



ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

- 8-7** Cardinals all-time record playing on Halloween, including a 6-4 mark at home. Thursday's game marks the team's second-ever primetime appearance on Halloween and first since they shut out the NY Giants 28-0 on Monday Night Football in 1977.
- 95** Distance (in yards) of the kickoff return TD for RB Kenyan Drake in his only game he has played at State Farm Stadium to date. As a senior at Alabama, Drake helped the Crimson Tide to a 45-40 victory over Clemson in the College Football Playoff championship game on 1/11/16.
- 16** Days between the upcoming two matchups of Arizona and San Francisco this season. After squaring off on Thursday Night Football at State Farm Stadium, the two teams will face each other again in Week 11 at Levi's Stadium.
- 76** Points for K Zane Gonzalez in 2019 (21 FG, 13 PAT). The former ASU standout leads the NFL in totals points this season and is tied for the NFL lead in FGs made (21).

WITH A WIN...

- The Cardinals would have more wins in the month of October (4) than they had in all of 2018 (3).
- Arizona would run its winning streak against the 49ers to nine straight. That would tie for the longest winning streak in franchise history against a single opponent (9 vs. Philadelphia between 1974-78).
- Arizona would have the NFL's longest active winning streak against a division opponent.
- The Cardinals would earn their sixth consecutive home win against San Francisco, who hasn't won in Arizona since 2013.
- **Kyler Murray** would tie the franchise record for wins by a rookie QB.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

WR LARRY FITZGERALD

- With a reception, Fitzgerald would have at least one catch in 236 consecutive games, extending the second-longest streak in NFL history (HOF WR Jerry Rice - 274).
- With a TD reception, Fitzgerald would have 19 career TD catches against the 49ers. In NFL history, only Jerry Rice (25 vs. Falcons and 20 vs. Rams) would have more TD receptions against a single opponent.
- With 100 receiving yards, Fitz would have 50 career 100-yard games during the regular season. It would also give him 12 career 100-yard outings against the 49ers, the most against a single opponent in NFL history.

LB TERRELL SUGGS

- With a sack, Suggs would have 138.5 career sacks, tying DeMarcus Ware for eighth place on the NFL's all-time sacks list. SF QB Jimmy Garoppolo would become the 76th different QB Suggs has sacked in his career. In NFL history, only Reggie White (77) and Julius Peppers (77) would have sacked more QBs.
- With two sacks, Suggs would tie Jason Taylor (139.5) for seventh place on the NFL's all-time sacks list.

LB CHANDLER JONES

- With a sack, Jones would have 50.5 sacks in 57 games with the Cardinals. He would tie Curtis Greer for fourth place on the franchise all-time sacks list.
- With 1.5 sacks, Jones would become the first player in Cardinals history with four seasons of at least 10 sacks. He would also tie the franchise record for sacks in the first nine games of a season (Jones in 2017; Simeon Rice in 1999; Freddie Joe Nunn in 1988).

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 24 completions, Murray (210) would establish a new NFL record for completions in a player's first nine career games. Patrick Mahomes (209 in 2017-18) holds the current record.
- With 300 passing yards, Murray would become the fourth player - and just the second rookie - in NFL history with at least four 300-yard passing performances in their first nine career games, joining Patrick Mahomes (7), Kurt Warner (5), and Andrew Luck (4 as a rookie).
- With 35 rushing yards, Murray would establish a new franchise rookie record for rushing yards by a QB. The current record is 313 by Bud Schwenk in 1942.

RB DAVID JOHNSON

- With a receiving TD, Johnson would become just the fifth player in NFL history with at least 30 rushing TDs and 15 receiving TDs in his first five seasons. He would join Marcus Allen, Thurman Thomas, Chuck Foreman and Abner Haynes as the only players to accomplish the feat.

LB JORDAN HICKS

- With 10 tackles, Hicks would become the first AZ defender with 90+ tackles through the first nine games of a season since LB Ronald McKinnon (95) in

REMINDER TO FANS: ARRIVE EARLY FOR TNF

With the combination of normal work day traffic and fans heading to the game, *the Cardinals highly encourage fans to give themselves plenty of extra time and arrive early for Thursday Night Football.* Sportsman Park carparks and other game day lots open at **1:15 PM** on Thursday and main entrance gates into State Farm Stadium open at **3:45 PM**. There will be a number of family-friendly Halloween-themed activities for fans in and around the stadium prior to and during the game.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR: A TURNOVER TALE

The Cardinals offense has displayed a historic level of ball security so far this season, *having committed the fewest turnovers in the NFL (4) and the fewest through the first eight games of a season in team history.* Arizona has an active streak of four consecutive games without a turnover.

One key to San Francisco's undefeated record this season has been the defense's ability to take the ball from opposing offenses and hand it back to their own. Despite having played just seven games this season, the 49ers are tied for third in the NFL with 16 takeaways.

OVER 19 QUARTERS WITHOUT A TURNOVER

• Dating back to the first quarter of the Week 4 contest vs. Seattle, *the Cardinals offense has run 294 consecutive plays without a turnover.* In his last five games, Murray has 1,351 total yards (1,158 passing; 193 rushing), five TDs and one turnover in 192 combined pass/rush attempts. He has an active streak of 148 pass attempts without an INT.

AZ LOOKS TO KEEP WINNING STREAK ALIVE

The Cards enter Thursday's game looking for their ninth consecutive win over the 49ers, which would tie the longest winning streak in team history vs. any opponent.

AZ's 8 straight wins vs. SF are tied for the longest active winning streak in the NFL against a division opponent: KC vs. Den; NE vs. NYJ; Pit vs. Cin.

PRIME TIME QUICK HITS

Below are a few notes on Cardinals players and their success while playing in front of a primetime audience in the regular season:

LB Chandler Jones (23 games) - 71 tackles, 15.0 sacks, 19 tackles for loss, 30 QB hits, an INT, two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery.

LB Terrell Suggs (43 games) - 154 tackles, 22.5 sacks, 32 tackles for loss, 45 QB hits, an INT, five forced fumbles and a fumble recovery.

WR Larry Fitzgerald (28 games) - 163 receptions for 1,792 yards and 11 TDs.

RB David Johnson (10 games) - 1,106 total scrimmage yards and 10 TDs, averaging 110.6 yards and one TD per game.

LB Jordan Hicks (13 games) - 74 tackles, 1.5 sacks, 2 INTs (1 returned 67 yards for TD), four passes defended and a fumble recovery.
