#### **WASTING NO TIME**

• Outside linebacker Jason Pierre-Paul has recorded sacks in four of the first five weeks of the 2020 season, taking his career total to 83.5. His 83.5 sacks since entering the league in 2010 are the eighth-most in the NFL.

• Pierre-Paul has earned 25.0 sacks since joining the Buccaneers in 2018, which rank 10th in the NFL during that span.



#### **ROUGHING UP THE RUN GAME**



 In 2018, the Buccaneers ranked 20th in defensive rush average and 24th in rush yards allowed per game. Last season, Tampa Bay ranked first in the NFL in run defense, and it continues to lead the NFL in that category dating back to the start of 2019, holding

11-straight opponents under 100 yards rushing (longest streak in the NFL since 2014) and three-consecutive opponents under 50 yards rushing (team record).

#### THERE'S A LOT TO LIKE ABOUT LAVONTE



 Inside linebacker Lavonte David earned NFC Defensive Player of the Month Honors for September after posting a well-rounded statline, which included 24 tackles (two for loss), two passes defensed, one interception, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery.

 Through Week 5, David leads the team in solo tackles (28) and is tied for first in fumble recoveries (one), second on the team in tackles (39), tied for second in forced fumbles (one) and interceptions (one) and tied for fourth in tackles for loss (three).

#### **BUCCANEERS TEAM**

- Quarterback **Tom Brady** and tight end **Rob Gronkowski** have connected for **78 touchdowns** in the regular season and need **1 more** to match Dan Marino and Mark Clayton (79) for the fourth-most touchdown connections in NFL history.
- The Buccaneers held each of their past three opponents under 50 rushing yards, establishing a franchise record. If Tampa Bay **holds Green Bay under 50 rushing yards**, it will mark the longest streak of such games in the NFL since 2016 (Packers, four games, 9/11/16-10/9/16) and tie for the longest such streak since the 1970 NFL/AFL merger (accomplished six times in that span).
- Dating back to the 2019 season, the Buccaneers have held 11 consecutive opponents under 100 rushing yards, establishing a franchise record. If Tampa Bay **holds the Packers under 100 rushing yards**, it will mark is the first NFL team to hold at least at least 12 consecutive opponents under 100 rushing yards since 2006 (Minnesota Vikings, 13 games, 9/24/06-12/21/06).

#### SHAQUIL BARRETT

- Barrett recorded a franchise-record 19.5 sacks in 2019. With 15.0 or more sacks in 2020, he would be just the 11th player in NFL history to post consecutive seasons with at least 15.0 sacks.
- Barrett has 22.5 sacks as a Buccaneer. He needs 3.5 more to tie Greg Spires (26.0 from 2002-07) for 10th-most sacks in franchise history.



#### CAMERON BRATE

- Brate has 28 career touchdown catches. He needs one more to pass Joey Galloway (28 from 2004-08) for the fourth-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Brate has three career games with multiple touchdown receptions. He needs one more to tie Jimmie Giles for the most ever such games by a Buccaneers tight end and tie for the third-most such games in franchise history.



#### **TOM BRADY**

- Brady has 12 passing touchdowns, tied for the most through five games in franchise history. He needs one passing touchdown at Chicago to tie Brad Johnson (13 in 2003) for the most through six games in franchise history.
- Brady has 553 regular season passing touchdowns and needs three to tie Drew Brees (556 - active) for the most regular season passing touchdowns in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has thrown for 626 touchdowns, the most in NFL history.
- Brady has two career regular season games with at least six passing touchdowns and needs one more such game to tie Peyton Manning (three) for the most such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has seven such games, tied with Ben Roethlisberger for the third-most in NFL history.
- Brady has 93 career regular season games with at least **300 passing yards** and needs one more such game to pass Peyton Manning (93) for the secondmost such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has 109 games with at least 300 passing yards, trailing only Drew Brees (129).





#### LAVONTE DAVID

- David has **22.5 career sacks**. He needs **3.5 more** to tie Greg Spires (26.0 from 2002–07) for 10th-most and **4.0 more** to pass Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989–93) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history. Thomas holds the record for the most sacks by a linebacker in franchise history.
- David has three career defensive touchdowns and needs one more to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979-96; Mike Washington, 1976-84).



#### **MIKE EVANS**

- Evans has five receiving touchdowns this season. With **a receiving touchdown** at Chicago, he will match Chris Godwin (six in 2019) for the most receiving touchdowns through five games in franchise history.
- Dating back to last season, Evans has caught at least one touchdown in each of the past six contests. With a **touchdown** of any kind against Green Bay, he will surpass Earnest Graham (six in 2007) for the most consecutive games with a touchdown in franchise history.

