



ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

88 Combined receptions for WR **Michael Wilson** and TE **Trey McBride** in the last five games (44 each). They are the only two players in the NFL to have 40+ catches in that span (since Week 11) and the first duo since Travis Kelce and Tyreek Hill in 2020 to have 85+ receptions, 1,000+ receiving yards and 7+ TDs in a five-game stretch.

101 Tackles for S **Budda Baker** this season. The 2025 season marks his sixth 100-tackle campaign, his second in a row, and his third in the last four years. Baker's 101 tackles also rank 4th among all NFL DBs in 2025. He is one of just two DBs (Antoine Bethea - 8) since 2000 to have 6+ seasons of 100-or-more tackles.

10 Career FG blocks for DL **Calais Campbell**, with the most recent coming on a 52-yard attempt last week at Houston. In NFL history only Shaun Rogers (14) and Julius Peppers (12) have more.

8 Games with 225+ passing yards and 2+ passing TDs for QB **Jacoby Brissett** this season. That is tied with Cowboys QB Dak Prescott for the second-most in the NFL behind only Rams QB Matthew Stafford (9). Brissett has accomplished the feat in just nine starts while the other two have started all 14 games this season.

MILESTONE WATCH

WITH A WIN...

- Arizona would improve to 19-16 all-time vs. the Falcons (including postseason). The Cardinals would also improve to 13-2 at home vs. Atlanta.
- Arizona would improve to 6-0 at home vs. Atlanta since beginning play at State Farm Stadium in 2006 (including postseason).

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

LB JOSH SWEAT

- With 1.0 sack, Sweat would have 12.0 sacks in 2025. That would establish a new career high for the 8th-year pro (11.0 in 2022 w/ Eagles). It would also give him at least 1.0 sack in 9 of 15 games this season.
- With 2.0 sacks, Sweat (4) would join Simeon Rice (6 in 1999; 4 in 1998), Chandler Jones (4 in 2017 & 2019) and Curtis Greer (4 in 1983) as the only players in franchise history to have at least four games with 2.0+ sacks in a single season.

TE TREY MCBRIDE

- With 5 receptions, McBride would have 5+ catches for the 17th consecutive game. That would extend the longest such streak by a TE in NFL history (previous: Travis Kelce with 15 such games in 2018).
- With 5 receptions, McBride (331) would also pass Larry Fitzgerald (330) for the second-most catches by a Cardinal in his first four seasons. He needs 17 receptions to pass Anquan Boldin (342) for the top spot.
- With 7 receptions, McBride would have 112 receptions in 2025. That would break his own franchise single-season record for receptions by a TE (111 in 2024).
- With 135 receiving yards, McBride (1,206) would break the franchise single-season record for receiving yards by a TE. The current record of 1,205 was set by Hall of Famer Jackie Smith in 1967.
- With 1 TD reception, McBride would have 11 TD catches in 2025. He would become the first Cardinals player since Larry Fitzgerald in 2009 (13) to have at least 11 TD catches in a season.
- With 2 TD receptions, McBride would become the first TE (and just 6th player overall) in Cardinals history with 2+ TD catches in back-to-back games.

QB JACOBY BRISSETT

- With 1 TD pass, Brissett (19) would establish a new career high for TD passes.
- With 6 passing yards, Brissett (2,714) would pass Kurt Warner (2,713 in 2005) for the most passing yards by a Cardinals QB in his first 10 starts with the team.
- With 292+ passing yards and 2+ TDs, Brissett would join Matthew Stafford (2021 w/ LAR), Justin Herbert (2020 w/ LAC) and Patrick Mahomes (2017-18 w/ KC) as the only QBs since at least 1950 to have 3,000+ passing yards and 2+ TD passes in their first 10 starts with a team.

WR MICHAEL WILSON

- With 1 TD reception, Wilson would have at least one TD catch in three consecutive games for the first time since his senior year at Chaminade High School in West Hills, CA when he had four such performances in Games 2-5 of 2017.

