ARGERS FALL TO RAVENS. 30–23

The Los Angeles Chargers fell to the Baltimore Ravens, 30-23, on Monday night.

QB Justin Herbert competed 21-of-36 passes for 218 yards for a passer rating of 75.9 while rushing for 29 yards and one touchdown on four carries (7.3 avg.). He scored on a five-yard run in the first quarter to give the Bolts a 7-0 lead.

Rookie **WR Ladd McConkey** tallied six receptions for 83 yards (13.8 avg.). **RB J.K. Dobbins** recorded 40 yards on six carries (6.7 avg.).

K Cameron Dicker was three-for-three from the field with a pair of 50-plus yard makes. He also added two extra points for a total of 11 points on the day. Dicker has made 74 field goals with the Bolts and moves to No. 5 on the team's all-time field goals list.

LB Daiyan Henley totaled 10 tackles (four solo) and 1.0 tackle for loss. The second-year linebacker has recorded 10-plus tackles in the last five games and six on the season — in 2024, he is one of just eight players to record at least 10 tackles in six or more games and is one of three players to accomplish the feat in five consecutive games.

LB Nick Niemann set season-highs in tackles (eight) and solo tackles (four).

S Derwin James Jr. recorded six tackles (two solo), 1.0 sack and one quarterback hit. Rookie CB Tarheeb Still tallied a career-high seven tackles (four solo).

QB Justin Herbert reached 1,800 career completions on Monday night, reaching the feat in 73 career games. Herbert ties Kansas City QB Patrick Mahomes as the fastest players in NFL history to eclipse 1.800 completions.

The fifth-year captain wrapped up the night completing 21-of-36 passes for 218 yards, totaling 19,627 career passing yards. He passed Hall of Fame QB Dan Marino for the third-most passing vards by any player in the first five seasons of a career.
