THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

• Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). Over his last eight quarters of regular season football, Brady threw for 1,067 yards and 10 touchdowns with just one interception.

GETTING RED ZONE RESULTS



• The Buccaneers offense scored a touchdown on 42-of-61 trips inside the red zone this season, while leading the NFL with a 95.1 scoring percentage (58-of-61) on red zone drives.

• The team found success through the air in the red zone, recording 27 red zone passing touchdowns, tied for the second-most in the NFL this season.

A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN

• With 1,006 yards in 2020, Mike Evans became the first player in NFL history with 1,000-or-more receiving yards in each of his first seven NFL seasons, surpassing Randy Moss (first six seasons).

• Evans set a new franchise record with 13 receiving touchdowns (fourth in the NFL) and is Tampa Bay's all-time leader in receptions, receiving yards and receiving touchdowns.

ROUGHING UP THE RUN GAME



In 2018, the Buccaneers ranked 20th in defensive rush average and 24th in rush yards allowed per game. Tampa Bay has now led the NFL in run defense in each of the past two seasons under Todd Bowles, becoming the first team to accomplish that feat since the Minnesota Vikings (2006-08).

FORMER BUCCANEERS

- Titans General Manager **Jon Robinson** was the director of player personnel for the Buccaneers during the 2014 and 2015 seasons. He spent six total seasons working with Buccaneers General Manager **Jason Licht** in New England (2002, 2009-11) and Tampa Bay (2014-15).
- Titans RB **Jeremy McNichols** was drafted by the Buccaneers in the fifth round (162nd overall) of the 2017 NFL Draft.
- Titans TE **Luke Stocker** was drafted by the Buccaneers in the fourth round (104th overall) of the 2014 NFL Draft. He played 71 games for Tampa Bay from 2011-2017.
- Titans Assistant Offensive Line Coach **Mike Sullivan** played for the Buccaneers from 1992-95.
- Titans Quarterbacks Coach **Pat O'Hara** was a 10th-round selection by the Buccaneers in the 1991 NFL Draft and played for the team his rookie season.

- Buccaneers QB **Tom Brady** (2000-19) was teammates with Titans Head Coach **Mike Vrabel** (2001-08) in New England, winning three Super Bowls in their time together and earning an overall record of 97-31 (.758). Vrabel caught eight touchdown passes from Brady during his regular season career and two more in their postseason contests. Vrabel accumulated 606 career tackles, 48.0 sacks and 11 interceptions during his time with the Patriots.
- Titans WR **Julio Jones** (2008-10) was a wide receiver for the Alabama Crimson Tide when Buccaneers Wide Receivers Coach **Kevin Garver** (2007-12) was a member of the program's coaching staff. The duo won a national championship together in 2009, and Garver went on to win two more (2011, 2012) before taking his coaching career to the professional level.
- Buccaneers Quarterbacks Coach **Clyde Christensen** (2016-17) was the Offensive Coordinator in Miami from 2016-17 and the Director of Football & Player Development in 2018, while Titans QB **Ryan Tannehill** was the team's quarterback (2012-18).
- Buccaneers DL **Ndamukong Suh** played three seasons under Titans Defensive Line Coach **Terrell Williams** in Miami (2015-17). During that time, Suh ranked eighth among defensive tackles with 15.5 sacks.

HC BRUCE ARIANS



CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. MIKE VRABEL



Mike Vrabel is in his fourth season with the Titans after being named head coach on Jan. 20, 2018. He became the 19th head coach in franchise history.

In 2020, the Titans made their second consecutive playoff appearance under Vrabel, who tied Jack Pardee (1990 to 1992) for the most wins (31) and best winning percentage (.596; 31-21) in franchise history over a head coach's first three seasons with the organization. The Titans won the 2020 AFC South title with an 11-5 record in the regular season, claiming their best record and first

division title since going 13-3 in 2008. They finished with a 5-1 record within the division and a 6-2 mark in road games, all while navigating the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic.

MIKE VRABEL AT A GLANCE

- The Titans led the NFL in 2020 with a plus-11 turnover differential as their 23 takeaways ranked seventh in the NFL and their 12 turnovers were the second-fewest in the league. Tennessee tied for second in total offense (396.4 yards per game) and ranked fourth in scoring offense (30.7 points per game).
- In 2020, Tennessee became the first team in NFL history to generate at least 2,500 rushing yards (2,690) and 3,500 net passing yards (3,653) while surrendering 25 or fewer sacks (25).
- From 2018-20, the Titans were a top-10 team in scoring defense. They allowed opponents to score 22.4 points per game during that stretch, the eighth-lowest average in the NFL.
- In 2019, Vrabel led the Titans to the AFC Championship Game for the first time since 2002. His 20 wins over his first two seasons in Tennessee were the second most in franchise history.
- Vrabel ascended quickly to his position as a head coach following a 14-year playing career as a linebacker with the Pittsburgh Steelers (1997-2000), New England Patriots (2001-08), and Kansas City Chiefs (2009-10). He spent three years as an assistant coach at Ohio State (2011-13) and four years on the Houston Texans staff (2014-17), including one season as the team's defensive coordinator (2017).
- Vrabel's accomplishments as a player included three Super Bowl wins (2001, 2003 and 2004), one Pro Bowl selection (2007) and an All-Pro honor (2007). He appeared in 206 NFL games and totaled 57.0 sacks, 496 tackles, 11 interceptions (one returned for a touchdown), 20 forced fumbles and nine fumble recoveries.
- Vrabel has played or coached under Bill Belichick, Bill Cowher, Romeo Crennel, Urvan Meyer and Bill O'Brien.
- In 2012, Vrabel was part of an Ohio State program that finished the season undefeated at 12-0. He was named the Big Ten Recruiter of the Year that season by ESPN.com.
- Vrabel is a native of Akron, Ohio, and attended Walsh Jesuit High School. He and his wife, Jennifer, have two sons: Tyler and Carter.