#### **RONALD JONES II**

 Jones has rushed for at least 100 yards in each of the past two contests. With 100-or-more rushing yards against Green Bay, it would mark only the fourth time in franchise history that a player has rushed for 100-or-more yards in three consecutive games (also: Doug Martin, 2015; Cadillac Williams, 2005; James Wilder, 1984-85).



#### **CHRIS GODWIN**

- Godwin has 2,843 career receiving yards. He needs 105 more to pass Mike Williams (2,947 from 2010-13) for 10th-most receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has 18 career touchdown receptions. He needs two more to tie Vincent Jackson (20 from 2012-16) for 10th-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.
- Godwin had 1,333 receiving yards in 2019. If he surpasses 1,300 yards receiving in 2020, he would be the first player in team history to record 1,300-or-more yards in consecutive seasons.

#### **ROB GRONKOWSKI**

- Gronkowski has 8,001 regular season receiving yards and needs 52 more to pass Jimmy Graham (8,052 active) for the sixth-most receiving yards by a tight end in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has 9,164 receiving yards and needs 52 more to pass Greg Olson (9,215 active) for the fifth-most receiving yards by a tight end in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).
- Gronkowski has **79 regular season receiving touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to pass Harold Carmichael (79) and Charley Taylor (79) for 27th-most, **two more** to tie Art Powell and Steve Smith (81) for 25th-most and **three more** to tie Anquan Boldin and Reggie Wayne (82) for the 23rd-most touchdown receptions in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has **91 receiving touchdowns** and needs **one more** to pass Reggie Wayne (91) for the 14th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).



#### **LESEAN MCCOY**

- McCoy has **11,069 career rushing yards**. He needs **168 more** to pass O.J. Simpson (11,236) for 21st-most and **172 more** to pass Corey Dillon (11,241) for the 20th-most regular season rushing yards in NFL history.
- McCoy has 73 career rushing touchdowns. He needs one more to tie Earl Campbell and Leroy Kelly (74) for 26th-most, two more to tie Clinton Portis (75) for 25th-most and three more to tie Pete Johnson (76) for the 24th-most regular season rushing touchdowns in NFL history.
- McCoy has 14,921 career yards from scrimmage. He needs 189 more to pass Jerome Bettis (15,111) for 25th-most, 196 more to pass Steve Smith (15,118) for 24th-most, 199 more to pass Steven Jackson (15,121) for 23rd-most, 202 more to pass Tim Brown (15,124) for 22nd-most and 219 more to pass Tony Gonzalez (15,141) for the 21st-most regular season yards from scrimmage in NFL history.





#### **JASON PIERRE-PAUL**

Pierre-Paul has 25.0 sacks as a Buccaneer. He needs 1.0 more to tie Greg Spires (26.0 from 2002-07) for 10th-most and 1.5 more to tie Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for ninth-most in franchise history.

#### FORMER BUCCANEERS

- Packers Senior Analyst Butch Barry was an assistant offensive line coach for the Buccaneers from 2015-18.
- Packers Defensive Backs Coach Jerry Gray played for Tampa in 1993.
- Packers Offensive Coordinator Nathaniel Hackett was an offensive quality control coach for the Buccaneers from 2006-07.

#### **FORMER PACKERS**

 Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles was a college scouting assistant for the Packers from 1995-96.

#### PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

Buccaneers RB **Leonard Fournette** developed into one of the NFL's top running back threats during his three-season stint in Jacksonville. During Fournette's first two seasons in Duval, the Jaguars offense was run by Offensive Coordinator **Nathaniel Hackett** (2015-18), who now holds the same role in Green Bay. While running in Hackett's offense, Fournette produced a 1,000-yard season during his rookie campaign with nine rushing touchdowns while appearing in just 13 games. The LSU product also tallied 302 receiving yards and caught a touchdown.

• Buccaneers Director of Athlete Performance Greg Skaggs is a Wisconsin native.

#### **FLORIDA TIES**

- Packers LB Jonathan Garvin played collegiately at Miami.

