



ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

- 25** Tackles for S **Budda Baker** which are the second most on the team trailing only LB **Kyzir White** (29). Baker has three tackles for loss in 2024 which also ranks second among Cardinals. He is one of four NFL players (Commanders LB Bobby Wagner, Texans LB Azeee Al-Shaair and Browns LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah) and the only DB to have 25+ tackles and 3+ tackles for loss this season.
- 126** Meetings between the two teams since 1932 when the Commanders were founded. Prior to division realignment in 2002, the two franchises spent over 30 seasons as NFC East rivals (1970-2001). Both teams were also a part of the NFL East from 1950-1966.
- 2.0** Sacks for LB **Dennis Gardeck** in his last meeting with the Commanders in Week 1 of 2023. Gardeck also forced a fumble in the contest which was returned for a TD for the Cards first score of the season. Gardeck currently leads the team or has a share of the team lead in sacks (3.0), tackles for loss (five), INTs (one) and forced fumbles (one) this season.
- 8** Receptions for 64 yards for WR **Michael Wilson** last week against the Lions. That total marked a game high as well as a career high for Wilson.

WITH A WIN...

- The Cardinals would improve to 16-7 against the NFC East since 2014, including a 9-3 mark over the last 12 games.
- The Cardinals would improve to 4-1 at home vs. Washington since beginning play at State Farm Stadium in 2006.
- Arizona would improve to 4-3 in the team's last seven meetings with Washington.
- Arizona would improve to 2-1 in conference play in 2024.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 2 passing TDs, Murray would pass Hall of Fame QB Kurt Warner (100) for the fifth-most TD passes in franchise history.
- With 2 passing TDs, Murray would match Warner (32) for the fourth-most games with 2+ TD passes in franchise history.
- With a rushing TD, Murray would have 27 rushing TDs as a member of the Cardinals. That would tie Johnny Roland (1966-72) and Elmer Angsman (1946-52) for seventh place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs.
- With 3 passing TDs, Murray would tie Neil Lomax (15 games) for the most games with 3+ passing TDs in franchise history.

RB JAMES CONNER

- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 32 rushing TDs with Arizona. That would tie Stump Mitchell for fifth place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs.
- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 32 rushing TDs in 45 games played with the Cardinals. That would mark the most of any Cardinal in their first 45 games with the team.
- With 2 rushing TDs, Conner would have eight games with multiple rushing TDs as a member of the Cardinals. That would tie David Johnson (2015-19) for the most such outings in franchise history.

LB ZAVEN COLLINS

- With a tackle for loss, Collins would have at least one tackle for loss for the fifth consecutive game, matching the longest streak of his career (Games 12-16 in 2022). Only Lions DL Aidan Hutchinson (five games) and Rams LB Bryon Young (five) currently have longer active streaks than Collins (four).

LB KYZIR WHITE

- With 10+ tackles, White would have double-digit tackles in three of four games played this season and in four of his last six games dating back to last season.

WR MARVIN HARRISON JR.

- With a TD reception, Harrison would join Steve Lach (4 in 1942) as the only rookies in team history with at least four TD catches in their first four games.
- With 2 TD receptions, Harrison would join Larry Fitzgerald (2 in 2004) and Anquan Boldin (2 in 2003) as the only rookies in team history with at least two TD receptions in multiple games in a season.
- With 100+ receiving yards, Harrison would become just the eighth rookie in franchise history with multiple 100-yard receiving games in a season and first since Anquan Boldin (5) in 2003.

WR MICHAEL WILSON

- With a reception, Wilson would have 50 in his career.

LB MACK WILSON SR.

- With 1.0 sack, Wilson would have 5.5 sacks in his last nine games played after having 2.5 sacks in his first 72 games.

DL DANTE STILLS

- With 1.0 sack, Stills would have a sack in back-to-back games for the first time in his NFL career.

IT STARTS WITH SCORING

The Cardinals offense has wasted no time getting on the scoreboard in 2024. In each of the team's first three games, their first offensive series resulted in a TD. **It marked the first time that Arizona scored TDs on its first drive in three straight games since Weeks 12-14 of 2006 and the first time since at least 2000 when the NFL began tracking the statistic that the Cards did so in the first three games of a season.**



If Arizona scores a TD on its first offensive possession Sunday, they'd become just the third team since at least 2000 to score a TD on their opening drive in each of the first four games of a season joining the 2022 Titans and 2011 Patriots.

The Cardinals have scored points on 14 of their 29 offensive drives (48.3%) this season. Both the Cards and Commanders rank in the top 10 in scoring efficiency in '24.

STOP IT SHORT

The Cards defense has stopped opposing runners for zero or negative yardage on 24 plays in 2024. That total leads the NFL. **It also marks just the fourth time in the last 25 seasons and first time since 2011 that the team has forced opponents to run for zero or negative yards 24+ times in the first three games of a season.**

"MARV-ELOUS" BEGINNING

WR **Marvin Harrison Jr.** continued the hot start to his NFL career last week vs. the Lions as he caught five passes for 64 yards and a TD. Through three games, Harrison has 10 catches for 198 yards and three TDs.



Harrison became just the fourth player in franchise history to have 3+ receiving TDs in his first three NFL games. **He also became the only player in franchise history with 160+ receiving yards and 3+ TD catches in his first three games. Harrison's 198 receiving yards are the fourth-most in a player's first three games in team history and also rank second among current NFL rookies.**

With a TD catch on Sunday, Harrison would join Rob Awalt (3 games, Weeks 7-9 in 1987) and Steve Lach (4, Weeks 1-4 in 1942) as the only rookies in franchise history to have at least one TD catch in three-or-more consecutive games.
