



ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

- 204** Scrimmage yards for RB **James Conner** in his last home game against the Seahawks. In Week 18 last season vs. Seattle at State Farm Stadium, Conner ran for a career-high 150 yards and a TD on 27 carries (5.6 avg.) and had four receptions for 56 yards.
- 12** Receptions for TE **Trey McBride** in each of the last two games. McBride became the first TE in NFL history and the first player in team history - regardless of position - to have 12+ catches in consecutive games.
- 86** Tackles for LB **Kyzir White** in 2024. White is just four tackles away from reaching 90 tackles for a fourth straight season and becoming just the ninth NFL player to have 90+ tackles in each of the last four years (2021-24).
- 2** Forced fumbles for CB **Sean Murphy-Bunting** last week in Minnesota, both of which came at the expense of Vikings RB Aaron Jones in the first half. Murphy-Bunting is the first Cardinal to force two fumbles in a game since Chandler Jones in Week 1 of 2021 and the first to do so in a first half since Tony Jefferson in Week 5 of 2015.

WITH A WIN...

- Arizona would improve to 7-6 and enter the final four weeks of the regular season in a tie for first place in the NFC West.
- The Cardinals would have at least four consecutive home wins for the first time since the team won four straight in 2015.
- The Cards would improve to 3-1 vs. division opponents in 2024 and have a win against all three NFC West teams.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 2 passing TDs, Murray would pass Charley Johnson (108) for third place on the franchise all-time list for career passing TDs.
- With 78 rushing yards, Murray would reach 500 rushing yards in a season for the third time in his career - and first time since 2020 (819).

RB JAMES CONNER

- With 29 rushing yards, Conner (3,347) would pass Wayne Morris (3,375) for the 8th-most rushing yards in franchise history. With 92 rushing yards, he would also pass Terry Metcalf (3,438) for 7th place.
- With 100+ rushing yards, Conner would have 10 games with 100+ rushing yards as a member of the Cardinals, the third-most in franchise history. It would also mark his seventh 100-yard rushing performance in his last 15 games and his fifth 100-yard outing in 2024.
- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 35 rushing TDs with Arizona, the third most in franchise history (Ottis Anderson - 46 and Wayne Morris - 37).

TE TREY MCBRIDE

- With 19 receiving yards, McBride would have 800 in 2024. Combined with his 825 yards in 2023, he would join Hall of Famer Jackie Smith (2x) as the only TEs in franchise history with multiple seasons of 800+ receiving yards.
- With nine receptions, McBride would break his own franchise single-season record for receptions by a TE (81 in 2023).
- With 10+ receptions, McBride would become the first player in franchise history - at any position - to have 10+ catches in three consecutive games.

WR MARVIN HARRISON JR.

- With a TD catch, Harrison would have eight TD receptions in 2024. He would become the first player in franchise history to have 8+ TD catches in his first 13 career games. That would also tie Larry Fitzgerald (8 in 2004) and Anquan Boldin (8 in 2003) for the most TD catches in franchise history by a rookie.
- With 94 receiving yards, Harrison would join Anquan Boldin (1,377 in 2003), Frank Sanders (883 in 1995), Ricky Proehl (802 in 1990) and Larry Fitzgerald (780 in 2004) as the only rookies in franchise history with 700+ receiving yards.
- With 100+ receiving yards, Harrison would join Anquan Boldin (5 in 2003) and Gaynell Tinsley (3 in 1937) as the only rookies in franchise history with at least three 100-yard receiving performances.

S BUDDA BAKER

- With 10+ tackles, Baker would have double-digit tackles for the 32nd time in his career and in eight of his last 16 games played.

LB MACK WILSON SR.

- With 1.0 sack, Wilson would have at least 1.0 sack in back-to-back games and have a career-high 4.0 sacks in 2024.

DL L.J. COLLIER

- With 1.0 sack, Collier would have at least 1.0 sack in three straight games for the first time in his career. He would also have at least a partial sack in four of his last five outings and a career-high 4.5 sacks in 2024.

TREY'S TREMENDOUS LAST TWO GAMES

Last Sunday in Minnesota, TE **Trey McBride** had 12 receptions for 96 yards. His 12 catches matched the franchise single-game record (among TEs) that he set the week prior at Seattle. McBride also had a career-high 133 receiving yards in Week 12's meeting with the Seahawks.

Over the last two weeks, McBride has totaled 24 receptions for 229 yards with 15 catches for first downs. His 24 receptions and 15 catches for first downs led the NFL in that span while his 229 receiving yards were the second most (Browns WR Jerry Jeudy - 320).

McBride was targeted 12 times against the Vikings last Sunday and each resulted in a catch. He is the only player in the NFL this season to catch every one of his targets and have 12+ receptions in a game. He joins 49ers TE George Kittle (15 in Week 4 of 2020) as the only NFL TEs to do so in the last 15 seasons.

ARIZONA'S DEFENSE IS STACKING SACKS

The Cardinals defense sacked QB Sam Darnold five times last week in Minnesota. **Paired with five sacks the week prior @ Seattle (11/24), it marked just the fifth time in the last 40 seasons that Arizona had 5+ sacks in back-to-back games.**

With 5.0 sacks on Sunday vs. the Seahawks, Arizona would have 5+ sacks in three straight games for the first time since at least 1970. AZ's 10 sacks over the last two games are tied for the most in the NFL in Weeks 12-13.
