



# ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

**92** Starts for C **Rodney Hudson** - which is every game played - during his six seasons (2015-20) with the Raiders. During that time, he was named to the Pro Bowl three times (2016-17, '19) and was named 2<sup>nd</sup>-team All-Pro in 2019.

**71.5** Sacks for DE **Chandler Jones** in six seasons (2016-21) with the Cardinals. His 71.5 sacks are a franchise career record and his 19.0 sacks in 2019 are a single-season record. Jones was a three-time Pro Bowl selection (2017, '19, '21) and two-time 1<sup>st</sup>-team All-Pro (2017 and '19) with Arizona.

**54** Turnovers for the Cardinals in 50 games under head coach **Kliff Kingsbury**. Dating back to 2019, only three teams have fewer: Packers (39), Saints (44) and Seahawks (52). Arizona has lost just 18 fumbles during that stretch. Only New Orleans (17) lost fewer.

**2020** Year the Cardinals and Raiders were supposed to meet in the inaugural game at Allegiant Stadium (Week 3 of the preseason). All NFL preseason games were canceled due to COVID.

## WITH A WIN...

- Arizona would earn its first-ever win in its first-ever appearance at Allegiant Stadium and improve to 4-2 all-time on the road against the Raiders.
- The Cardinals would improve to 3-1 in their last four games vs. the Raiders.
- The Cardinals would improve to 9-1 on the road in the regular season dating back to 2021. Arizona would also improve to 13-5 on the road over the last three seasons (2020-22).

## MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

### QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 3+ passing TDs, Murray would have 12 career outings with 3+ TD passes in 48 games played. That would leave him just three such performances shy of the franchise career record (Neil Lomax - 15 times in 108 games played).
- With a rushing TD, Murray would have 21 rushing TDs in 48 career starts. Dating back to 1970, only three NFL QBs - Josh Allen (28), Cam Newton (28) and Daunte Culpepper (25) would have more rushing TDs in their first 50 career starts.
- With a passer rating of 120.0+, Murray would have 10 such performances in his career. That would tie Neil Lomax (10 times in 108 games) for the most games with a passer rating of 120.0+ in franchise history.

### RB JAMES CONNER

- With a TD (of any kind), Conner would have 20 TDs in 17 regular season games with the Cardinals. In NFL history, only Hall of Famers RB Gale Sayers (24 w/ Bears), WR Randy Moss (24 w/ Patriots), RB Jim Brown (24 w/ Browns) and RB Eric Dickerson (21 w/ Rams) would have more TDs in their first 17 games with a team.
- With two rushing TDs, Conner would have 18 rushing TDs in 17 games with the Cardinals. Only Hall of Fame RBs Jim Brown (22 w/ Browns) and Eric Dickerson (19 w/ Rams) would have more rushing TDs in their first 17 games with a team.

### K MATT PRATER

- With 8 points, Prater would join SF's Robbie Gould and GB's Mason Crosby as the only active players in the NFL with 1,600+ career points.

### DL J.J. WATT

- With a sack, Raiders QB Derek Carr would become the 42<sup>nd</sup> different QB Watt has sacked in his career.

### LB MARKUS GOLDEN

- With a sack, Golden would have 10.0 sacks in his last 13 games played during the regular season. It would also give him 9.0 sacks in his last nine road games.
- With 2.0 sacks, Golden would have four games with 2.0+ sacks dating back to last season. Only Pittsburgh All-Pro LB T.J. Watt (6) would have more such performances in that span.

### TE ZACH ERTZ

- With a TD reception, Ertz would have a TD catch in each of the first two games of a season for the first time in his career.

### WR A.J. GREEN

- With a TD reception, Green would have at least one TD catch vs. 27 of 32 NFL teams. It would leave Arizona, Cincinnati, Carolina, Houston and San Francisco as the only teams he does not have a TD reception against in his career. He will face Carolina in Week 4 and San Francisco in Weeks 11 and 18.

### WR MARQUISE BROWN

- With a TD reception, Brown would have a TD reception in each of the first two games of a season for the second consecutive year.

### S BUDDA BAKER

- With an INT, Baker would have three INTs in his last six road games.

## CARDS MAKING ALLEGiant DEBUT

On Sunday the Cardinals will play their first-ever game at Allegiant Stadium when they take on the Raiders in Arizona's inaugural road game of the 2022 regular season.

The Cardinals have been successful on the road under head coach **Kliff Kingsbury**, highlighted by a 2021 campaign in which the team finished 8-1 in away games. **That established a franchise record for road wins and Arizona became just the 10<sup>th</sup> team in NFL history to win eight road games in a season.**

### A REMARKABLE ROAD RUN IN 2021

- AZ ranked #1 in the NFL in points scored (267), total TDs (31), rushing TDs (12), passer rating (111.2), turnover margin (+18), forced fumbles (14) and fumble recoveries (11) in away games in 2021.
- AZ (7 in 2021) joined San Francisco (7; 1984) and Dallas (7; 1968) as the only teams in NFL history to win seven consecutive road games by 10+ points.

Arizona has a 15-10 record on the road under Kingsbury. Dating back to 2020, **the Cardinals are 12-5 (.706) on the road. Only Kansas City (.824), New Orleans (.722) and Tampa Bay (.722) hold higher road winning percentages during that span.**

#### QB Kyler Murray

**2021** - 6-1 record; 19 TDs (15 pass, 4 rush) vs. 3 INTs and 109.2 passer rating.  
**Career** - 13-10 record; 42 TDs (33 pass, 9 rush) vs. 9 INTs and 96.9 passer rating.

**LB Markus Golden: 2021** - 8.0 sacks & 9 TFL in 8 games.

**RB James Conner: 2021** - 696 scrimmage yards & 9 TDs (7 rush, 2 rec) in 8 games.

**S Budda Baker: 2021** - 2 INTs (84 yards), 1.0 sack, 5 PD, 2 TFL, 1 FR in last 5 games.

## CARDS VS. RAIDERS QUICK NOTES

- Sunday's game will be just the 11<sup>th</sup> regular season matchup between the Cardinals and Raiders in a series that dates back to 1973.
- Cardinals have won two of the last three in the series.
- Arizona is 3-2 on the road all time in the series.
- 5 of the last 8 matchups were decided by 3 points or fewer. 2 of the last 3 meetings were decided by FG attempts as time expired: 1 made (2018) & 1 missed (2010).
- The teams last met in 2018. Of the 22 players who started that game for Arizona, only LB **Markus Golden** remains a starter for the Cardinals.

## PRATER ON THE CUSP OF 1,600

K **Matt Prater** enters Sunday's game needing eight points to become just the 24<sup>th</sup> player in NFL history - and one of just three active players - with at least 1,600 career points.

Should he reach the milestone on Sunday, Prater would join San Francisco's Robbie Gould and Green Bay's Mason Crosby as the only active players to have 1,600+ points in their career.
