



ARIZONA CARDINALS NOTE CARDS

- 5-4** Cardinals record against Seahawks QB Russell Wilson at Lumen Field. Arizona's defense recorded 37 sacks of Wilson in those nine contests. In the last six road games at Seattle - in which the Cardinals are 4-2 - Arizona's defense sacked Wilson 25 times.
- 10** "Drive-Stalling" penalties for the Cardinals in 2021. Only three teams have fewer (Chargers, Rams and Buccaneers each with 9). Arizona had the most such penalties in the NFL last season (34).
- 102.7** Passer rating for QB **KYLER MURRAY** in his last three games against the Seahawks, during which he has a 2-1 record. In those contests, Murray threw for 747 yards, 6 TDs and just 1 INT while adding 122 yards and a TD on the ground.
- 9** Consecutive TDs for the Cardinals that have been scored by RBs - a streak that dates back to Week 7 vs. Houston: **JAMES CONNER** (6 rushing, 1 receiving), **ENO BENJAMIN** (1 rushing) and **CHASE EDMONDS** (1 rushing). Conner has accounted for four of the Cardinals five TDs in the last two games.

WITH A WIN...

- Arizona would improve to 9-2 in 2021. It would mark just the sixth time in franchise history (2015, 2014, 1974, 1948, 1925) the Cardinals had at least nine wins through the first 11 games.
- With nine wins, the Cardinals would secure their first season with a winning record since 2015 (13-3).
- Arizona would have increased their win total in each of the first three seasons under head coach **Kliff Kingsbury**: 5 in 2019; 8 in 2020; 9 in 2021 (with 7 games remaining).
- The Cardinals would have at least six road wins in a season for just the fifth time in franchise history: 2015 (7), 2009 (6), 1963 (6), 1948 (6).
- Arizona would have wins in each of its first six road games in a season for just the second time in franchise history (6 in 1948).
- The Cardinals would have an NFL-high nine road wins at Lumen Field, which opened in 2002. Arizona would also improve to 5-2 in their last seven road games at Seattle.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

QB KYLER MURRAY

- With 31 passing yards, Murray (24 years, 106 days) would become the fourth-youngest player in NFL history to reach 10,000 career passing yards.
- With a passer rating of 120.0+, Murray (5) would tie the franchise record for most such performances in a single season: Kurt Warner - 5 in 2009.
- With three passing TDs, Murray would have 20 TD passes in 2021. He would become just the ninth player in NFL history to throw 20+ TD passes in each of their first three seasons.
- With 2 rushing TDs, Murray would have 20 career rushing TDs. He would become the first player in NFL history to reach 60+ passing TDs and 20+ rushing TDs in his first 41 career games.

LB MARKUS GOLDEN

- With a sack, Golden would have 10.0 sacks in 2021, including 8.0 in the last six games. It would mark his third career season with 10.0+ sacks, and his second as a member of the Cardinals (12.5 in 2016).
- With 2.0 sacks, Golden would have 2.0+ sacks in a game for the eighth time in his career, and for the fourth time in the last six games this season.

WR A.J. GREEN

- With 110 receiving yards, Green would reach 10,000 receiving yards for his career. He would join teammate DeAndre Hopkins as well as Julio Jones and Antonio Brown as the only active players to reach the milestone.

RB JAMES CONNER

- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 12 rushing TDs in 2021, tying his career high for a single season (had 12 in 2018). Only two players in franchise history (David Johnson - 16 in 2016; John David Crow - 14 in 1962) would have more rushing TDs in a season.
- With a rushing TD, Conner would have at least one rushing TD in five consecutive games, tying the franchise record.
- With two TDs (of any kind), Conner would have 14 TDs in 2021, a new career high (had 13 TDs - 12 rushing, 1 receiving in 2018). Conner (5) would join RB David Johnson (5 in 2016) as the only players in team history with at least five multi-TD performances in a single season.

LB CHANDLER JONES

- With a sack, Jones would have 15.5 sacks in 11 career games against the Seahawks, including postseason. It would also give him 12.5 sacks in nine games against the Seahawks since coming to Arizona in 2016.
- With 2.0 sacks, Jones would have 12.5 sacks in six career games at Lumen Field. He would be tied for 10th all-time in sacks at the venue, despite never having played for Seattle.

A DOMINANT TEAM ON THE ROAD IN 2021

On Sunday in Seattle, Arizona will look to improve to 6-0 on the road this season. **The Cardinals (5-0) and Patriots (5-0) are the only teams in the NFL that remain undefeated on the road in 2021.**

Arizona's road success this season has been historic. **The Cardinals average margin of victory in their five road wins this season is 18.2, having outscored opponents 174-83 in those contests.**

ON OFFENSE: The Cardinals are averaging 34.8 points per game on the road and have scored 30+ points in all five road games this season. Arizona is just the fourth team in NFL history - and first since the 2000 Rams - to have scored 30+ points in each of its first five road games in a season.

ON DEFENSE: Arizona has allowed an average of 16.6 points per game on the road in 2021. The Cardinals are the only team in the NFL this season that has allowed 20 points or fewer in every road game.

In road games this season, the Cardinals rank #1 in the NFL in:

SACKS - AND TAKEAWAYS - BY THE BUNCH

In the NFL this season, there have been just six games in which a team recorded 5+ sacks and 3+ takeaways while playing on the road:

Arizona - 3 times (@ Tennessee; @ Cleveland; @ San Francisco)
All other NFL teams combined - 3 times (Buffalo, Cleveland & Las Vegas - 1 each)

Since team sacks became an official statistic in 1963, just one team - the 1984 Denver Broncos (4) - had more such performances in an entire season than Arizona (3) has in 2021.

PLAYING - AND WINNING - THROUGH ADVERSITY

While playing 10 consecutive games to start the season - this week's game at Seattle will make it 11 before Arizona is on bye in Week 12 - **the Cardinals are tied for the NFL's best record despite a host of key starters missing time in 2021.**

Arizona has already had 72 different players see action this season. Only Tennessee (82) has had more.

The Cardinals have been hit especially hard on the offensive side of the ball. Last week vs. Carolina, Arizona was without starters QB **Kyler Murray**, WR **DeAndre Hopkins**, LG **Justin Pugh** and RB **Chase Edmonds**.

Through Week 10, **Arizona' offense had seen:**

- **36 different players see action (most in the NFL)**
- **10 different starting lineups (tied for most in the NFL)**
- **7 different starting combinations on the O-Line (6 in last 8 games)**
- **8 different starters miss a combined 17 games**
- **2 different QBs starting multiple games (3 seeing action in multiple games)**
- **1 player start all 10 games (LT D.J. Humphries) and just 5 appear in all 10 games**
