CEMENTING HIS LEGACY - LAVONTE IS PLAYING LIGHTS OUT IN YEAR 12



Lavonte David needs just two tackles to surpass Rondé Barber (1,428) for the second-most in franchise history.

David shares the lead among all active NFL players in forced fumbles (28) and is fourth in TFL (154).

Since Week 6, David leads the NFL in both tackles (55) and tackles for loss (eight).

David is 1-of-2 players in the NFL this season with 75+ tackles and 10+ tackles for loss (Quincy Williams).

OFFENSIVE NOTES

A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

• Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.



• Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

PROFICIENCY IN PASS PROTECTION

• Since the arrival of All-Pro tackle Tristan Wirfs in 2020, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.3%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (17). So far in 2023, the Buccaneers have allowed just 16 sacks through Week 10.

• The Buccaneers offensive line is tied for fifth in the league lead in fewest quarterback hits allowed this season (42), tied for the fourth-fewest sacks (16) and ranks fifth in fewest sacks allowed per pass attempt (5.0%).

• When Baker Mayfield has faced pressure, he ranks first among all QBs this season in passer rating, second in passing touchdowns and second in touchdown-to-interception ratio.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

RAISING THE LEVEL IN THE REDZONE



· Through Week 10, Tampa Bay has allowed its opponents to reach the end zone on just 32.1% of redzone possessions, the best defensive mark in the NFL this season. Tampa Bay's nine redzone touchdowns allowed are tied for the fewest in the NFL this season.

· In addition, Buccaneers opponents have scored touchdowns on just 37.5% of goal-to-go drives, the best mark in the NFL.

A DO-IT-ALL SAFETY



· Antoine Winfield Jr. is tied for first in the league with three fumble recoveries this season, matching his single-season career high. He is the only player in the league with three-or-more forced fumbles and three-or-more fumble recoveries.

· Winfield Jr. and Steelers edge rusher T.J. Watt are

the only players this season with multiple forced fumbles, multiple fumble recoveries and multiple sacks.

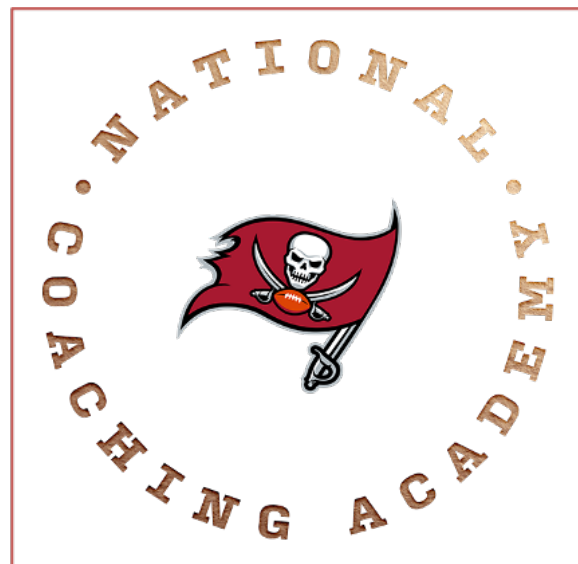
IN THE COMMUNITY

NATIONAL COACHING ACADEMY

- On Oct. 31, the Tampa Bay Buccaneers established a coaching academy that delivers an intensive, comprehensive curriculum and opportunity to participate in the team's 2024 rookie minicamp for coaching candidates seeking their first entry into the NFL.

- The Tampa Bay Buccaneers National Coaching Academy is open to all persons with three or more years of coaching or work experience in a football program at the high school, college or semi-professional league level, irrespective of background or status. Twenty-five finalists will be selected from a nationwide search and participants will be awarded full scholarships to cover costs in Tampa for the weeklong Academy.

- The inaugural class will receive valuable on-field experience, interactive sessions, business insights, media training, film review, and instruction on key football software with NFL players, coaches and staff. Participants will be given hands-on instruction as well as valuable networking opportunities with Buccaneers coaches and staff members throughout the organization. The Academy complements the NFL's long-established Bill Walsh Diversity Coaching Fellowship, created in 1987, to open pathways for minority coaches into the league.