- Buccaneers Assistant Defensive Line Coach **Lori Locust** began her career in the NFL as a defensive coaching intern with the Baltimore Ravens in 2018. While in Baltimore, she worked with Packers LB **Za'Darius Smith**, who played in Baltimore from 2015-18.
- Buccaneers DT **Rakeem Nunez-Roches** (2015-17) spent three seasons with the Kansas City Chiefs. For two of those seasons, he played under Packers Outside Linebackers Coach **Mike Smith**, who was the assistant defensive line coach in Kansas City from 2016-17.
- Buccaneers RB **LeSean McCoy** spent four seasons with the Buffalo Bills, two of which came alongside Packers Wide Receivers Coach **Jason Vrable**, who was an offensive quality control coach, assistant quarterbacks coach and interim running backs coach for the organization from 2013-16. McCoy was a Pro Bowler when working directly with Vrable in 2016, rushing for 1,267 yards and 13 touchdowns.





#### **COACHING CONNECTIONS**

- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** was the head coach of the New York Jets from 2015-18. Packers Wide Receivers Coach **Jason Vrable** was an offensive assistant on Bowles' staff from 2017-18. Multiple coaches on Tampa Bay's staff also worked under Bowles during this time, including inside linebackers coach **Mike Caldwell** (2015-18) and defensive line coach **Kacy Rodgers** (2015-18).
- Buccaneers Assistant Head Coach/Run Game Coordinator **Harold Goodwin** held the same role and served as the offensive line coach at Central Michigan from 2000-03, spending time with Packers Senior Analyst **Butch Barry**, who was a graduate assistant with the program from 2002-03.
- Buccaneers Offensive Line Coach **Joe Gilbert** (1994–99) held the same position and served as the offensive coordinator at Maine when Packers Running Backs Coach **Ben Sirmans** was the running backs coach and recruiting coordinator at the university from 1996–99. The two were a part of a pair of winning seasons, including a 7-4 record in 1996 where the Black Bears won four of their final five contests to finish with their best record since 1989.
- Buccaneers Special Teams Coordinator **Keith Armstrong** (2008-18) held the same position with the Atlanta Falcons when Packers Head Coach **Matt LaFleur** (2015-16) was the quarterbacks coach in Atlanta.

# HC BRUCE ARIANS

### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the secondbest mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

## ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49–30–1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

## TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

## **INDIANAPOLIS COLTS**

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest singleseason turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.



Entering his 12th season in the National Football League, Matt LaFleur (la-flew-er) enters his second season in Green Bay after being named the Packers' 15th head coach on Jan. 8, 2019.

In his first season with the Packers in 2019, he led the team to a 13-3 record, a 6-0 mark in NFC North games, a division title and the No. 2 seed in the NFC.

In LaFleur's first year leading the team in 2019, Green Bay finished the regular season with a 13-3 record on its way to an NFC North crown and the No. 2 seed in the

NFC as he became just the fifth coach in league history to win 13-plus games in his first season as a head coach. He guided the Packers to their biggest one-year win improvement in club history (plus-seven wins) and became the first head coach to lead Green Bay to the playoffs in his first season. LaFleur joined Mike McCarthy as the only head coaches in club annals to lead the team to the NFC Championship Game in their first playoff appearance and he became the first NFL coach to do so since Jim Harbaugh led the 49ers to the NFC title game in 2011.

#### MATT LAFLEUR AT A GLANCE

- Became only the fifth coach in NFL history to win 13-plus regularseason games in his first season as a head coach (Jim Caldwell, George Seifert, Jim Harbaugh, Steve Mariucci).
- Is entering his 12th season in the NFL in 2020, having also served as an offensive coordinator for two seasons (Los Angeles Rams, 2017; Tennessee Titans, 2018), a quarterbacks coach for six seasons (Washington Redskins, 2010-13; Atlanta Falcons, 2015-16) and an offensive assistant for two seasons (Houston Texans, 2008-09).

- Helped the Rams lead the league in scoring with an average of 29.9 points per game in 2017, more than doubling their average from 2016 (14.0 ppg) as they became the first team in the Super Bowl era to go from last to first in the NFL in scoring in one season.
- Tutored Falcons QB Matt Ryan, who led the league with a 117.1 passer rating in 2016, the sixth highest in a season in NFL history, on his way to being named NFL Most Valuable Player and Offensive Player of the Year by The Associated Press.
- Coached rookie QB Robert Griffin III with the Redskins in 2012, who became the first QB in team history to win AP Offensive Rookie of the Year and the first Redskins rookie QB to be selected to the Pro Bowl.
- Began his coaching career in 2003 at his alma mater, Saginaw Valley State. Has six seasons of coaching experience at the collegiate level, having also worked at Central Michigan (2004-05), Northern Michigan (2006), Ashland University (2007) and Notre Dame (2014).
- Played QB at Saginaw Valley State (2000–02), where he guided the Cardinals to three straight NCAA Division II playoff appearances and earned second-team All-Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference honors in all three seasons.
