ROTE CARDS

- Combined point differential in the last three games between Arizona and New England (2, 2 and 3 points).

 All three of those contests were decided by a potential game-winning FG attempt (2 were missed, 1 was made).
- Wins for the Cardinals in their last seven appearances on Monday Night Football. Arizona has as many wins in their last seven MNF appearances (4) as it had in its previous 20 (4).
- Different players who have started at least one game on the offensive line for the Cardinals this season. Only the Rams (14) have had more. Arizona currently has six O-Lineman on injured reserve, tied with the Rams for the most in the NFL.
- Sacks for DL **Zach Allen** in 2022, a new career high. Through 12 games, Allen has already established career highs for sacks (4.5), QB hits (19), passes defensed (7) and tackles for loss (9). In the last four games Allen has 2.5 sacks and 9 QB hits, including a career-high 4 QB hits in Week 12 vs. the Chargers.

WITH A WIN...

- Arizona would improve to 5-3 in its last eight appearances on Monday Night Football. The Cardinals would have more wins in their last eight MNF appearances (5) than they had in their previous 20 (4).
- The Cardinals would tie their all-time series against the Patriots at eight wins apiece. New England currently holds an 8-7 lead.
- Arizona would earn its first home win vs. New England since 1991.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH... WR MARQUISE BROWN

With a TD reception, Brown would have seven TD receptions in six career appearances on Monday Night Football. Brown currently has as least one TD catch in four of five games played on MNF, including two outings with 2 TDs.

WR DEANDRE HOPKINS

- With 1 reception, Hopkins would have at least one catch in 143 consecutive games. That would extend the longest active streak in the NFL.
- With 10 receptions, Hopkins would have 10+ receptions in four of seven games played this season. He would join Larry Fitzgerald (4 in 2017) as the only players in franchise history with at least four games of 10+ receptions in a season.
- With 100+ receiving yards, Hopkins would have 100+ yards in a game for the 40th time in his career and for the 10th time as a member of the Cardinals.

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 161 passing yards, Murray would join Josh Allen and Cam Newton as the only QBs in NFL history with 14,000+ passing yards and 2,000+ rushing yards in their 1st four seasons.
- With 3+ TD passes, Murray would have 3+ passing TDs in a game for the 13th time in his career. Only Neil Lomax (15 times in 108 games) and Charley Johnson (14 times in 87 games) would have more such performances. Murray would also join Kurt Warner (3 vs. San Francisco on 11/10/08) as the only players in franchise history to throw 3+ TD passes on Monday Night Football.
- With 85 rushing yards, Murray would reach 500 rushing yards for the third time. He would join Lamar Jackson (4), Cam Newton (4), Josh Allen (3), Russell Wilson (3) and Randall Cunningham (3) as the only QBs in NFL history with 500+ rushing yards at least three times in his first four seasons.

DE J.J. WATT

- With 1.0 sack, Watt would have 7.5 sacks in 2022. It would give him more sacks in his last six games (5.0) than he had in his first 13 games (4.5) with Arizona.
- With 1.0 sack, Watt would have his first career sack against the Patriots. That would leave the Bears, Texans and 49ers as the only teams he does not have a sack against during the regular season.
- A sack of Patriots QB Mac Jones would make him the 47th different QB Watt has sacked in his career.

S BUDDA BAKER

■ With 10+ tackles, Baker would reach 100 tackles in a season for the fourth time in his career. It would also mark his 23rd career game with 10+ tackles.

RB JAMES CONNER

- With a TD (of any kind), Conner would have 24 TDs in 25 games with Arizona. That would be a franchise record for TDs in a player's first 24 games with the team.
- With two rushing TDs, Conner would have multiple rushing TDs for the 7th time as a member of the Cardinals. In franchise history only David Johnson (8) would have more games with multiple rushing TDs.

<u>WR A.J. GREEN</u>

With 1 TD catch, Green would have 70 TD receptions in his career. He would join Davante Adams (85), Mike Evans (78) and teammate DeAndre Hopkins (71) as the only active players with 70+ career TD receptions.

HOLLYWOOD STARS UNDER BRIGHT LIGHTS OF MNF

In five career appearances on Monday Night Football, WR Marquise Brown has 24 receptions for 299 yards and 6 TDs. In his last appearance (10/11/21 vs. Ind with Baltimore) he had 9 receptions for 125 yards and two TDs, including a game-winning 5-yard TD catch in OT.

In fact, Brown has two career "go-ahead" TD receptions in the $4^{\rm th}$ quarter/OT - and both have come while playing on MNF.

Among active players, only Stefon Diggs (12) and Travis Kelce (12) have more career TD receptions on MNF.

INJURIES HAMPERING THE O-LINE

- Four of the Cardinals five starting O-Linemen to the begin the season are on IR.
- Arizona has seen 8 different starting combinations on the O-Line, including 5 in the last 6 games.

The Cardinals have had 31 different players miss a combined 165 games due to injury so far this season.

Of the 13 players currently on IR for the Cardinals, 10 are offensive players. **OL Kelvin** Beachum is the only offensive player to start every game for the Cards this season.

ERTZ NAMED CARDS WALTER PAYTON MAN OF THE YEAR

On Tuesday (12/6), the Cardinals announced that TE Zach Ertz was named the 2022 "Arizona Cardinals/Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year."

The award is in recognition of outstanding community service activities off the field as well as excellence on the field. As a nominee, Ertz will receive a donation of up to \$40,000 in his name to a charity of his choice.

"As outstanding as he's been on the field throughout his career, Zach's commitment to giving back is even more exceptional and makes him such a fitting selection for this

award," said Cardinals owner **Michael Bidwill**. "Whether in Philadelphia or now in Arizona, Zach and Julie Ertz are making a meaningful difference in so many areas."

Ertz is one of 32 NFL "Man of the Year" recipients to qualify for the league's national 2022 "Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year" award. The winner - who will receive a \$250,00 donation to a charity of his choice - will be announced during NFL Honors, which takes place the Thursday before Super Bowl LVII.
