CARDINALS

Receptions for WR DeAndre Hopkins in 2022 if he continues his current pace: 45 receptions for 487 yards 100in five games played. Despite having missed the first six games this season, Hopkins is currently on pace for 100 receptions and 1,075 receiving yards.

Home games - in the last 19 seasons (2003-21) - for the Cardinals in the series vs. the Chargers. This week the Chargers will play just their second regular season game at State Farm Stadium (2014).

Week 1 starters - QB Kyler Murray, LT D.J. Humphries, LG Justin Pugh, C Rodney Hudson, RG Will Her-nandez, WR Marquise Brown and TE Zach Ertz - who missed last week's game in Mexico City due to injury. Ertz missed his first game of the season, becoming the 30th Arizona player to miss time to injury.

Tackles for S **Budda Baker** in the last four seasons (2019-22). That is over 100 more than any other DB in 448 the NFL during that span (Minnesota S Harrison Smith comes in second with 345). Baker has 10+ tackles in four games this season, including in three of the last four contests.

WITH A WIN

- The Cardinals would improve to 10-6 against teams from the AFC under head coach Kliff Kingsbury, including a 6-2 record dating back to 2021.
- Arizona would improve to 2-0 vs. the Chargers at State Farm Stadium.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

WR DEANDRE HOPKINS

- With 1 reception, Hopkins would have at least one catch in 142 consecutive games. That would extend the longest active streak in the NFL.
- With 10 receptions, Hopkins would have 10+ receptions in four of six games played this season. He would join Larry Fitzgerald (4 in 2017) as the only players in franchise history with at least four games of 10+ receptions in a season.
- With 1 TD reception, Hopkins would have 11 TD catches in 16 games played dating back to the beginning of last season.
- With 100+ receiving yards, Hopkins would have 100+ yards in a game for the 40th time in his career and for the 10th time as a member of the Cardinals.

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 3+ TD passes, Murray would have 3+ passing TDs in a game for the 13th time in his career. Only Neil Lomax (15 times in 108 games) and Charley Johnson (14 times in 87 games) would have more such performances.
- With 41 rushing yards, Murray would join Josh Allen, Lamar Jackson, Russell Wilson and Cam Newton as the only QBs in NFL history with 400+ rushing yards in each of their first four seasons.

DE J.J. WATT

- With 1.0 sack, Watt would have 6.5 sacks in 2022. He would have more sacks in 11 games played this season (6.5) than he had in the previous two seasons (2020-21) combined (6.0 in 23 games played).
- A sack of Chargers QB Justin Herbert would make him the 46th different QB Watt has sacked in his career.

RB JAMES CONNER

- With a TD (of any kind), Conner would have 23 TDs in 24 games with Arizona. That would set a franchise record for TDs in a player's first 24 games with the team.
- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 20 rushing TDs in 24 games with the Cardinals.
- With two TDs (of any kind), Conner would have six total TDs in three career games vs. the Chargers. He would have multiple TDs in all three contests.
- With two rushing TDs, Conner would have multiple rushing TDs for the 7th time as a member of the Cardinals. In franchise history only David Johnson (8) would have more games with multiple rushing TDs.

ZACH ALLEN

With 1.0 sack, Allen would have 4.5 sacks in 2022. That would be a new career high (current mark is 4.0 in 2021).

S BUDDA BAKER

With 10+ tackles, Baker would have 10+ tackles in a game for the fifth time this season - and for the fourth time in five games.

<u>WR A.J. GREEN</u>

With 1 TD catch, Green would have 70 TD receptions in his career. He would join Davante Adams (83), Mike Evans (78) and teammate DeAndre Hopkins (70) as the only active players with 70+ career TD receptions.

<u>WR MARQUISE BROWN</u>

With a TD reception, Brown would have 25 career TD catches. It would be Brown's fourth TD catch in seven games played this season, and his third in his last four games played.



BAKER IS SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD NOMINEE

The 32 player nominees for the 9th annual Art Rooney Sportsmanship Award were announced earlier this week, and S **Budda Baker** was named the Cardinals nominee. Created in 2014 in honor of late Steelers Hall of Fame owner Art Rooney Sr., the award recognizes players who exemplify outstanding sportsmanship on the field.

As aggressive on the field as any player in the league, Baker has always balanced his relentless and physical playing style with a respect for the game and his opponents. The best illustration is how rare it is for Baker to be penalized for his on-field play.



 Over the last four seasons (2019-22), Baker leads all NFL DBs
with 448 total tackles. <u>Despite that production and playing 3,856 total defensive</u> snaps in that span, he has been penalized just four times in the last four seasons.

• In the last two seasons (2021-22), Baker has played 1,731 snaps and has been called for just one penalty for 5 yards (defensive offsides).

•In 694 defensive snaps in 2022, *Baker ranks 3rd among NFL DBs with 71 total tackles* and has not been called for a single penalty.

MURRAY VS. HERBERT - ROUND ONE

Sunday's matchup against the Chargers will mark the first meeting between two young Pro Bowl QBs in Arizona's Kyler Murray and L.A.'s Justin Herbert. Although they are young - Murray is 25 and Herbert is 24 - the pair have already built impressive resumes.

TDS VS. THE TEAMS FROM TINSELTOWN

RB James Conner has 48 total TDs in 73 career games. Of those 48 TDs, 10 have come in six games against the two teams from Los Angeles. Conner has four TDs (3 rushing, 1 receiving) in two career games against the Chargers.

Against the Rams and Chargers, Conner has averaged 1.7 TDs per game (10 TDs in 6 games). Against all other teams he averages 0.57 TDs per game (38 in 67 games).

Over 20 percent of his career TDs (10 of 48) have come against the L.A. teams

Conner has 13 multi-TD performances in his career with five coming against the Chargers and Rams.