DL CALAIS CAMPBELL

- With 1.0 sack, Campbell would have 6.5 sacks in 2025. It would mark the second time in his last six years (6.5 in 2023 w/ Atlanta) Campbell had at least 6.5 sacks in a season.

WR MARVIN HARRISON JR.

- With 1 TD catch, Harrison would have 13 career TD receptions. In franchise history only Sonny Randle (19), Mal Kutner (19) and Larry Fitzgerald (15) would have more in their first 28 career games.

S BUDDA BAKER

- With 5+ tackles, it would be Baker's 33rd consecutive game with 5-or-more tackles, the third-longest streak by a DB in NFL history. It is also the second-longest active streak behind only Commanders LB Bobby Wagner (43 games).

MCBRIDE REWRITING THE RECORD BOOK

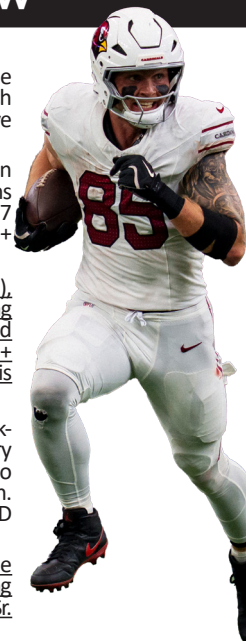
Last week, TE **Trey McBride** posted his 16th consecutive game with 5+ receptions and passed Chiefs TE Travis Kelce (15 such games in 2018) for the longest streak of games with at least five catches by a TE in NFL history.

He matched or surpassed his single-game career-highs in receptions (12), receiving yards (134) and touchdown receptions (2) and joined Anquan Boldin (9/23/07 @ Bal and 12/23/07 vs. Atl) as the only other player in franchise history to have 12+ receptions, 130+ yards and 2+ TDs in the same game.

Entering the week, McBride led the NFL in receptions (105), ranked third in touchdown receptions (10) and sixth in receiving yards (1,071). He joined Travis Kelce (2018, '20, and '22) and Dallas Clark (2009) as the only TEs in NFL history to have 100+ receptions, 1,000+ receiving yards and 10+ TDs in a season and is the first TE to accomplish the feat in just 14 games.

He is the first TE in NFL history to post 100+ receptions in back-to-back seasons (111 in 2024; 105 in 2025) and joined Larry Fitzgerald (2005, 07) as the only players in franchise history to have 100+ receptions, 1,000+ yards and 10+ TDs in a season. McBride also passed Jackie Smith (9 TDs in 1967) for the most TD receptions by a TE in Cardinals history.

If he finishes the season as the NFL receptions leader, McBride would become just the fourth TE in NFL history to do so, joining two Hall of Famers in Tony Gonzalez (2004) and Kellen Winslow Sr. (1980,81) and multiple time All-Pro Todd Christensen (1983,86).



THE PRESENT AND FUTURE



DL **Calais Campbell** spent the 2023 season with the Atlanta Falcons where he started all 17 games and totaled 56 tackles, 6.5 sacks, 17 QB hits, 10 tackles for loss, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a pass defended. He also achieved a career milestone as he recorded his 100th career sack in Week 6 that season vs. Washington.

DL **Walter Nolen III** recorded his second sack of the season last week at Houston. Excluding the 1987 season which included replacement players, he is just the sixth player in Cardinals history to have 2.0+ sacks in his first five career games. He is also the first DL in NFL history to have two games with at least 1.0 sack and one pass defended in his first five career games.

CARDINALS HIGH SCHOOL HONORS

At a special event held at the Morgan Athletic Club at State Farm Stadium last week, the Cardinals announced the awards given to athletes and coaches at the inaugural **Arizona Cardinals High School Honors presented by Avnet**. Recognizing the 2025 season of Arizona high school football, 12 players were honored including Hamilton WR **Royce Oliver III** being named the **Larry Fitzgerald Boys Player of the Year** and Casa Grande WR/DB **Kayla Tacker** being named the **Violet Bidwill Girls Player of the Year**. Cardinals Players and Coaches of the Week from the boys tackle and girls flag seasons were also honored at the event.
