FIRST THINGS FIRST

- The Buccaneers are looking for their sixth-consecutive win in Week 1 — currently tied with Philadelphia for the longest active streak in the league (five). Todd Bowles is a perfect 4-0 in Week 1 as Buccaneers head coach, and Baker Mayfield is a perfect 3-0 as the team's Week 1 starter.
- 2018 No. 1 overall pick Baker Mayfield is 3-0 in his career vs. 2020 No. 1 overall pick Joe Burrow — all with Cleveland.
- Sunday will mark the 14th all-time regular season meeting between the Buccaneers and Bengals, with Tampa Bay holding a 7-6 edge in the series. The Buccaneers have won 5-of-8 all-time road contests, including four of the past five.

STEERING THE SHIP: A NEW ERA BEGINS FOR THE BUCCANEERS DEFENSE



TAMPA BAIN

When he was selected with the No. 15 overall pick in the 2026 NFL Draft, Rueben Bain Jr. became just the second defensive player that the Buccaneers have drafted in the first round out of the University of Miami. The other was Pro Football Hall of Famer Warren Sapp, whose jersey Bain wore on his first day reporting to Rookie Mini-Camp.

MATCHING UP



BUCCANEERS IN WEEK 1



The Buccaneers have won their last five season-opening games and look to extend the streak to six. The Buccaneers open their season against the Cincinnati Bengals for the second time in team history and the first time since Sept. 7, 1980 when the Buccaneers won, 17-12, at Cincinnati.

WEEK 1 BAKER

Baker Mayfield owns a perfect 3-0 record in Week 1 since joining the Buccaneers in 2023, including going 2-0 in Week 1 road games. In all Week 1 appearances for Tampa Bay, Mayfield has thrown 9 touchdown passes, with zero interceptions, earning a 114.5 passer rating over those three contests. He is 1-of-3 quarterbacks with a 3-0 record in Week 1 since 2023, along with Philadelphia Eagles QB Jalen Hurts and San Francisco 49ers QB Brock Purdy, and Mayfield is the only one of the group to have not thrown an interception over that span. His 114.5 passer rating trails only Aaron Rodgers (115.1) among players who have started in Week 1 each of the past three seasons.



The Sept. 13 matchup will be Mayfield's first time meeting the Bengals as a Buccaneer. Mayfield has recorded at least two touchdown passes in his last five games against the Bengals dating back to Week 17 of the 2019 season.

Mayfield has thrown a Week 1 touchdown pass to a rookie in each of the past three seasons. It's the longest active streak in the league of team's having a Week 1 rookie receiving touchdown.

SETTING A STANDARD



Head Coach Todd Bowles and Baker Mayfield are undefeated together in Week 1, going 3-0.

Their record ties San Francisco (Brock Purdy/Kyle Shanahan) for the second-best among active head coach-quarterback duos, trailing only Philadelphia (5-0, Jalen Hurts/Nick Sirianni).

Tampa Bay has won each of its last five season-opening games, tying Philadelphia for the longest active Week 1 winning streak in the NFL. The Buccaneers' five-game streak is the longest in franchise history, surpassing the team's three-game run from 1979-81.

Over the last five seasons, Tampa Bay has averaged 26.0 points per game in Week 1, tied for the sixth-highest mark in the NFL, while allowing just 17.8 points per game, the fourth-lowest average in the league. The Buccaneers' +8.2 average point differential during that span ranks third in the NFL.

Since Todd Bowles' arrival in 2019, the Buccaneers have allowed an average of 79.9 rushing yards in Week 1, the second fewest in the league. The Buccaneers have held opponents to 3.2 yards per carry in Week 1 games during that stretch, the best mark in the NFL.

TAKEAWAY THREAT

The Buccaneers have recorded 16 interceptions against the Cincinnati Bengals, the fifth-most among NFC teams since 1976. Tampa Bay has totaled seven interceptions in its last four meetings with Cincinnati and is 3-1 all-time when recording multiple interceptions in a game vs. Cincinnati.

Mayfield rushed for a career-high 382 yards in 2025. He carried the ball 29 times on third down, with 21 going for first downs (72.4% success rate). That was the second-highest first-down rush percentage on third-down attempts among all quarterbacks with 15+ third-down carries and the fourth-highest mark in the entire NFL. Mayfield's 259 rushing yards on third down led the entire NFL in 2025.

