Career regular season games for RB James Conner, 49 of which have come with the Cardinals. On Sunday vs. Chicago, Conner will reach 100 career games. He will become just the 15th active running back to have 100 career games played.

INTs for S **Jalen Thompson** in two starts against Chicago. Thompson intercepted Justin Fields in Week 16 last season and Andy Dalton in Week 13 of 2021. He has totaled 15 tackles (one for loss), four passes defensed and two INTs in his career against the Bears.

Sacks allowed by the Cardinals offensive line in the last three games. Arizona's current three-game streak marks the first time since Games 12-14 of the 1975 season that the Cards held their opponents without a sack in at least three straight games.

Years in which the Cardinals called Chicago home. The team was founded in Chicago as the Morgan Athletic Club in 1898 and remained in the city until moving to St. Louis in 1960. The Cardinals and Bears were crosstown rivals for 40 years dating back to the Bears founding in 1920.

- The Cardinals would improve to 5-4 on the season and maintain their spot atop the NFC West.

MILESTONES WITHIN REACH...

<u>QB KYLER MURRAY</u>

- With 3 passing TDs, Murray would tie Charley Johnson (108) for third place on the franchise all-time list for career passing TDs.
- With 3 passing TDs, Murray would tie Neil Lomax (15 games) for the most games with 3+ passing TDs in franchise history.
- With 338 passing yards, Murray would pass Jake Plummer (17,622) for third place on the franchise all-time list for career passing yards.

RB JAMES CONNER

- With 100+ rushing yards, Conner would have nine 100-yard outings as a member of the Cardinals, matching Jim Otis (1973-78) for the third-most games with 100+ rushing yards in franchise history. It would also mark his sixth 100yard rushing performance is his last 11 games.
- With a rushing TD, Conner would have 34 rushing TDs with Arizona. That would give him sole possession of third place on the franchise all-time list for career rushing TDs. At 50 games, he would also become the quickest Cardinal ever to reach 34 rushing TDs with the team.
- With 2 rushing TDs, Conner would have 8 games with 2+ rushing TDs with the Cards, tying David Johnson (2015-19) for the most such games in team annals.

TE TREY MCBRIDE

- With 100+ receiving yards, McBride would join Jackie Smith (twice) as the only TEs in franchise history to have 100+ receiving yards in consecutive games.
- With 54 receiving yards, McBride would reach 500 receiving yards for the season. At nine games, he'd become the quickest Cards TE to reach 500 receiving yards in a season since at least 1970.

<u>WR MARVIN HARRISON JR.</u>

- With a TD catch, Harrison would have six TD catches in 2024. In franchise history only Anguan Boldin (8 in 2003) and Larry Fitzgerald (8 in 2004) would have more TD receptions in their rookie season.
- With 2 TD receptions, Harrison would join Larry Fitzgerald (2 in 2004) and Anquan Boldin (2 in 2003) as the only rookies in team history with at least 2 TD receptions in multiple games in a season.
- With 100+ receiving yards, Harrison would join Anguan Boldin (5 in 2003) and Gaynell Tinsley (3 in 1937) as the only rookies in franchise history with at least three 100-yard receiving performances. He would also be the first rookie in team history with 100+ receiving yards in back-to-back games.

S BUDDA BAKER

- With 2 tackles, Baker would be just the 16th active player and one of just five DBs to surpass 800 career tackles.
- With 10+ tackles, Baker would have double-digit tackles for the 31st time in his career and in seven of his last 12 games played.

DANTE STILLS

With a sack, Stills would become the first Cardinals player with 1.0+ sacks in three straight games since Haason Reddick in Weeks 14-16 of 2020.

LB ZAVEN COLLINS

With three tackles, Collins would have 200 tackles in his career.

A HISTORIC MONTH

After joining the Cardinals practice squad on October 2nd, K Chad Ryland played a historic first four games with Arizona that earned him "NFC Special Teams Player of the Month" for his performance in October.

Ryland finished the month 8-9 on FGAs (88.9%) and 6-6 on PATs for a team-high 30 points with three game-winning FGs in four games played with the Cards.

His achievement marks the sixth time a Cardinal has won "Special Teams Player of the Month" since the award's inception in 1993. <u>He is just the third Arizona kicker (K Neil</u> Rackers - twice in 2005) and first since K Zane Gonzalez in October of 2019 to receive the honor.

A SIGNIFICANT STREAK FOR MURRAY

QB **Kyler Murray** put together another strong performance in the passing game in last week's comeback win in Miami. He completed 26-of-36 passes (72.2%) for 307 yards, 2 TDs and a passer rating of 116.3.

With two TD passes, Murray has now thrown at least one TD in 15 consecutive games dating back to Week 11 of 2023. Only Steelers QB Russell Wilson (21 straight) has a longer active streak.
