LOS ANGELES CHARGERS at ATLANTA FALCONS

CHARGERS DOWN FALCONS, 17-13

Behind four interceptions and one pick six, the Los Angeles Chargers defeated the Atlanta Falcons 17-13 on Sunday in Mercedes Benz Stadium.

The Chargers defense recorded four interceptions, the most since Dec. 26, 2022 when they had three against Indianapolis.

Rookie **CB Tarheeb Still** compiled three tackles (one solo), two interceptions and three passes defended. He returned his second interception 61 yards for a touchdown to become the second Bolts rookie to record multiple interceptions and return one for a touchdown in a single game, joining DB John Hendy who did so in Week 13 of the 1985 season against Buffalo.

Rookie **WR Ladd McConkey** totaled a career-high nine receptions for 117 yards (13.0 avg.), marking his third 100-yard performance of the season. He registered 105 yards in the first half, setting a record for the most receiving yards in the first half of a game and becomes the second rookie in Bolts history to top the century mark in the opening half of a game, joining WR Keenan Allen (104) who did so in Week 12 of the 2013 season at Kansas City.

QB Justin Herbert completed 16-of-23 passes for 147 yards with no interceptions for a passer rating of 86.7. **RB Gus Edwards** led the Chargers on the ground with 32 rushing yards on six carries (5.3 avg.).

LB Troy Dye led the defense with 14 tackles (seven solo) and a pass defended. **S Derwin James Jr.** added 10 tackles (five solo), 2.0 tackles for loss, an interception and a pass defended. **LB Daiyan Henley** tallied 10 tackles (three solo) and a tackle for loss. **S Marcus Maye**, who joined the team mid-week after being claimed off waivers, made an impact in his Chargers debut, tallying three tackles (one solo), an interception and a pass defended.

LADD SETS BOLTS ROOKIE RECORD

Rookie **WR Ladd McConkey** recorded 105 receiving yards in the first half of the game, setting a record for the most receiving yards in the first half of a game by a Bolts rookie. He is one of only two rookies in franchise history to surpass the century mark in the first half of a game, joining WR Keenan Allen (104) who did so in Week 12 of the 2013 season at Kansas City.

McConkey ended the day with 117 receiving yards on a career-high nine receptions.

TARHEEB FOR SIX

CB Tarheeb Still recorded a pair of interceptions, returning one 61 yards for a touchdown. He is the second Bolts rookie to record multiple interceptions, including one returned for a touchdown in a single game, joining DB John Hendy, who did so in Week 13 of the 1985 season against Buffalo.

Still is one of three rookies since 2020 to record multiple interceptions and return one for a touchdown, joining CB Patrick Surtain II, DB Cobie Durant and DB Kamren Kinchens.

HENLEY HITS 10 AGAIN

LB Daiyan Henley tallied 10 tackles (three solo) and 1.0 tackle for loss. Sunday marked his seventh game this season, six consecutive, with at least 10 tackles. His six consecutive 10-tackle games is the longest streak by a Charger since the turn of the century and leads the NFL this season.

JUSTIN PASSES JAMEIS

QB Justin Herbert completed 16-of-23 passes for 147 yards with no interceptions for a passer rating of 86.7. The Oregon product has amassed 19,774 passing yards and passes QB Jameis Winston for second in passing yards in the first five seasons of a player's career in NFL history.
