CAREER ACCOLADES

2022: Offensive Most Valuable Player in the College Football Playoff Semifinal win over Michigan with six receptions for 163 yards, including a 76-yard touchdown...His 19.0 career yards per reception average ranked second among active players in the FBS...Became TCU's first 1,000-yard receiver since Jalen Reagor (1,061) in 2018...Had team-best totals of 60 receptions, 1,069 yards and six touchdowns...Had four receptions for 139 yards, including catches of 53 and 51 yards, against Kansas State in the Big 12 Championship Game...His career-best 14 receptions for a career-high 206 yards at Kansas tied for third-most in a game by an FBS player on the season...His 24-yard reception with 1:36 to play in Lawrence provided the game's winning score...The second-best receiving game of his career was eight receptions for 180 yards in the 43-40 double-overtime victory over Oklahoma State...**Accolades:** First-Team All-Big 12.

2021: Led TCU in receiving yards (634), yards per reception (19.2) and touchdown catches (6)...Placed second in receptions (33)...Played in nine games, missing three due to injury...Had a career day at Oklahoma with seven receptions for 185 yards and three touchdowns ...Topped 100 yards receiving against Baylor (142) and West Virginia (113)...His 142 yards in the 30-28 win over Baylor came on five receptions, including a fourth quarter 19-yard touchdown...Also had a 53-yard reception in the contest...The five catches against West Virginia included a 49-yard snag...**Accolades:** First-Team All-Big 12.

2020: His team-best 22.1 yards per catch average was the highest by a true freshman in Big 12 history (minimum 20 receptions) ... the 22.1 mark was also second nationally since 2008 for a true freshman at a Power 5 program while also setting a TCU season record (min. 20 catches)...Became the first TCU true freshman in at least the last 25 seasons with back-to-back 100-yard receiving games when he went for 114 and 133 yards in the final two contests versus Oklahoma State and Louisiana Tech, respectively... The 133 yards on five receptions, including a 76-yard touchdown, versus Louisiana Tech were the most by a Horned Frog since Tave Barber totaled 137 in a 2019 win at Texas Tech...The first Big 12 true freshman with consecutive 100-yard receiving games since 2014...Led TCU with 487 yards receiving on the season... His 114 yards versus Oklahoma State were on three receptions, including a 58-yard snag...**Accolades:** Honorable Mention All-Big 12.

HIGH SCHOOL & PERSONAL: Attended Temple High School in Temple, Texas, where, as a senior, he helped lead Temple to a 9-3 record and 2019 district championships, finishing the 2019 season with 41 catches for 778 yards and eight touchdowns...Emerged as one of the top pass-catchers in the state as a junior with 54 catches for 1,015 yards and 13 touchdowns, earning All-Region honors...Also played basketball and competed in track & field, where he finished third at the 2019 5A State Championships in the high jump...His mother and father are both Army veterans.
