



# ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

**7** Games in which QB **Kyler Murray** has thrown at least one TD pass this season. He is one of just four NFL QBs to have done so in 2024, joining Ravens QB Lamar Jackson, Seahawks QB Geno Smith and Buccaneers QB Baker Mayfield.

**+19** Scoring differential for the Cardinals in their last five games against the Dolphins. Five of the last six games in the series have been decided by one score.

**0** Sacks allowed by the Cardinals offensive line in each of the last two games. Arizona has allowed just one or zero sacks in five of its seven games this season. That is the most such games for an NFL team in 2024. Only the Broncos (3) have more games where they held their opponents without a sack this season. The Cards have had eight different starters and 10 different players take snaps on the O-line in 2024.

**106** Rushing yards for QB **Kyler Murray** in his lone meeting with the Dolphins (11/8/20), which marked a career high. Murray completed 21-of-26 pass attempts for 283 yards and a 150.5 passer rating in addition to four total TDs (three passing, one rushing) in the game.

## WITH A WIN...

- The Cardinals would improve to 4-2 in their last six games vs. the Dolphins.
- Arizona would earn its second-ever road win in Miami and second in the last three visits (won 24-23 in 2004).
- The Cards would improve to 3-1 in their last 4 games in the Eastern Time Zone.

## MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

### QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 3 passing TDs, Murray would tie Neil Lomax (15 games) for the most games with 3+ passing TDs in franchise history.
- With 3 passing TDs, Murray would pass Carson Palmer (105) for fourth place on the franchise all-time list for career passing TDs.

### RB JAMES CONNER

- With 51 rushing yards, Conner would pass David Johnson (3,128) for 10th place on the Cardinals all-time list for career rushing yards.
- With 100+ rushing yards, Conner would have nine 100-yard outings as a member of the Cardinals, matching Jim Otis (1973-78) for the third-most games with 100+ rushing yards in franchise history. It would also mark his sixth 100-yard rushing performance in his last 10 games and his second in a row.
- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 33 rushing TDs with Arizona. That would tie David Johnson and John David Crow for third place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs.
- With 2 rushing TDs, Conner would have 8 games with 2+ rushing TDs with the Cards, tying David Johnson (2015-19) for the most such games in team annals.

### TE TREY MCBRIDE

- With five receptions, McBride would have 5+ catches in eight straight road games. Only two NFL TEs since at least 1970 have had longer such streaks (KC TE Travis Kelce - 10 games from 2019-20 and HOF TE Tony Gonzalez - nine games from 2004-05). He has had 5+ catches in 5-of-6 games played in 2024.

### WR MARVIN HARRISON JR.

- With a TD catch, Harrison would join Fran Polsfoot (5 in 1950) as the only players in Cardinals history with at least 5 TD catches in their first 8 career games.
- With 2 TD receptions, Harrison would join Larry Fitzgerald (2 in 2004) and Anquan Boldin (2 in 2003) as the only rookies in team history with at least 2 TD receptions in multiple games in a season.
- With 100+ receiving yards, Harrison would become just the eighth rookie in franchise history with multiple 100-yard receiving games in a season and the first since Anquan Boldin (5) in 2003.

### WR GREG DORTCH

- With a reception, Dortch would have 100 receptions in his career.
- With a TD reception, Dortch would have a TD catch in back-to-back games for the first time in his career.

### S BUDDA BAKER

- With 10+ tackles, Baker would have double-digit tackles for the 30th time in his career and in six of his last 11 games played.
- With 14 tackles, Baker would have 800 tackles in his career.

### DL NAQUAN JONES

- With a sack, Jones would have nearly as many sacks in four games played this season (3.0) as he had in his first three seasons combined (3.5 in 36 games).
- With a sack, Jones would have a sack in back-to-back games for the first time in his career.

### LB ZAVEN COLLINS

- With three tackles, Collins would have 200 tackles in his career.

## CONNER CAN DO IT ALL

RB **James Conner** continued his hot start to the 2024 campaign last week with a strong performance on Monday Night Football. **He had a game-high 101 rushing yards and shared the team lead with 51 receiving yards (Trey McBride - 51) in the Cardinals primetime victory.**

**Conner is just the fifth NFL player this season to have 100+ rushing yards and 50+ receiving yards in a game.**

With another strong performance in the pass game this week, Conner could reach a pair of milestones. With two receptions, he would reach 250 receptions in his career. **With 58 receiving yards, Conner would have 2,000 receiving yards in his career. He'd become just the 7th active player with 5,000+ rushing yards and 2,000+ receiving yards.**

**Over Conner's last nine games, he has totaled nearly 1,000 scrimmage yards. In that span, only Ravens RB Derrick Henry (1,130) has accounted for more scrimmage yards than Conner (980).**

## ELITE WITH HIS FEET

In Monday's come-from-behind victory over LAC, QB **Kyler Murray** yet again showed how dangerous he can be with his feet. The sixth-year signal caller ran for 64 yards and a TD on six carries (10.7 avg.), including a 44-yard TD run that was the third longest TD run by a QB in Cardinals history.

**Only two NFL QBs (Ravens QB Lamar Jackson - 455 yards and Commanders QB Jayden Daniels - 372) have more rushing yards this season than Murray (325).**