On his way to the fifth-best third-down rushing success rate in the league, **Mayfield** did it by extending plays and picking up extensive yardage. His 8.9 yards per rush on third down were the second-most among qualified players and his 6.9 yards per rush overall led all quarterbacks in 2025.

Tristan Wirfs was selected for the 2026 Pro Bowl Games, earning his fifth consecutive nod (2021-25). His five Pro Bowl selections are the third-most by an offensive player in team history, trailing only Mike Alstott and Mike Evans (six each).

Wirfs was the only offensive lineman in 2025 to have finished top five in each offensive, run blocking and pass blocking grades per Pro Football Focus.

Chase McLaughlin reset the Buccaneers single-season franchise record for field goal percentage in consecutive seasons, posting a 93.5% clip in 2023 and following that up with a 93.8% mark in 2024. He also set a franchise record by making 30 consecutive field goals from 10/26/23 to 10/21/24 and has made the **most field goals made of 50+ yards in team history (26)**, including an **11-for-11 stretch on 50+ yard field goal attempts in 2025, which set a new record for the longest streak within a season without a miss in league history**. His 65-yarder in Week 4 was the then **longest outdoor field goal in NFL history** and remains the **longest made field goal in franchise history**.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

TODD BOWLES

- Needs **1 win** to surpass Bruce Arians (36) for the fourth-most total wins in franchise history, including playoffs (37).
- Needs **1 win** to move to 5-0 in Week 1 as Buccaneers head coach and become 1-of-4 head coaches since 2000 to win each of their first five Week 1 games with a single team, joining Nick Sirianni (2021-25), Sean McVay (2017-21) and John Harbaugh (2008-12). Currently, Bowles is 1-of-7 head coaches since 2000 to win each of their first four Week 1 games with a team alongside Sirianni, McVay, John Harbaugh, Doug Pederson (2016-19), Jim Harbaugh (2011-14) and Mike Tomlin (2007-10).



JASON LIGHT

- Needs **1 win** to reach 100 career wins, including playoffs, becoming the first general manager in franchise history to reach the 100-win milestone.

CADE OTTON

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to surpass Calvin Magee and Alex Smith (11) and tie Kellen Winslow (12) for the sixth-most receiving touchdowns among tight ends in franchise history.
- Needs **3 receptions** for the fourth-most by a tight end in franchise history.
- Needs **12 receptions** for the third-most by a tight end in team history.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR

BAKER MAYFIELD

- Needs **2 passing touchdowns** to tie Tom Brady (31) for the second-most games in franchise history with multiple touchdown passes.
- Needs **2 passing touchdowns** to break a tie with Lamar Jackson (five) for the most career multi-touchdown performances vs. Cincinnati among all active starting quarterbacks (six).
- Needs **3 passing touchdowns** to reach 200 for his career (regular season only). He would become just the 16th quarterback in NFL history to reach 200 career passing touchdowns in 125-or-fewer games played.
- Needs **1 win** to tie Jameis Winston (28) for the fourth-most wins by a starting quarterback in team history.
- Needs **250 passing yards** to surpass Josh Freeman (23) for the third-most 250-yard passing games in franchise history.
- Needs **300 passing yards** to tie Vinny Testaverde (12) for the third-most 300-yard passing games in franchise history.
- Needs a **90.0+ passer rating** to tie Jameis Winston (34) for the most career games with a 90+ passer rating in franchise history.
- Needs **four completions** to surpass Trent Dilfer (1,117) for the fifth-most, **13 completions** to surpass Vinny Testaverde (1,126) for the fourth-most and **31 completions** to surpass Josh Freeman (1,144) for the third-most career completions in franchise history.



ANTOINE WINFIELD JR.

- Needs **1 interception** to record the 10th of his career. He can become the 16th defensive back in NFL history (since sacks became an official statistic in 1982) to record 500+ tackles, 15.0+ sacks and 10+ interceptions. He would join Bill Bates, Dave Duerson, Rodney Harrison, Derwin James Jr. and Adrian Wilson as the only players to do so in their first seven career seasons.
