



ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

38 Receptions for WR **Marquise Brown** this season. He is tied for fourth in the NFL in receptions in 2022 while also tying for sixth in the NFL in receiving yards (417). Brown has never finished a season in the top-10 in either category.

1 Players in the NFL this season - at any position - that have 2.0+ sacks and 5+ passes defended: Cardinals DL **Zach Allen**.

3,942 On Sunday, the number of days it will have been since the Cardinals last faced a Seahawks starting QB other than Russell Wilson. That game - against Tarvaris Jackson - came on 1/1/12, in the regular season finale of the 2011 regular season.

3 Combined wins for QBs **Kyler Murray** (1) and **Colt McCoy** (2) at Lumen Field. The Cardinals signal-callers have more combined career wins at Lumen Field (3) than the two QBs on the Seahawks current roster: Geno Smith (2) and Drew Lock (0).

WITH A WIN...

- The Cardinals would earn their 10th all-time win at Lumen Field. That would double the total of any other visiting team in the NFL since the venue opened in 2002 (49ers and Rams each have 5 wins there).
- Arizona would start the year 3-0 on the road for the second consecutive season. It would mark the first time in Cardinals history the team started the season 3-0 on the road in back-to-back years.
- Arizona would improve to 6-2 at Seattle dating back to 2015.
- The Cardinals would tie the all-time series vs. the Seahawks at 23-23-1.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

WR MARQUISE BROWN

- With 9 receptions, Brown would tie the franchise record for receptions through the first six games of a season. The record is currently shared by DeAndre Hopkins (47 in 2020) and J.T. Smith (47 in 1989).
- With 1 TD reception, Brown would have a TD catch in three straight games in a single season for just the second time in his career: Games 11-13 in 2020 w/ Ravens.

TE ZACH ERTZ

- With 1 reception, Ertz would have at least one catch in 112 consecutive games. Only three players have longer active streaks: DeAndre Hopkins (136), Travis Kelce (131) and Jarvis Landry (126).
- With 1 TD reception, Ertz would have six TD receptions in seven career games against the Seahawks. He would have three TD catches in three games vs. Seattle since joining the Cardinals in 2021.
- With 2 TD receptions, Ertz would join Hall of Fame TE Jackie Smith (4) as the only TEs in franchise history with multiple games of 2+ TD receptions. Ertz had 2 TD catches in Week 11 at Seattle last season.

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 2 TDs (passing or rushing), Murray would have 100 career TDs. In NFL history, only nine players would have reached 100 career TDs in fewer games than Murray (52): Patrick Mahomes (39), Dan Marino (43), Deshaun Watson (45), Kurt Warner (46), Josh Allen (47), Andrew Luck (49) and Daunte Culpepper (50), Johnny Unitas (51) and Matthew Stafford (51).
- With a passer rating of 120.0+, Murray would have 10 such performances in his career. That would tie Neil Lomax (10 times in 108 games) for the most games with a passer rating of 120.0+ in franchise history.

DL J.J. WATT

- With 1.0 sack, Watt would have 4.5 sacks in his last seven regular season games played.
- With a sack of Geno Smith, the Seahawks QB would become the 44th different QB Watt has sacked in his career.
- With 2.0 sacks, Watt would have 5.5 sacks in his last seven regular season games played.

DL ZACH ALLEN

- With 1.0 sack, Allen would have a sack in three consecutive games for the first time in his career.
- With 2.0 sacks, Allen would have 4.0 sacks in 2022. Just six games into 2022, that would tie his career high for a single season (4.0 in 2021).

LB MARKUS GOLDEN

- With 1.0 sack, Golden would have 10.0 sacks in his last 17 games played. It would also give him 9.0 sacks in his last 11 road games.

S JALEN THOMPSON

- With an INT, Thompson would have six career INTs. Of those six, five would have come in his last 14 games played.

A POTENTIAL TIME CHANGE FOR SUNDAY'S GAME

With the Houston Astros currently holding a 2-0 series lead over the Seattle Mariners in the ALDS, Saturday's game between the two teams could result in the Cardinals-Seahawks matchup on Sunday being moved back.

Should the Mariners win on Saturday (game starts at 1:07 PM AZ time), it would force a game four to be played in Seattle on Sunday. That would result in the original 1:05 PM kickoff for the Cardinals-Seahawks game being pushed back to 2:30 PM.

Should that happen, it will be just second NFL regular season game in at least the last 60 years to start at 2:30 PM PT (5:30 PM ET). The other was Houston at San Francisco on Christmas Day in 1993.

CARDS GO FOR WIN #10 AT LUMEN FIELD

Lumen Field has a well-earned reputation as one of the toughest venues in the NFL for visiting teams. Over the last 11 seasons (2012-22), Seattle has the third-best home winning percentage in the NFL (.720).

Arizona is one of the few visiting teams that has had success at Lumen Field during that stretch, with an NFL-high six road wins at the venue since '12.

Since Lumen Field opened in 2002, the Cardinals have more wins at the venue (9) than any other visiting team.

Dating back to last season, the Cardinals have been particularly strong when it comes to protecting the ball and creating turnovers on the road.

- AZ has just 5 turnovers on the road. No other team has fewer than 10.
- AZ has not lost a single fumble on the road. All other teams have lost at least 3.
- AZ has a +20 turnover differential on the road. The next-best total is +14.
- AZ has not had a game in which it committed more than one turnover.
