ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

Last time the road team suffered a loss in the series between the Cardinals and Seahawks. That span covers eight games. In that time, the road team has a 7-0-1 record.

Offensive linemen across the NFL that have taken every snap on offense this season. That total includes three rookies: Cardinals C Mason Cole, Colts G Quenton Nelson and Giants G Will Hernandez. Cole has started 119 consecutive games in a streak that dates back to his freshman year of the high school.

Punting average for Andy Lee this season, which leads the NFL. Should Lee's number hold through this Sunday's finale, he will break the franchise single-season record for gross punting average - which he himself established in 2017 (47.3).

Scrimmage yards RB David Johnson needs to reach 1,400 scrimmage yards in 2018. Should he reach it, he would join WR Larry Fitzgerald (3x) as the only players in franchise history with 1,400+ scrimmage yards and 10+ TDs in a season multiple times. Johnson had 2,118 scrimmage yards and 20 TDs in 2016.

WITH A WIN...

- The Cardinals would become the first road team to win four straight games at CenturyLink Field. Arizona would also have twice as many victories at CenturyLink Field since it opened in 2002 (8) as any other NFL franchise.
- QB Josh Rosen would have four wins in 2018, tying the franchise record for wins by a rookie QB. Rosen would become the first rookie QB in team history with at least three road wins.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

WR LARRY FITZGERALD

- With a reception, Fitzgerald would have at least one catch in 227 consecutive games, extending the second-longest streak in NFL history (HOF WR Jerry Rice 274). Fitzgerald would have at least one catch in every game played over the last 14 seasons.
- With a TD reception, Fitzgerald would have 116 TD catches in his career. That would tie Chargers TE Antonio Gates for sixth place on the NFL's all-time list for career TD receptions.
- With 14 receiving yards, Fitzgerald would join WR Jerry Rice as the only players in NFL history with 2,000+ receiving yards against three different opponents.
- With five catches, Fitzgerald would have more receptions at CenturyLink Field (79) than in any other NFL venue aside from State Farm Stadium (598).

DE CHANDLER JONES

- With a sack, Jones would have 9.5 sacks in seven career games against the Seahawks. He would have at least one sack in all seven games. Jones would also have 6.5 sacks in four career games at CenturyLink Field.
- With a sack, Jones would have 41 sacks in 48 games with the Cardinals. He would pass DT Darnell Dockett (40.5) for seventh place on the franchise all-time sacks list.
- With 2.0 sacks, Jones would have 14.0 sacks in 2018. That would tie for the fifth-best single-season total in team history.

CB PATRICK PETERSON

With an INT, Peterson would have three INTs in 2018 and 24 in his career. Only six players in Cardinals history would have more.

RB DAVID JOHNSON

- With a TD (of any kind), Johnson would have 44 TDs in his career. He would have 10 more TDs than any other player in franchise history through their first four seasons
- With a TD (of any kind), Johnson would have five TDs in his last three games against the Seahawks and four TDs in his last two games at CenturyLink Field.
- With one rushing TD, Johnson would tie Stump Mitchell (32) for fourth place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs.
- With two TDs (of any kind), Johnson would have 45 career TDs. That would tie Anquan Boldin (2003-09) for the eighth-highest total in franchise history.

QB JOSH ROSEN

■ With two TD passes, Rosen would have 12 TD passes this season. In franchise history only Jake Plummer (15 in 1997) and Sam Etcheverry (14 in 1961) would have more TD passes in their rookie season.

PANDY LEE

■ If he averages 50 yards per punt this week, it would mark the seventh time this season he has done so. That last punter to average 50+ yards per punt in more than seven games in a season was Detroit's Sam Martin (8) in 2013.

S ANTOINE BETHEA

With 11 tackles, Bethea would establish a new career single-season high with 140 tackles in 2018. The 13th year pro has recorded 11+ tackles in a game three times this season.

GAME #234 FOR FITZ

Selected by the Cardinals #3 overall in the 2004 NFL Draft, WR Larry Fitzgerald will wrap up his 15th season in the NFL on Sunday at Seattle, and in doing so will appear in his 234th career game with Arizona. <u>That will tie K Jim Bakken for the most games played in franchise history.</u>

SUCCESS AT CENTURYLINK

CenturyLink Field has a well-deserved reputation as one of the toughest venues in the NFL for visiting teams. Over the last six seasons, Seattle has the third-best home winning percentage in the NFL (.745).

They have a 35-12 record at home during that stretch but <u>a third of those losses</u> have come against the Cardinals, who enter this week's game having won three in a row - and four of the last five - at the Seahawks home field.

The Seahawks are 1-4 at home against the Cardinals dating back to 2013 - and have a 34-8 home record against the rest of the NFL during that span.

Arizona has nearly twice as many wins at CenturyLink Field - which opened in 2002 - as any other Seattle opponent. With a victory this week, the Cardinals would become the first road team to win four consecutive games at CenturyLink Field, which opened in 2002.

In just three career games at CenturyLink Field, Jones has recorded 5.5 sacks. He has multiple sack in all three contests.

In six games against the Seahawks, Jones has 28 tackles, 8.5 sacks, 14 QB hits, seven tackles for loss and two forced fumbles.
