



ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

19.2 Points allowed per game by the Cardinals defense this season. That is the lowest total among teams in the NFC and ranks fourth in the NFL in 2025.

41 Tackles for **LB MACK WILSON SR.** in 2025, a team-high. Wilson's 41 tackles are tied for 16th among all NFL defenders in 2025 and his 5 passes defended are tied for 10th in the NFL. He is the only player in the NFL this season with 40+ tackles and 5+ passes defended.

15 Passing TDs allowed by the Cardinals defense dating back to Week 7 of 2024 (a span of 16 games). That is the lowest total in the NFL during that stretch, with no other team allowing fewer than 19. AZ has allowed the fewest passing TDs and 2nd-fewest total TDs (30) in the NFL during that span.

10 Receiving TDs for both **WR MARVIN HARRISON JR.** and Colts Hall of Fame **WR MARVIN HARRISON SR.** in their first 22 career games. On Sunday, Marvin Jr. will play his first ever game at Lucas Oil Stadium, exactly 6,133 days (16 years, 9 months, 15 days) after his father played his final game at the venue.

MILESTONE WATCH

WITH A WIN...

- Arizona would earn its second straight road win at Indianapolis (16-13 OT win in Week 2 of 2017).
- The Cardinals would improve to 3-1 in their last four games vs. the Colts and even the all-time series at 9 wins apiece.
- The Cardinals would improve to 6-2 in their last eight road games vs. teams from the AFC South.
- The Cardinals would improve to 2-1 on the road in 2025.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

LB JOSH SWEAT

- With 1.0 sack, Sweat would have at least 1.0 sack in five consecutive games for just the second time in his career: 5 straight (Games 11-15) in 2022. His current 4-game streak is tied (Lions DL Aidan Hutchinson) for the longest active streak in the NFL.
- With 1.0 sack, Sweat would have 6.0 sacks in 2025. In franchise history only Chandler Jones (7.0 in 2017) and Curtis Greer (6.5 in 1983) would have more sacks through the first six games of a season.
- With 2.0 sacks, Sweat would have 2.0+ sacks in back-to-back games for the first time in his career. He would also have 7.0 sacks in 2025, tying Chandler Jones (7.0 in 2017) for the most in franchise history through the first six games of a season.

TE TREY McBRIDE

- With 5+ receptions, McBride would have at least five catches in eight consecutive games, marking the longest streak of his career. It would also tie for the fifth-longest streak in NFL history by a tight end.

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With a rushing TD, Murray would tie RBs David Johnson and John David Crow (33) for fifth place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs.
- With 3 TD passes, Murray would have 16 career outings with 3+ TD passes. That would pass Neil Lomax (15) for the most such outings in franchise history.

WR MARVIN HARRISON JR.

- With a TD reception, Harrison would have one more TD catch (11) than his Hall of Fame father - Marvin Harrison Sr. - in his first 23 career games (10).
- With a TD reception, Harrison would become one of just five players in franchise history with 11+ TD receptions in their first 23 career games: Sonny Randle (19), Larry Fitzgerald (12), Mal Kutner (12) and Dave Williams (11).
- With four receptions, Harrison Jr. (86) would pass John Brown (85) for the fifth-most receptions by a Cardinals player in their first 23 career games.

DL CALAIS CAMPBELL

- With 1.0 sack, Campbell (114.5) would tie former Cardinals DE J.J. Watt (114.5) for 24th place on the NFL's all-time sacks list.
- Campbell will be playing in his 267th career game on Sunday and will pass Hall of Famer Julius Peppers for the third-most games played by a D-Lineman in NFL history behind only HOFers Jim Marshall (282) and Bruce Smith (279).

S DADRION TAYLOR-DEMERSON

- With an INT, Taylor-Demerson would have an INT in back-to-back games for the first time since Games 9-10 in his senior year at Texas Tech in 2023. He would have also have three INTs in his last four games.

RB MICHAEL CARTER

- With a rushing TD, Carter would have a rushing TD in back-to-back games for the second time in his career and for the first time since Weeks 4 and 5 of 2021.

RB ZONOVAN (BAM) KNIGHT

- With a rushing TD, Knight would have a rushing TD in back-to-back games for the first time since he had a streak of six straight games with a rushing TD in his sophomore year at North Carolina State in 2020.

BIRDS' EYE VIEW

WILL LOCKING IT DOWN

- According to Pro Football Focus, rookie **CB WILL JOHNSON** has earned an 84.5 overall defensive grade in 2025, which ranks first among all defensive backs in the NFL this season (min. 20% snaps played). His 84.2 coverage grade also ranks third across the league and first among qualified rookies.
- Despite missing two games due to injury, Johnson has totaled 5 passes defended in three games this season, the most among rookies and tied for the 10th most in the NFL. Passes thrown his way are completed at just a 53.3% rate which ranks in the top-10 and his 63.4 passer rating allowed lands in the top-12.



WR MARVIN HARRISON JR. will play his first-ever game vs. the Colts on Sunday, the team for which his father - MARVIN HARRISON SR. - had a Hall of Fame career. They are the only father-son WR duo in NFL history to be selected in the first round in the Common Draft Era (since 1967) and have had remarkably similar production to begin their NFL careers. Marvin Sr. recorded 90 receptions for 1,114 yards and 10 TDs in his first 22 career games while Harrison Jr. has 82 receptions for 1,191 yards and 10 TDs in the same time frame.

SWEAT TURNING UP THE PRESSURE

Through five games, **LB JOSH SWEAT** has recorded 12 tackles, 5.0 sacks, 6 tackles for loss and 7 QB hits. He leads the team in all three of those categories. His 5.0 sacks are the most he has tallied through the first five games of a season, his 6 tackles for loss are tied for the most and his 7 quarterback hits rank third.



Across the NFL, Sweat is tied for third in sacks and forced fumbles (two), tied for seventh in tackles for loss, and tied for 19th in quarterback hits. Last week vs. Tennessee, he recorded 2.0 sacks of QB Cam Ward which tied a single-game career-high. It was his eighth career game with 2.0+ sacks and first since Super Bowl LIX where he had 2.5 sacks of Chiefs QB Patrick Mahomes as a member of the Eagles.

CARDS IN THE COMMUNITY
