**2017:** Played all 16 games (15 starts) and registered 79 tackles, a career-high five INTs (tied for fifth most in the NFL) and nine passes defended ... had a season-high seven tackles vs. Mia (9/17), vs Phi (10/1), @ Oak (10/15) and vs. Oak (12/31); added an INT and two passes defended in the second matchup against the Raiders ... sealed a win by intercepting Eli Manning near midfield late in the fourth quarter, adding five tackles @ NYG (10/8) ... posted six tackles, one for loss, a career-high two INTs (both in the game's final two minutes) and three passes defended @ Jax (11/12) ... had his third INT in two games and added four tackles vs. Buf (11/19).


