THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

• Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). **Brady currently ranks first in the NFL in both passing touchdowns and passing yards.**

• Brown ranks tied for 12th in league history in 100-yard receiving games with 46, and ranks second since entering the league in 2010.

THE BUZZ AROUND BOWLES' DEFENSE



Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020 and ranking 11th in 2021.

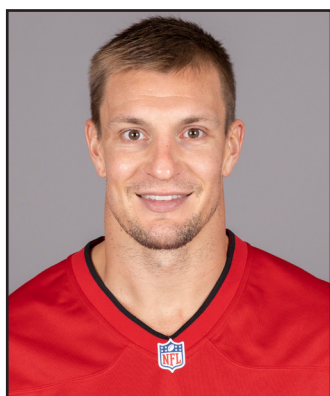

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- The Buccaneers have scored **442 points** this season, the third-most in a single season in team history. They need **17 more** to pass 2019 (458) for the second-most points in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have scored **55 touchdowns** this season, the second-most in a single season in team history. They need **five more** to surpass 2020 (59) for the most touchdowns in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have totaled **6,025 net yards** this season, the fourth-most in a single season in team history. They need **121 more** to pass 2020 (6,145) for third-most, **342 more** to pass 2019 (6,366) for second-most and **624 more** to pass 2018 (6,648) for the most yards in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have totaled **4,500 net passing yards** this season, the fourth-most in a single season in team history. They need **127 more** to pass 2020 (4,626) for third-most, **346 more** to pass 2019 (4,845) for second-most and **626 more** to pass 2018 (5,125) for the most yards in a single season in team history.

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- The Buccaneers have **357 first downs** this season, the third-most in a single season in team history. They need **eight more** to pass 2020 (364) for second-most and **32 more** to pass 2018 (388) for the most first downs in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have **44.0 sacks** this season, tied for the fifth-most in a single season in team history. They need **two more** to pass 2004 (45.0) for fourth-most, **four more** to pass 2019 (47.0) for third-most, **five more** to pass 2020 (48.0) for second-most and **12.0 more** to pass 2000 (55.0) for the most sacks in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have **113 quarterback hits** this season, the third-most in a single season since quarterback hits became regularly tracked in 2006. They need **two more** to pass 2019 (114) for second-most and **three more** to pass 2000 (115) for the most quarterback hits in a single season since at least 2006.

HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

Robert Saleh (pronounced: SAH-luh) was named the head coach of the New York Jets by Vice Chairman Christopher Johnson on January 19, 2021.

Now in his 17th season coaching in the NFL, Saleh spent the last four seasons as the defensive coordinator with San Francisco. Since 2017, his group ranked third in the league in passing yards allowed (211.4), holding opposing quarterbacks to the eighth lowest completion percentage (62.9%), while producing Pro Bowl players at linebacker (Fred Warner), cornerback (Richard Sherman) and defensive line (Nick Bosa & DeForest Buckner), while Bosa was also selected as the 2019 Defensive Player of the Year by the Associated Press.

ROBERT SALEH AT A GLANCE

- The last two seasons under Saleh, the 49ers defense led the league in passing defense (188.6), ranking in the top 10 in passer rating allowed (85.8), completion percentage allowed (62.4%), tackles for loss (154) and defensive touchdowns (six), while also helping San Francisco advance to Super Bowl LIV.
- A key part of the team's Super Bowl LIV run in 2019, Saleh's defense finished second in total defense, first in passing defense and third in third-down defense, while producing 48 sacks, tied for the fifth most in the league, and 28 takeaways, the sixth most. In the postseason, the defense allowed just over 300 yards per game, holding opponents to just 31.4% on third down and producing seven total takeaways, including two interceptions of league MVP Patrick Mahomes in the Super Bowl, the only game Mahomes had more than one interception that season.
- Coaching linebackers for three seasons in Jacksonville, Saleh oversaw a linebacker group that included Posluszny and Telvin Smith as the pair each finished in the top five in the league in total tackles between 2015-16 (according to Radar360). The team's linebackers were also a key part of a Jaguars defense that ranked fifth in passing defense and sixth in opponent rushing average in 2016, and fifth in rushing average allowed in 2015.
- Prior to his time in Jacksonville, Saleh spent three seasons in Seattle as a defensive quality control coach. In those three seasons, he helped develop linebackers Bobby Wagner (2012 second-round pick) and K.J. Wright (2011 fourth-round pick) as the two became future Pro Bowl selections. A part of the Seahawks Super Bowl XLVIII winning staff, another of the team's linebackers, seventh-round pick Malcolm Smith, earned MVP honors after Smith registered nine tackles, a fumble recovery and a 69-yard interception returned for a touchdown.
- Before his start as an NFL coach, Saleh spent four seasons coaching college football at Georgia (2005), Central Michigan (2004) and Michigan State (2002).
- A native of Dearborn, MI, Saleh attended Northern Michigan University where he started for four years at tight end.
- Saleh and his wife, Sanaa, have six children, sons, Adam, Zane, Michael and Sam, and daughters, Mila and Ella. The couple are expecting their seventh later this year. Born to Lebanese parents, Sam and Fatin, he is considered one of three Arab-American head coaches in NFL history and believed to be the first Muslim-American head coach.
