



# ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

- 14.3** Points per game allowed by Arizona's defense during the team's current four-game winning streak. The Cardinals have the second-ranked scoring defense in the NFL since Week 7. Only the Eagles (13.4 ppg) have held their opponents to fewer points in that span (Weeks 7-11).
- 100** Tackles for S **Budda Baker** this season following a nine-tackle performance in Week 10's win over the Jets. It marks the fifth time in his career he's had 100+ tackles in a season. Since 2000, only one other NFL DB has had 100+ tackles in 5+ seasons (S Antoine Bethea - 8 seasons).
- 3+** Rushing TDs for QB **Kyler Murray** in each of his first six seasons. Murray is just the fourth QB in NFL history to do so joining Josh Allen, Cam Newton and Otto Graham. Murray, Jalen Hurts and the aforementioned group are also the only QBs in NFL history to have 30+ rushing TDs in their first six seasons.
- 21** Plays of 20+ yards (passing or rushing) allowed by the Cardinals defense over the last eight games. Only the Eagles (15) have allowed fewer such plays in their last eight contests. Arizona (17) also ranks second in the NFL in passes of 20+ yards allowed since Week 3 (Philly - 15).

## WITH A WIN...

- The Cardinals would extend their winning streak to five straight. Arizona would also have wins in six of its last seven games.
- AZ would improve to 7-4 and hold at least a one-game lead in the NFC West.
- The Cards would improve to 3-0 vs. division opponents in 2024 and have a win against all three NFC West teams.
- Arizona would become the first team to have 10 road wins at Lumen Field since the venue opened in 2002.

## MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

### QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 2 passing TDs, Murray would tie Charley Johnson (108) for third place on the franchise all-time list for career passing TDs.

### RB JAMES CONNER

- With 56 scrimmage yards, Conner would have 1,000 in 2024. He would become the first player in Cardinals history to have 1,000+ scrimmage yards in each of his first four seasons with the team.
- With 61 rushing yards, Conner (3,238) would pass Pro Football Hall of Famer Ollie Matson (3,331) for the 9th-most rushing yards in franchise history. With 105 rushing yards, he would also pass Wayne Morris (3,375) for 8th place.
- With 100+ rushing yards, Conner would have 10 games with 100+ rushing yards as a member of the Cardinals, the third-most in franchise history. It would also mark his seventh 100-yard rushing performance in his last 13 games and his fifth 100-yard outing in 2024.
- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 35 rushing TDs with Arizona, the third most in franchise history (Ottis Anderson - 46 and Wayne Morris - 37).

### TE TREY MCBRIDE

- With 5 receptions, McBride would have at least five catches in each of his last nine road games. He would join Travis Kelce (10 straight from 2019-20) and Tony Gonzalez (9 straight from 2004-05) as the only TEs in NFL history to have at least five receptions in nine straight road games.
- With 8 receptions, McBride would have 57 catches this season, the second most by a TE in a season in franchise history. Combined with his franchise-record 81 receptions in 2023, he would own the two highest single-season reception totals by a TE in team history.
- With 100+ receiving yards, McBride (2) would join HOFer Jackie Smith (6) as the only TEs in franchise history to have multiple seasons with multiple games of 100+ receiving yards.

### WR MARVIN HARRISON JR.

- With a TD catch, Harrison would have seven TD receptions in 2024. He would become the first player in franchise history to have 7+ TD catches in his first 11 career games.
- With 2 TD receptions, Harrison would match Anquan Boldin (8 in 2003) and Larry Fitzgerald (8 in 2004) for the most TD receptions by a rookie in franchise history. He would also join Fitzgerald (2) and Boldin (2) as the only rookies in team history with at least 2 TD receptions in multiple games in a season.
- With 100+ receiving yards, Harrison would join Anquan Boldin (5 in 2003) and Gaynell Tinsley (3 in 1937) as the only rookies in franchise history with at least three 100-yard receiving performances.

### S BUDDA BAKER

- With 10+ tackles, Baker would have double-digit tackles for the 32nd time in his career and in eight of his last 14 games played.

### LB XAVIER THOMAS

- With a sack, Thomas would have at least 1.0 sack in three consecutive games. He would become just the fifth different rookie in franchise history to accomplish the feat and the first since LB Sam Acho (three straight games) in 2011.

## HISTORIC SEASON FOR KYLER CONTINUES

QB **Kyler Murray** completed 22-of-24 passes (91.7%) for 266 yards, a TD and a passer rating of 126.7 in Week 10 vs. the Jets. He also ran for 31 yards and two TDs in the win. **The outing earned him NFC Offensive Player of the Week.**

His performance in Week 10 gave Murray (6) the most 'Player of the Week' awards in franchise history. **He became the first player in NFL history to complete at least 85% of his pass attempts while having 250+ passing yards and 2+ rushing touchdowns in a game.**

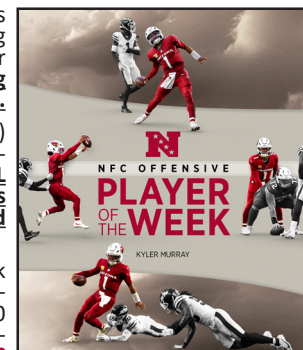
Murray's 91.7 completion percentage in Week 10 is the second-highest single-game completion percentage in franchise history (min. 20 attempts.) and is the highest in the NFL this season (min. 20 attempts). **Murray enters Week 12 with 17 consecutive completions, which is already the franchise record. The NFL record is 25 straight completions and currently shared by four QBs.**

Murray has a chance to re-write the team history books yet again this Sunday in Seattle. **With two TD passes on Sunday, Murray would tie Charley Johnson (108) for the third-most passing TDs in franchise history.**

Murray has thrown 10 TD passes in eight career games against the Seahawks, the second most against any opponent in his career (11 vs. the Rams in nine games).



## THE CONSISTENCY OF CONNER

RB **James Conner** had another strong performance in the Week 10 win over the Jets. He led the team with five catches for 80 receiving yards to pair with 33 rushing yards and a TD on the ground. **With 113 scrimmage yards, it marked his 10th game with 100+ scrimmage yards in his last 15 contests. That is the most such games in the NFL in that span (since Week 13 of 2023).**

Conner's performance against the Jets also gave him 944 scrimmage yards in 2024. **Only 10 games into the season, he is just 56 yards away from his fourth consecutive 1,000-yard season. On Sunday in Seattle, Conner could become just the fifth NFL player to total 1,000+ scrimmage yards in each of the last four seasons joining Derrick Henry, Josh Jacobs, Alvin Kamara and Ja'Marr Chase.**
