ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

- Finalists were named for the Art Rooney Sportsmanship Award on Tuesday which included S **Budda Baker**. It's his third consecutive season being named a finalist for the award which is presented annually to an NFL player who best demonstrates the qualities of on-field sportsmanship.
- Games this season in which WR **Michael Wilson** has 10+ receptions and 100+ receiving yards (all coming in his last four outings). That is tied for the most such games in a single season in franchise history. He joins LAR's Puka Nacua (3) as the only players in the NFL with at least three such outings in 2025.
- Sacks for LB Josh Sweat this season, tying his career high (2022 w/ Philadelphia). He is the first Cardinals player to reach double-digit sacks in a season since J.J. Watt (12.5) in 2022.
 - Games with 250+ passing yards and 2+ passing touchdowns for QB Jacoby Brissett this season. That is tied for the most in the NFL with Cowboys QB Dak Prescott and Rams QB Matthew Stafford. Brissett has accomplished the feat in just eight starts while the other two have started all 13 games this season.

MILESTONE WATCH

WITH A WIN...

- Arizona would earn its first-ever road win against the Texans and take a 4-3 lead in its all-time series vs. Houston.
 - QB Jacoby Brissett would improve to 6-1 all-time as a starter vs. the Texans. He would also become the 7th QB in NFL history to beat a single opponent as the starting QB for at least four different teams in those wins. He previously won with the Patriots, Colts and Dolphins.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

LB JOSH SWEAT

- With 1.0 sack, Sweat would have 12.0 sacks in 2025. That would establish a new career high for the 8th-year pro (11.0 in 2022 w/ Eagles). It would also give him at least 1.0 sack in 9 of 14 games this season.
- With 2.0 sacks, Sweat (4) would join Simeon Rice (6 in 1999; 4 in 1998), Chander Jones (4 in 2017 & 2019) and Curtis Greer (4 in 1983) as the only players in franchise history to have at least four games with 2.0+ sacks in a single season.

<u>TE TREY McBRIDE</u>

- With 5 receptions, McBride would have 5+ catches for the 16th consecutive game. That would pass Travis Kelce (15 in 2018) for the longest such streak by a TE in NFL history.
- With 1 TD reception, McBride would have 9 TD catches in 2025. That would tie Hall of Famer Jackie Smith (9 in 1967) for the most TDs by a TE in a single season in franchise history.
- With 2 TD receptions, McBride would become the first Cardinals player with 10+ TD catches in a season since WR Larry Fitzgerald (10) in 2013.
- With 7 catches, McBride would become the first TE in NFL history to have 100+ receptions in back-to-back seasons. McBride (2) would join Travis Kelce (3) as the only TEs in NFL history with multiple seasons of 100+ receptions.
- With 63 receiving yards, McBride would become the first TE in franchise history with multiple seasons of 1,000+ receiving yards.
- With 7 receptions <u>AND</u> 63 receiving yards McBride (2, 2024-25) would join WR Larry Fitzgerald (3, 2015-17) as the only Cardinals players ever to have 100+ receptions and 1,000+ receiving yards in at least two consecutive seasons.

QB JACOBY BRISSETT

- With 2 TD passes, Brissett would have multiple TD passes in eight of nine starts in 2025.
- With 140 passing yards, Brissett (2,599) would pass Kurt Warner (2,398 in 2005) for the most passing yards by a Cardinals QB in his first nine starts with the team.
- With 250+ passing yards and 2+ TDs, Brissett (8) would join Carson Palmer (9 in 2015) and Neil Lomax (9 in 1984) as the only players in franchise history with eight such outings in a single season.

S BUDDA BAKER

 With 7 tackles, Baker would surpass 100+ tackles for the second-consecutive season and for the 6th time in his career. He would join Antoine Bethea (8) Lawyer Milloy (7), Rodney Harrison (7) and Steve Atwater (6) as the only DBs to have 6+ seasons of 100-or-more tackles in their career.

WR MICHAEL WILSON

 With 9 receptions on Sunday, Wilson (48) would pass Anquan Boldin (47 in games 11-15 of 2005) for the most receptions by a Cardinals player in a fivegame span in franchise history.

DL CALAIS CAMPBELL

 With 1.0 sack, Campbell would have 6.5 sacks in 2025. It would mark the second time in his last six years (6.5 in 2023 w/ Atlanta) Campbell had at least 6.5 sacks in a season.

RB BAM KNIGHT

With a TD (of any kind), Knight would extend his career high to 6 TDs in 2025. It
would also give him at least one TD in four of his last five games.

BIRDS' EYE VIEW

MCBRIDE'S IMPACT SEASON CONTINUES

TE **Trey McBride** posted his 15th consecutive game with 5+ receptions last week vs. the Rams, tying TE Travis Kelce for the longest such streak by a TE in NFL history. Through Week 14, McBride is tied for the league-lead in receptions (93), tied for 5th in TD receptions (8) and ranks 6th in receiving yards (937).

He could surpass 100 receptions and 1,000 yards this week and would join Zach Ertz (2018) as the only tight ends in NFL history to have 100+ receiving yards in the first 14 games of a season. With nine receptions and 102 receiving yards, he would pass Ertz for the most receptions and receiving yards by a TE in the same span.

If he continues at his current pace, McBride would finish the 2025 season with 121 receptions for 1,225 yards and 10 TDs. <u>That would be the single-season record for receptions by a TE</u>.



LB **Josh Sweat** is on another hot streak in his debut season in Arizona, totaling 10 tackles, 9 QB hits, 6.0 sacks, 5 tackles for loss, 2 forced fumbles, a fumble recovery and a pass defensed in his last six games

Sweat has four "strip sacks" this season, the most by a player in the NFL this season. He had 5 total "strip-sacks" in 104 games played in Philadelphia. Sweat's career high for "strip-sacks" in a single season during his 7 years with the Eagles was 2 in 2020.

WILSON'S HISTORIC RUN

WR **Michael Wilson** had another outstanding performance last week vs. the Rams, finishing with 11 receptions for 142 yards and 2 TDs. <u>He became the first Cardinals WR to have 10+ catches, 140+ yards and 2+TDs in a game since Larry Fitzgerald on 12/30/2007 vs. the St. Louis Rams.</u>

In three games played with WR Marvin Harrison Jr. sidelined, Wilson totaled 36 receptions for 445 yards and 2 TDs. He had 10+ receptions and 100+ receiving yards in all three contests. Wilson's 39 receptions in his past four games are tied for the second-most in a four-game span in franchise history. He is tied with with DeAndre Hopkins who had 39 in Games 1-4 of 2020 and fall behind McBride's 40 catches in Games 11-14 in 2024.

The players joined Cardinals Cheerleaders, team mascot Big Red and representatives from Desert Financial and shopped with 30 underprivileged youth from different programs of Chicanos Por La Causa. Each child received \$1,000 to shop for holiday gifts with members of the team.