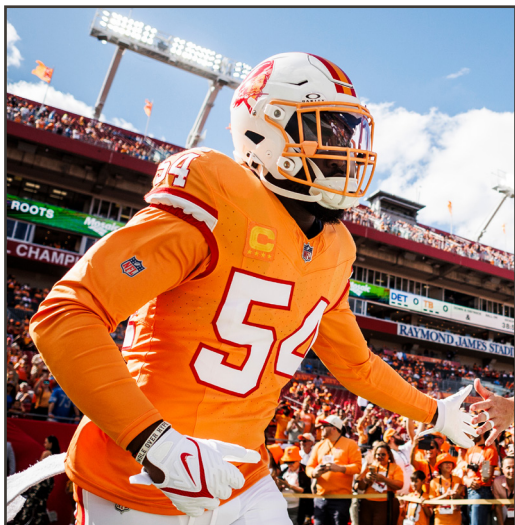

WHAT TO WATCH FOR



LAVONTE DAVID

- Needs **2 tackles** to surpass Rondé Barber (1,428) for the second-most tackles in franchise history, trailing only Derrick Brooks (2,198).
- Needs **2 solo tackles** to become the lone active player with 1,000 career solo tackles.
- Needs **17 tackles** to mark his 10th career season with 100-or-more tackles, joining London Fletcher (14) and Bobby Wagner (11) as the only players to accomplish that feat since 2000.



MIKE EVANS

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie Don Maynard (88) for the 15th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs **1 total touchdown** to tie Corey Dillon, LeSean McCoy and Steve Smith Sr. (89) for the 37th-most total touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **2 total touchdowns** to tie Davante Adams (active), Leroy Kelly and Charley Taylor (90) for the 37th-most total touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs **3 receiving touchdowns** to tie Davante Adams (90 - active) for the 14th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs **102 receiving yards** to surpass DeSean Jackson (11,263) for the 37th-most receiving yards in NFL history.

CHRIS GODWIN

KYLE SHANAHAN



Kyle Shanahan was named the 20th head coach of the San Francisco 49ers on February 6, 2017. Shanahan signed a multi-year contract extension with the 49ers on June 15, 2020.

Shanahan and the 2022 49ers finished with a 13-4 record, including wins in each of their last 10 games and the NFC West title. San Francisco earned a berth in the NFC Championship Game following a pair of home playoff game victories.

KYLE SHANAHAN AT A GLANCE

- In 2022, the 49ers saw four players earn first-team AP All-Pro selections, including Nick Bosa, who was named AP NFL Defensive Player of the Year after leading the NFL with a career high 18.5 sacks.
- Despite using three different starting quarterbacks during the season, the 49ers ranked fourth in the NFL in yards per play (5.9 avg.) and fifth in the NFL in total yards per game (365.6).
- In 2019, he was named Coach of the Year by Sporting News and NFC Coach of the Year by the Committee of 101 after leading the 49ers to a 13-3 regular season record, the NFC West Division Title and an appearance in Super Bowl LIV. San Francisco's nine-win improvement from 2018 to 2019 was the largest win improvement from one season to the next in franchise history. The 49ers became one of three teams since the NFL switched to a 12-team playoff format in 1990 to finish 4-12 or worse one season followed by earning the number one seed in its conference the next season.
- Prior to being named head coach of the 49ers, Shanahan had 15 seasons of coaching experience at the NFL level, including nine as an offensive coordinator for the Atlanta Falcons (2015-16), Cleveland Browns (2014), Washington (2010-13) and Houston Texans (2008-09). In six of his nine seasons as an offensive coordinator (2008-09, 2012-13 and 2015-16), Shanahan directed an offense that ranked in the top 10 in the NFL in yards gained.
- Following the 2016 season, Shanahan was named Associated Press Assistant Coach of the Year, Coordinator of the Year by Sporting News and Assistant Coach of the Year by the Pro Football Writers of America after a record-setting performance by the Falcons offense en route to capturing the NFC South division title and an appearance in Super Bowl LI. Under Shanahan, the 2016 Falcons set franchise records in yards per game (415.8), points scored (540), net passing yards per game (295.3) and average yards per play (6.7). QB Matt Ryan was named Associated Press Most Valuable Player.
- Born December 14, 1979, in Minneapolis, MN, Shanahan played wide receiver at Duke University before transferring to the University of Texas. He and his wife, Mandy, have three children - Stella, Carter and Lexi. Shanahan's father, Mike, was the head coach of the Denver Broncos (1995-2008) and Washington (2010-13), where he accumulated an overall win total of 178 victories (eight postseason), including victories in Super Bowls XXXII and XXXIII.
