2 Tackles for LB Josh Woods in Arizona's Week 13 win over Pittsburgh. That total was a game high and marked the second time in his career Woods surpassed 10 tackles in a game. Woods came one tackle shy of his career high as he had 13 tackles in his first career start in 2021.

Fumble recovery for DL **Dante Stills** last game against the Steelers. Stills is one of just 13 rookies to recover a fumble this season. He joins Jalen Carter, YaYa Diaby and Tuli Tuipulotu as the only rookies to have at least 3.5 sacks and one fumble recovery in 2023.

Tackles, to go along with three passes defensed and two INTs, for S **Budda Baker** in his last three games against the 49ers. In nine career starts vs. San Francisco, Baker has posted 10+ tackles five times. That includes two 15-tackle performances, which is his career high.

2 TD receptions for rookie WR Michael Wilson in the Cardinals Week 4 matchup with the 49ers. He remains one of just two players to have multiple TD catches in a game against San Francisco this season (Vikings WR Jordan Addison - 2).

WITH A WIN...

The Cardinals would improve to 7-2 in their last nine games vs. the 49ers at State Farm Stadium.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

TE TREY McBRIDE

- With one reception, McBride would establish a new franchise single-season record for catches by a TE. He currently shares the record of 56 with Zach Ertz (2021) and Jackie Smith (1967).
- With 90 receiving yards, McBride would join Hall of Famer Jackie Smith (3x) as the only TEs in franchise history with 700+ receiving yards in a season. Smith had 1,205 yards in 1967, 810 in 1966 and 789 in 1968.

RB JAMES CONNER

- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 27 rushing TDs as a member of the Cardinals. That would tie Johnny Roland (1966-72) and Elmer Angsman (1946-52) for sixth place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs.
- With 100+ rushing yards, Conner would have back-to-back 100-yard games for the first time since Games 2-3 of the 2020 season with Pittsburgh. Conner would also be the first Cardinals player with 100+ rushing yards in back-toback games since Kenyan Drake in 2019 (Games 14-15).
- With 100+ rushing yards, Conner would be the first Cardinals player with at least three 100-yard outings in a season since Drake (3) in 2019.

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 288 passing yards, Murray would reach 15,000 passing yards in his career. He would join Russell Wilson, Josh Allen and Cam Newton as the only players in NFL history with 15,000+ passing yards and 2,000+ rushing yards in their first five seasons.
- With a rushing and passing TD, Murray would have both a passing and rushing TD for the 19th time in his career. Just two players in NFL History Cam Newton (31) and Josh Allen (25) would have more such games in their first five seasons.
- With 3 passing TDs, Murray would reach 90 TD passes in his career. Combined with his 26 rushing TDs, Murray would join Josh Allen, Cam Newton and Daunte Culpepper as the only QBs in NFL history with 90+ passing TDs and 25+ rushing TDs in their first five seasons.
- With a rushing TD, Murray would have 27 rushing TDs as a member of the Cardinals. That would tie Johnny Roland (1966-72) and Elmer Angsman (1946-52) for sixth place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs.

LB BJ OJULARI - OR - DL DANTE STILLS

With 1.5 or more sacks, Ojulari - or - Stills would join Simeon Rice (3 in 1996) and Andre Wadsworth (2 in 1998) as the only players in franchise history with at least two games of multiple sacks in their rookie season.

<u>K MATT PRATER</u>

- With a FG of 50+ yards, Prater would establish a franchise single-season record with eight FGs of 50+ yards in 2023. It would also give him 79 career FGs of 50+, extending his NFL record.
- With three field goals, Prater would reach 396 field goals in his career and pass Mason Crosby (395) for 13th place on the NFL's all-time list for career field goals.
- With 11 points, Prater would reach 1,759 points in his career and pass Matt Bryant (1,758) for 15th place on the NFL's all-time scoring list.

WR RONDALE MOORE

With a rushing TD, Moore would have two rushing TDs this season and join Bobby Joe Conrad (two in 1959) as the only Cardinals WRs with multiple rushing TDs in a season.

HOME SWEET HOME

TE **Trey McBride** has thrived in his last three games at State Farm Stadium. In those games, he totaled 25 receptions for 286 yards and a TD.

In each of McBride's last three home games, he had at least seven receptions and 60 receiving yards, joining Chiefs TE Travis Kelce as the only NFL TEs to have 7+ catches and 60+ receiving yards in three consecutive home games this season.



McBride is the only Cardinals TE ever to have at

least seven receptions and 60 receiving yards in three consecutive home games. With seven receptions and 60 receiving yards on Sunday, he could become the first Cardinals player regardless of position to do so in four consecutive home games.

#6 FOR SIX!

RB James Conner ran for 105 yards and two TDs on 25 carries (4.2 avg.) in his return to Pittsburgh in Week 13. It marked <u>Conner's 12th time rushing for multiple TDs</u> in a game since 2018. Only Derrick Henry (22 games) has more games with 2+ rushing TDs in that span.

BAKER FINALIST FOR ROONEY SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

On Thursday, Cardinals S **Budda Baker** was named as one of eight finalists for the 2023 Art Rooney Sportsmanship Award. Created in 2014, the award recognizes players around the league who exemplify outstanding sportsmanship on the field in honor of the late founding owner of the Pittsburgh Steelers and Pro Football Hall of Famer Art Rooney Sr.

Baker has been penalized just one time for five yards (defensive offsides) in 2,637 snaps over the last three years.

A panel of former players from the NFL Legends Community selected the eight finalists from the 32 NFL club nominees. The panel is comprised of former Cardinals wide receiver Larry Fitzgerald, Warrick Dunn, Curtis Martin and Leonard Wheeler. Fitzgerald won the inaugural award in 2014.
