



ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

76 Tackles and eight passes defended for S **Jalen Thompson** in 2023. He joins Bills CB Taron Johnson and Chiefs CB L'Jarius Sneed as the only NFL players to have 75+ tackles and 7+ passes defended in each of the last three seasons.

3 Games with 200+ rushing yards for the Cardinals this season, including two of their last three contests (221 at Philadelphia, 234 vs. San Francisco). The last time the team had more games of 200+ rushing yards in a season was 1979 (four games).

95+ Passer rating for QB **Kyler Murray** in five of his last six starts against Seattle. In Murray's last meeting with the Seahawks (11/6/22), he completed 25-of-35 pass attempts for 175 yards and two TDs and a 101.5 passer rating in addition to 60 rushing yards on eight carries.

250 Career regular season games for K **Matt Prater** following Sunday's game. Prater will join Bears TE Mercedes Lewis (267) and Giants K Mason Crosby (260) as the only active players to have played in at least 250 career regular season games.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

TE TREY McBRIDE

- With nine receiving yards, McBride would join Hall of Famer Jackie Smith (2x) as the only TEs in franchise history with 800+ receiving yards in a season. Smith had 1,205 yards in 1967 and 810 in 1966.
- With 100+ receiving yards, McBride (3) would join Smith (22) as the only TEs in franchise history with at least three 100-yard receiving performances in their careers.
- With 10+ receptions, McBride would have three games of double-digit catches in 2023. Only one TE in NFL history (Zach Ertz - 5 in 2018) would have more such outings in a single season.

RB JAMES CONNER

- With two TDs (rushing or receiving), Conner would have 10 TDs in 2023. Combined with his 18 TDs in 2021, Conner would join Larry Fitzgerald (5), David Johnson (3), Stump Mitchell (2), Roy Green (2) and Sonny Randle (2) as the only players in franchise history with multiple seasons of 10+ TDs.
- With 84 rushing yards, Conner would establish a new single-season career high in rushing yards (973 in 2018).
- With 100+ rushing yards, Conner would join David Johnson (4 in 2016) and Chris Johnson (4 in 2015) as the only Cardinals players with at least four 100-yard outings in a season since the franchise came to Arizona in 1988.
- With 110 rushing yards, Conner would reach 1,000 rushing yards in a season for the first time in his career. He would become just the 11th different player in franchise history to rush for 1,000+ yards in a season and the first to do so since David Johnson (1,239) in 2016.

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With a rushing and passing TD, Murray would have both a passing and rushing TD for the 19th time in his career. Just two players in NFL history - Cam Newton (31) and Josh Allen (25) - would have more such games in their first five seasons.
- With a rushing TD, Murray would have 27 rushing TDs as a member of the Cardinals. That would tie Johnny Roland (1966-72) and Elmer Angsman (1946-52) for seventh place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs.

K MATT PRATER

- With one FG, Prater would become just the 12th player in NFL history to reach 400 career FGs.
- With two points, Prater would have 100 points in 2023. It would mark his 12th career season of 100+ points, which would match the seventh most in NFL history and rank second among active players (Mason Crosby - 15).
- With a FG of 50+ yards, Prater would have 10 FGs of 50+ yards in 2023. Only one player in NFL history - Daniel Carlson (11 in 2022) - would have more FGs of 50+ in a single season.

S JALEN THOMPSON

- With an INT, Thompson would extend his single-season career high to five INTs in 2023 and become the first Cardinal to have at least five INTs in a season since 2017 (Antoine Bethea - five).

RB MICHAEL CARTER

- With 18 rushing yards, Carter would become the sixth member of the Cardinals to have 150+ rushing yards this season. Six players with 150+ rushing yards would lead the NFL in 2023 and tie the franchise record for a single season (6 in 1951 and 1954).

LB BJ OJULARI

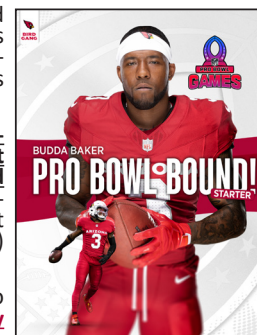
- With 1.5 or more sacks, Ojulari would join Simeon Rice (3 in 1996) and Andre Wadsworth (2 in 1998) as the only players in franchise history with at least two games of multiple sacks in their rookie season.

BAKER NAMED TO SIXTH PRO BOWL

On Wednesday, Cardinals S **Budda Baker** was named as a starter for the 2024 Pro Bowl. It marks Baker's sixth Pro Bowl selection and fifth consecutive at safety after being chosen as a special teamer during his rookie campaign.

He is just the third player in Cardinals franchise history to receive at least six Pro Bowl nods in his first seven NFL seasons joining Patrick Peterson (7) and Ollie Matson (6). Baker is just the third player in franchise history named to the Pro Bowl as a safety at least five times joining Hall of Famer Larry Wilson (8) and Adrian Wilson (5).

He is also the only safety in the NFL named to the Pro Bowl each of the last five seasons (2019-23). **Only two other active defensive backs have more career Pro Bowls than Baker - cornerbacks Patrick Peterson (7) and Jalen Ramsey (6).**



CONNER GOES STREAKING YET AGAIN

RB James Conner has at least one TD (rushing or receiving) in each of the last four games. With a TD on Sunday, he'll have a TD streak of 5+ games in all three of his seasons with the Cardinals (7 games in 2021, 6 in '22). Despite playing just 41 games with Arizona, Conner's three streaks of 5+ games with a TD would match Sonny Randle for the most in franchise history.

In the Cardinals first 101 seasons (1920-2020) as an NFL franchise, a player had a streak of five or more consecutive games with a TD 21 times. With a TD on Sunday, Conner will have that streak in each of the last three seasons.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

TE **Trey McBride** has thrived in his last four games at State Farm Stadium. **McBride has totaled 35 receptions for 388 yards and a TD over his last four home games.**

In each of McBride's last four home games, he has at least seven receptions and 60 receiving yards. **McBride is the only player in franchise history - regardless of position - to have at least seven receptions and 60 receiving yards in four consecutive home games. With 7+ catches and 60+ receiving yards on Sunday, only one NFL TE (Zach Ertz - 6 home games in 2018) would have a longer such streak dating back to at least 1970.**
