CHARGERS FALL TO KANSAS CITY

The Los Angeles Chargers fell to 5-5 on the season following a 30-27 loss to the Kansas City Chiefs. **WR Keenan Allen**, **Derwin James Jr.**, and **DL Sebastian Joseph-Day** were the game captains for the Chargers. The Bolts won the toss and deferred to the second half.

Los Angeles opened the game with a three-play, 75-yard drive capped by a 50-yard touchdown pass from **QB Justin Herbert** to **WR Joshua Palmer**. It marked the third opening-drive touchdown for the Bolts this season, tied for No. 5 in the NFL.

Palmer ended the day by setting a career-high two touchdown grabs, including his career-long 50-yard score. He tied his single-game career best of 106 receiving yards on eight catches (13.3 avg.).

A NOSE FOR THE BALL

S Derwin James Jr., totaled seven tackles (four solo) and added a seven-yard sack, giving him four on the year to go with his 92 tackles on the season. He is one of six players and the only defensive back in the last 30 years to eclipse 90 tackles and four sacks within their team's first 10 games of a season.

HERBERT HITS 12K

QB Justin Herbert recorded 280 passing yards and two touchdowns with an interception on 23-of-30 passing (76.7 pct.) to register a 113.2 passer rating.

The third-year passer surpassed 12,000 career passing yards in the third quarter, doing so in his 42nd game to tie Hall of Famer Kurt Warner as the second-fastest player in NFL history to eclipse that mark.

EKELER KEEPS CATCHING

RB Austin Ekeler ended the day with 100 scrimmage yards (83 rushing, 17 receiving), marking his 25th career game and fourth contest of the season with at least 100 yards from scrimmage.

His two receptions gave him 69 on the year, good for the most in NFL history by a running back through their team's first 10 games of a season. Ekeler punched in his seventh rushing score of the season in the second quarter, giving him an AFC-best 11 scrimmage touchdowns this year.
