





# **COACHING CONNECTIONS**

- Buccaneers Quarterbacks Coach Clyde Christensen coached alongside Steelers Head Coach Mike Tomlin in Tampa Bay in 2001.
- Buccaneers Senior Advisor to the General Manager Bruce Arians worked under Steelers Head Coach **Mike Tomlin** for five seasons in Pittsburgh as the offensive coordinator.
- In addition, Arians served as the head coach at Temple (1983-88) while Steelers Assistant Head Coach John Mitchell served as the defensive ends coach (1986).
- Steelers Tight Ends Coach Alfredo Roberts (2003-06) served as a tight ends coach with the Jacksonville Jaguars while Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator Byron Leftwich (2003-06) was a quarterback for the Jaguars. Additionally, Steelers Quarterbacks Coach Mike Sullivan (2003) served as an offensive assistant with the Jaguars during this time. Buccaneers Assistant Head Coach/Run Game Coordinator Harold Goodwin (2012) and Offensive Line Coach Joe Gilbert (2012-17) worked with Steelers Tight Ends Coach Alfredo Roberts while with the Indianapolis Colts.

# FORMER BUCCANEERS

- Steelers Head Coach Mike Tomlin spent five seasons as the Defensive Backs Coach for the Buccaneers (2001-05), In 2002, Tampa Bay's secondary led the league with 31 interceptions, culminating with a four-interception performance in the team's Super Bowl XXXVII win.
- Steelers Conditioning Coordinator Garrett **Giemont** worked in the same role for three seasons with the Buccaneers (2003-05).
- Steelers Tight Ends Coach Alfredo Roberts served in the same role while with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers (2009-11).
- Steelers Quarterbacks Coach Mike Sullivan served as the offensive coordinator for the Buccaneers for two seasons (2012-13).

# FORMER STEELERS

- Buccaneers Senior Advisor to the General Manager Bruce Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers three as a wide receivers coach (2004-06) and five as the offensive coordinator (2007-11). During his tenure, Pittsburgh won Super Bowl XL and Super Bowl XLIII.
- Buccaneers Assistant Head Coach/Run Game Coordinator Harold Goodwin spent five seasons as an offensive assistant with the Steelers (2007-11).
- Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator Bvron Leftwich played for the Steelers in 2008 and from 2010-12.
- Buccaneers Pass Game Coordinator/Inside Linebackers Coach Larry Foote played 11 seasons for the Steelers (2002-08, 2010-13).
- Buccaneers OL Fred Johnson (2019) played for one season with the Steelers.
- Senior Offensive Assistant **Tom Moore** served as a wide receivers coach (1977-1982) and as the offensive coordinator (1983-1989) with the Steelers.



Mike Tomlin was named the 16th head coach in franchise history on January 22, 2007.

Tomlin became the youngest head coach in NFL history to both coach in and win a Super Bowl when he led the Steelers to a 27-23 victory over the Arizona Cardinals in Super Bowl XLIII (36 years, 323 days).

Over his tenure in Pittsburgh, Tomlin has led the Steelers to seven AFC North titles, 10 playoff appearances and two Super Bowl appearances.

Through his first 15 NFL seasons as a head coach, Tomlin has never had a losing season. His streak of 15 consecutive seasons without a losing record is the longest-such streak to begin a head coaching career in NFL history.

# MIKE TOMLIN AT A GLANCE

- Tomlin has sent a total of 70 selections to the Pro Bowl, including four in 2021.
- Tomlin has won at least five home games in eaach of his first 15 years as a head coach, including six in 2021.
- He is one of just 20 head coaches to reach the 150 career wins milestone. Tomlin registered 150 career victories in the fourth-fewest games in NFL history (232).
- In 2021, Tomlin led the Steelers to a 9-7-1 record and captured a playoff berth for the 10th time in his Steelers career. Under his guidance, Pittsburgh led the NFL in sacks (55) for the fifth-straight season.
- Prior to becoming the head coach in Pittsburgh, Tomlin spent one season as the defensive coordinator for the Minnesota Vikings in 2006. His defense did not allow a 100-yard rusher that entire season and finished eighth in the NFL in total defense.
- Tomlin broke into the NFL as the defensive backs coach for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers from 2001-05. In 2022, he guided one of the most productive defensive backfields in the NFL, culminating with its performance in Super Bowl XXXVII. The secondary recorded four of the team's five interceptions, returning two for touchdowns, to help Tampa Bay capture its first Super Bowl title.
- Before ascending to the NFL ranks, Tomlin held collegiate roles at the University of Cincinnati (1999-2000), Arkansas State (1997-98), the University of Memphis (1996) and the Virginia Military Institute (1995).
- He was a three-year starter at wide receiver at William & Mary (1990-94), finishing his career with 101 receptions for 2,054 yards and 20 touchdowns. A first-team All-Yankee Conference selection in 1994, Tomlin established a program record with a 20.2 yards-percatch average.
- Tomlin is very active in the community and was recognized, along with his wife Kiya, in February 2013, by the Chuck Cooper Foundation with the Career Achievement in Leadership Diversity and Community Service Award. Tomlin also participates in the annual ManUp Pittsburgh conference, which encourages local men to be better fathers and role models.
