



ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

- 100** Scrimmage yards (86 rushing, 14 receiving) for RB **James Conner** in last Sunday's win at San Francisco. Conner has 100+ scrimmage yards in seven of his last 10 games dating back to Week 13 of 2023. He and LAR RB Kyren Williams (7) have the most games with 100+ scrimmage yards in the NFL during that span.
- 19** Penalties committed by Arizona so far in 2024, the fewest by any team in the NFL. It marks just the third time in the last 65 years (1960-2024) Arizona has been penalized 19 times or fewer through the first five games of a season (15 in 2000 and 16 in 1965).
- 102** Years, 10 months and 24 days between the Cardinals and Packers first meeting at Normal Park in Chicago and Sunday's game in Green Bay (10/13). The rivalry is the NFL's second oldest trailing only Cards-Bears, which began the year prior.
- 10** Big plays (runs of 10+ yards & receptions of 20+ yards) in the win over the 49ers last week. NFL teams have had 10+ big plays in a game just 12 times in 2024. The Cardinals have had 10+ big plays in a game twice this season (12 vs. LAR - 9/15), joining the Commanders as the only teams to do so.

WITH A WIN...

- The Cardinals would improve to 5-2 in their last seven meetings with the Packers (including postseason).
- Combined with their 2018 win at Lambeau Field, the Cards would have back-to-back road wins vs. the Packers for the first time since 1948-49.
- Arizona will have won consecutive road games against teams who made the Divisional Round of the postseason last year.
- AZ would earn a share of first place in the NFC West.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 164 passing yards, Murray would pass Carson Palmer (16,782) for fourth place on the franchise all-time list for career passing yards.
- With 3 passing TDs, Murray would tie Neil Lomax (15 games) for the most games with 3+ passing TDs in franchise history.
- With 4 passing TDs, Murray would tie Carson Palmer (105) for fourth place on the franchise all-time list for career passing TDs.

RB JAMES CONNER

- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 33 rushing TDs with Arizona. That would tie David Johnson and John David Crow for third place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs. At 47 games, he would also become the quickest Cardinal ever to reach 33 rushing TDs with the team.
- With 100+ rushing yards, Conner would have eight 100-yard outings as a member of the Cardinals, matching Edgerrin James (2006-08) for the fourth-most games with 100+ rushing yards in franchise history.
- With 2 rushing TDs, Conner would have eight games with multiple rushing TDs as a member of the Cardinals. That would tie David Johnson (2015-19) for the most such outings in franchise history.

TE TREY MCBRIDE

- With five receptions, McBride would have 5+ catches in seven straight road games. Only two NFL TEs since at least 1970 have had longer such streaks (KC TE Travis Kelce - 10 games from 2019-20 and HOF TE Tony Gonzalez - nine games from 2004-05).

WR MARVIN HARRISON JR.

- With a TD reception, Harrison would become the first rookie in franchise history with at least five TD receptions in his six career games.
- With 2 TD receptions, Harrison would join Larry Fitzgerald (2 in 2004) and Anquan Boldin (2 in 2003) as the only rookies in team history with at least two TD receptions in multiple games in a season.
- With 100+ receiving yards, Harrison would become just the eighth rookie in franchise history with multiple 100-yard receiving games in a season and the first since Anquan Boldin (5) in 2003.

S BUDDA BAKER

- With 10+ tackles, Baker would have double-digit tackles for the 30th time in his career and in six of his last nine games played. It would also give him 10+ tackles in three consecutive games for the first time in his career.

RB DEEJAY DALLAS

- With a kickoff return of 35+ yards, Dallas would have four kickoff returns of 35+ yards this season. That would be the most in a Cardinals player's first six games of a season since 2010. Dallas (3) is one of three NFL players (Austin Ekeler - 2, KaVontae Turpin - 2) with multiple KORs of 35+ yards this season.

DL BILAL NICHOLS

- Nichols is set to appear in his 100th NFL regular season game on Sunday. He enters the contest having appeared in 83 consecutive games, the third-longest active streak among NFL defensive linemen.

GOLDEN IN GOAL-TO-GO

When QB **Kyler Murray** connected with TE **Elijah Higgins** for a two-yard TD in the fourth quarter to put the game within one score last week at SF, it made the Cardinals a perfect seven-of-seven in goal-to-go situations in 2024.

The Cardinals are the only team this season to have scored a TD on all of their goal-to-go drives. Arizona was also one of two NFL teams (New England) to hold a 100% scoring efficiency rating in goal-to-go situations through its first nine games last season.

BATTLE IN THE TRENCHES

Sunday's matchup features two of the NFL's best run games. In 2024, the Packers (824) and Cardinals (782) are the third and fourth in the NFL in rushing, respectively.

MACK ATTACK

LB Mack Wilson Sr. continued his strong 2024 campaign in last Sunday's win at SF with his best performance as a Cardinal.

Last week, Wilson had an INT and a fumble recovery in addition to six tackles. The fumble recovery marked the first of his NFL career while the INT was his second and first since his rookie year in 2019. **Both of his takeaways came in the second half and resulted in points for the Cardinals offense on the ensuing possession.**

With Sunday's performance in addition to a sack he collected in Week 3, Wilson is just one of three NFL players with at least one sack, INT and fumble recovery in 2024 joining 49ers DL Nick Bosa and Chiefs CB Chamarri Conner.
