

CONSISTENCY COUNTS

· Since his breakout season in 2019, Chris Godwin ranks fourth among qualified receivers in yards after catch per game and seventh in receiving yards per game. Godwin's current 13-game streak with fiveor-more receptions is the longest in the NFL this season and the second-longest in franchise history.

· In Week 14, Tom Brady threw his 100th touchdown pass with Tampa Bay, making him the fifth quarterback in league history to throw 100-or-more touchdown passes with multiple teams (Peyton Manning, Carson Palmer, Fran Tarkenton, Kurt Warner).



· Brady currently ranks second in the NFL in passing yards this season with 4,610. Since arriving in Tampa Bay in 2020, his 14,559 passing yards trail only Patrick Mahomes.








CONNECTIONS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Named 2014 Assistant Coach of the Year by the Pro Football Writers Association and the Associated Press.
- X The architect of Tampa Bay's Super Bowl LV-winning defense during the 2020 NFL
- X Bowles' defenses have finished inside the top five in fewest yards per play five times (2013, 2015, 2019, 2020, 2021).
- X Placing a heavy emphasis on stopping the run, Bowles' defenses have led the NFL in fewest rushing yards allowed per game three times (2014, 2019, 2020).
- X 23 different players have earned Pro Bowl selections with Bowles as their position coach, defensive coordinator or head coach.
- X Enjoyed an eight-year career as an NFL defensive back, playing for Washington (1986-1990, 1992-93) and the San Francisco 49ers.
- X Started 12 games and contributed four interceptions for a Washington team that won Super Bowl XXII.

'AMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019-21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached five different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021) and Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021).
- X First Buccaneers coach to begin career 2-0 since Sam Wyche in 1992, and the first to do it with a pair of road wins.
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-toback seasons from 2019-20.
- X In his three seasons as defensive coordinator, Tampa Bay ranked first in fewest rushing yards allowed per game (82.5), first in fewest rushing vards per attempt (3.72), first in quarterback hits (352), first in fumble recoveries (37), first in passes defensed (241), second in strip sacks (26), third in tackles for loss (262), third in takeaways (82), third in sacks (142), fourth in forced fumbles (52), tied for fourth in defensive touchdowns (nine), fifth in fewest yards per play allowed (5.13) and fifth in passing yards per attempt allowed (6.78).

Arthur Smith was named the 18th head coach in Atlanta Falcons history on January 15, 2021 and took over the club after serving as the Tennessee Titans offensive coordinator for the previous two seasons (2019–2020).

In his first year at the helm, the Falcons posted a 7-10 record. Under Smith's guidance, nine-year veteran running back Cordarrelle Patterson set single-season career highs for rushing yards (618), receiving yards (548), rushing touchdowns (six) and receiving touchdowns (five), and became the first

player to record at least five rushing and five receiving touchdowns in a single season in franchise history. Additionally, tight end Kyle Pitts became the second rookie tight end to surpass 1,000 receiving yards in NFL history, joining Pro Football Hall of Famer Mike Ditka (1,076 yards in 1961). Pitts also became the first rookie tight end to be selected to the Pro Bowl since New York's Jeremy Shockey in 2002.

ARTHUR SMITH AT A GLANCE

- Prior to his tenure in Atlanta, Smith orchestrated one of the NFL's top offenses with the Titans leading the league in red-zone touchdown percentage (75.2), ranking fifth points per game (27.9) and fifth in total offense (379.6). He oversaw the second-ranked rushing attack in the NFL, averaging 153.5 yards per game on the ground.
- He oversaw one of the most potent rushing attacks in league history as Derrick Henry became just the eighth player in NFL history to rush for more than 2,000 yards in a single season.
- Smith also has been credited with revitalizing the career of quarterback Ryan Tannehill. In two seasons running Smith's offense, Tannehill started 26 games and totaled 6,561 passing yards with 55 touchdowns, 13 interceptions, and a 110.6 passer rating, while completing 67.3 percent of his passes. Tannehill was named to the Pro Bowl in 2019.
- In 2019, Smith helped lead the Titans to the team's first AFC Championship Game appearance in 17 years. In his first season as offensive coordinator, the Titans led the NFL in red-zone efficiency (75.6 percent), ranked third in rushing offense (138.9 yards per game), and fourth in yards per play (6.12).
- In Tennessee, Smith worked his way up from his 2011 position of defensive assistant/quality control coach. He also spent time as an offensive assistant/quality control coach (2012), offensive line/tight ends assistant (2013), and assistant tight ends coach (2014-15) before taking over as tight ends coach during the 2015 season and holding the position through 2018.
- Prior to joining the Titans, Smith spent two years as the defensive quality control coach for the Washington Football Team from 2007-08. He also worked as a college scouting assistant in Washington in 2007. In 2010, Smith worked at Ole Miss as an administrative assistant/defensive intern, primarily working with the linebackers.
- Smith graduated from North Carolina where he played offensive line and later joined the Tar Heels coaching staff as a graduate assistant (2006), working with the offensive line. Born and raised in Memphis, Tenn., he went to high school at Georgetown Prep (North Bethesda, Md.). Smith and his wife, Allison, currently live in Nashville with their two sons, Tanner and Liam, and their daughter, Sophie.
