
- Buccaneers Defensive/Special Teams Assistant **Keith Tandy** played safety for the Buccaneers from 2012-17 and was teammates with Chiefs Quarterbacks Coach/Pass Game Coordinator **Mike Kafka**, who played quarterback for the organization in 2014.

HC BRUCE ARIANS



CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

ANDY REID



Andy Reid enters his eighth season at the helm of the Chiefs in 2020. He was hired as the club's 13th head coach in franchise history on January 7, 2013.

Entering his 22nd season as an NFL head coach, Reid adds Super Bowl champion to his resume after he led his squad to a 31-20 come-from-behind win in Super Bowl LIV. He owns a 207-128-1 regular season record and adds a 15-14 postseason record, giving him 222 total wins, which rank sixth in NFL history and just second among active head coaches, trailing only New England Head Coach Bill Belichick. Reid joined the Chiefs

after 14 seasons as Head Coach/Executive Vice President of Football Operations of the Philadelphia Eagles where he compiled a 130-93-1 (.583) regular season record. Including his years as an assistant coach, Reid's teams have made the playoffs 21 times (24-18 record), and he has coached in four Super Bowls and 10 Championship Games (8 NFC, 2 AFC). He owns three NFL Coach of the Year titles.

ANDY REID AT A GLANCE

- Since his arrival in Kansas City, Reid's teams have made it to the playoffs six out of seven seasons, including back-to-back AFC Championship Game appearances (2018-19). In seven seasons under Reid, the Chiefs have recorded six 10-plus win seasons and a .669 (77-35) winning percentage, which is the top mark in franchise history for any coach in his first seven seasons leading the club.
- In 2019, Reid's 12-4 Chiefs finished the regular season as AFC West Champs for a franchise-record fourth-straight season and secured the No. 2 seed in the AFC. The club defeated Houston 51-31 in the divisional round and Tennessee 35-24 in the AFC Championship Game on it's way to returning to the Super Bowl for the third time in franchise history and first since the club won Super Bowl IV following the 1969 season. In Super Bowl LIV in Miami, Florida, Reid's Chiefs fell behind 20-10.
- Reid joined Philadelphia as head coach in 1999 and remained in that role through the 2012 season, becoming one of just 11 first-time NFL head coaches to lead 12-or-more seasons with the same club. Reid assumed the additional role of Executive Vice President of Football Operations in 2001.
- While compiling his 10-9 postseason record with Philadelphia, Reid led the Eagles franchise to one Super Bowl appearance, a game that saw Philadelphia fall by a mere field goal to the New England Patriots in Super Bowl XXXIX following the 2004 season. Reid guided Philadelphia to nine playoff appearances (2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010) during his 14-year tenure in the City of Brotherly Love. During that time period, only Indianapolis (12) and New England (10) had more postseason appearances than the Eagles.
- In 2008, Reid became the 37th coach to reach the 100-win plateau and the 22nd to win 100 games with one franchise. He overcame a 5-5-1 start to reach the NFC Championship Game.
- During his seven years with the Packers, Reid served as the tight ends coach and assistant offensive line coach (1992-96) and as quarterbacks coach (1997-98). In his span with the Packers, the team reached the playoffs six times and represented the NFC twice in back-to-back Super Bowls, defeating New England in Super Bowl XXXI and falling to Denver in Super Bowl XXXII.
- Reid coached collegiately at Missouri, UTEP, Northern Arizona and San Francisco State.
- He played collegiately as an offensive tackle and guard at BYU from 1979-81 before entering the coaching ranks as a graduate assistant at BYU under LaVell Edwards in 1982.
- The Los Angeles native and his wife, Tammy, have five children and nine grandchildren.
